Abraham Lincoln, Dwight Eisenhower and Muhammad Jinnah are few of the examples. 13th amendment in US constitution abolished prolonged slavery, this owes to Lincoln. Eisenhower set the foundation of League of Nations (LON). The United Nations as its successor has aided in peaceful co-existence of international community. Jinnah's struggle led to the birth of Pakistan, a ^{peaceful} home for Muslim and non-Muslim community. 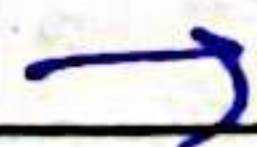
