This rhetoric is reiterated by Kalashnikov himself in an interview in 2007, where he shoved the blame of killings, attributed to his ~~invention~~ invention, to the politicians for not being able to establish peace. He reinforced this notion throughout his life that it is the users who resort to violence and killing, and the weapons are merely a means to achieve that.

5) Kalashnikov employed his last words to vindicate his invention. He repudiated claims that associated him with numerous killings and defended his invention on the grounds that it was the users who were using it in that way, and that the weapon was invented as a medium for defense, not offense. I think, however, under the sturdy facade of self satisfaction and no remorse, deep down Kalashnikov knew that, either directly or indirectly, he was guilty of mass killings precipitated by his invention.
