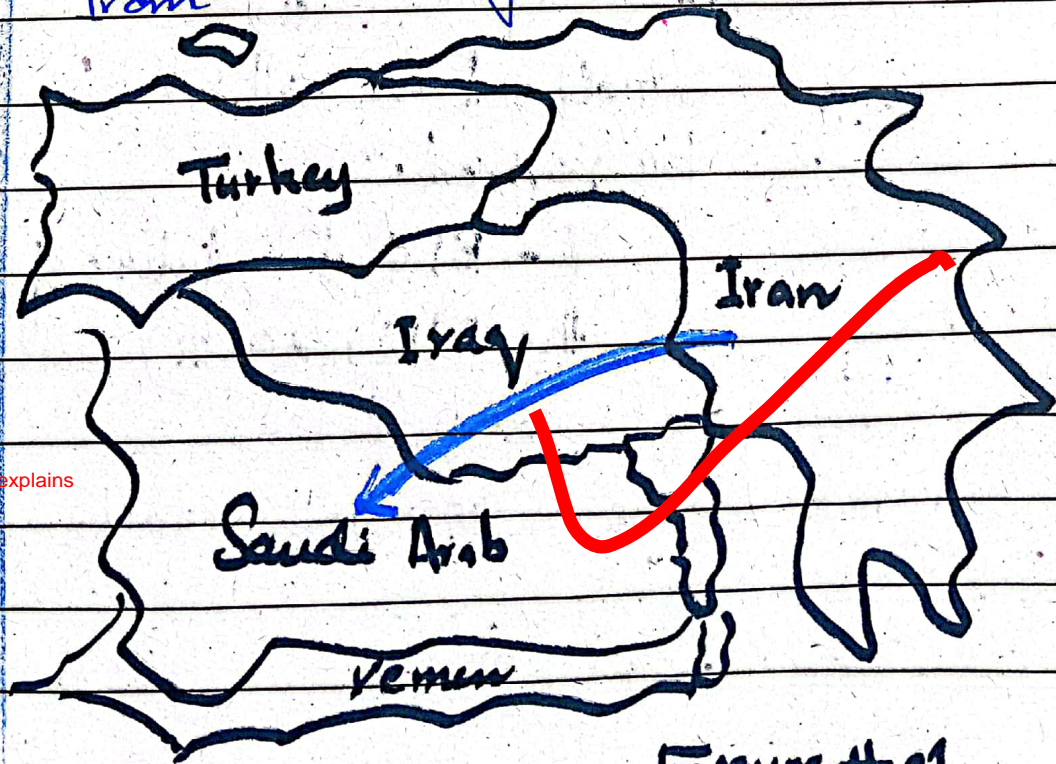

Therefore, Saudi-Iran has revived their economic deal.



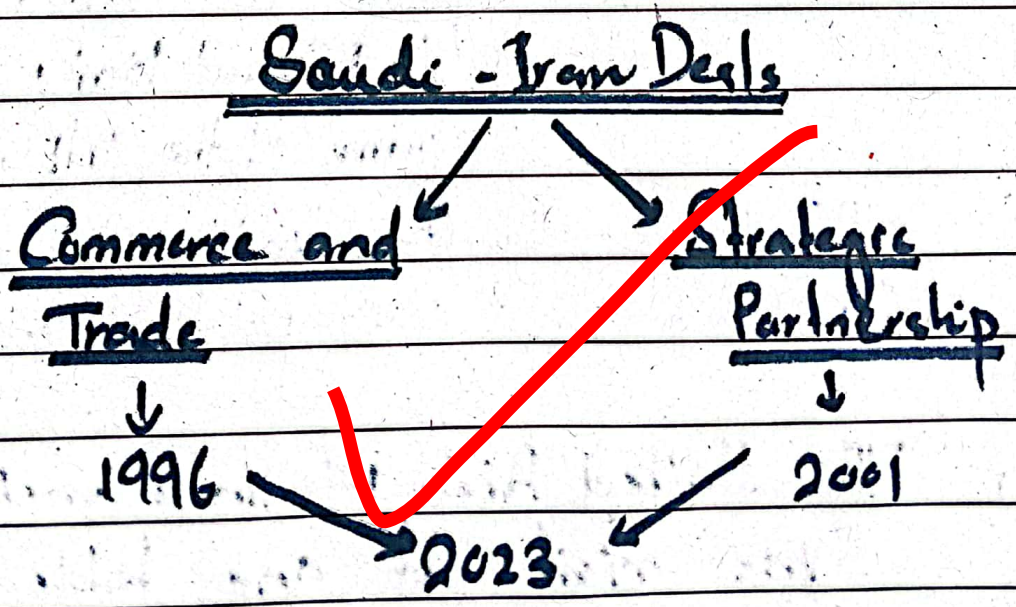
b) The Strategic Partnership deal of Saudi-Iran

Further, Saudi also visited Yemen with Oman for peace of the ME. Both countries had dialogue on socio-political issues to be dealt for prosperity.

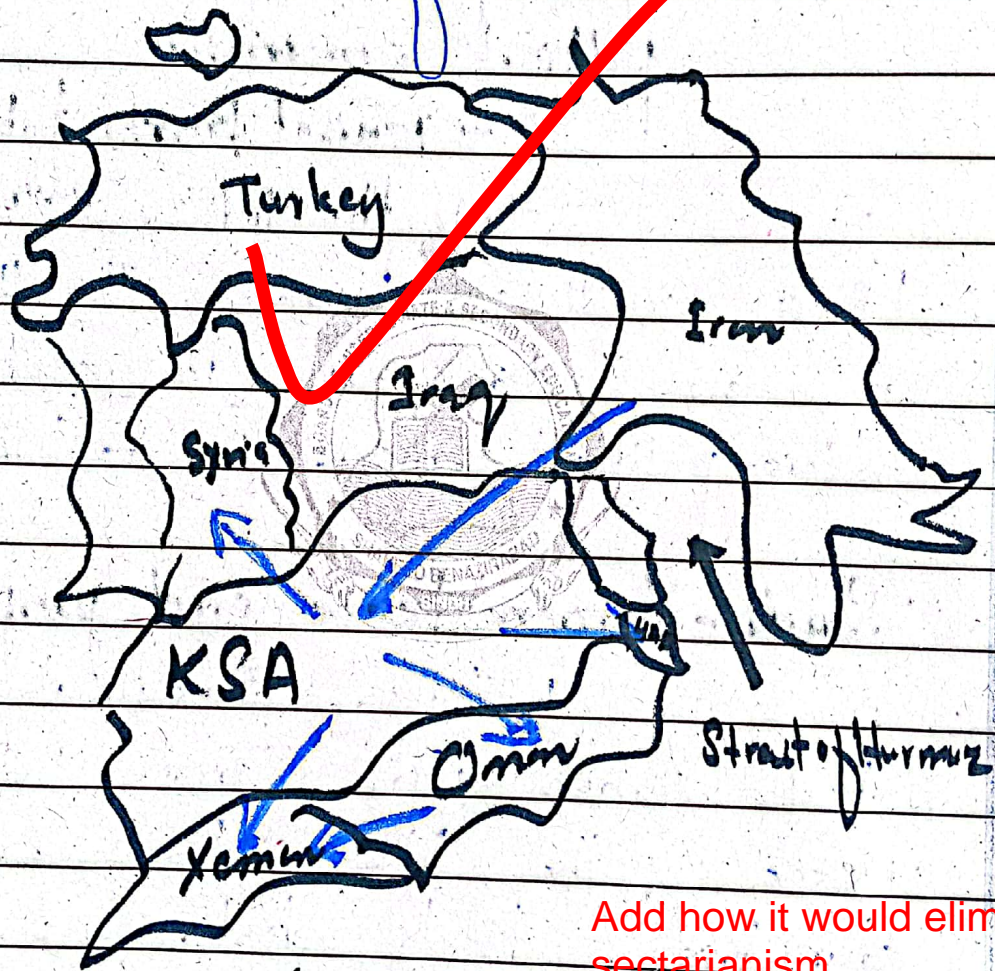

Furthermore, massive deforestation is also a major cause of air. Pakistan has the worst deforestation rate in recent years.

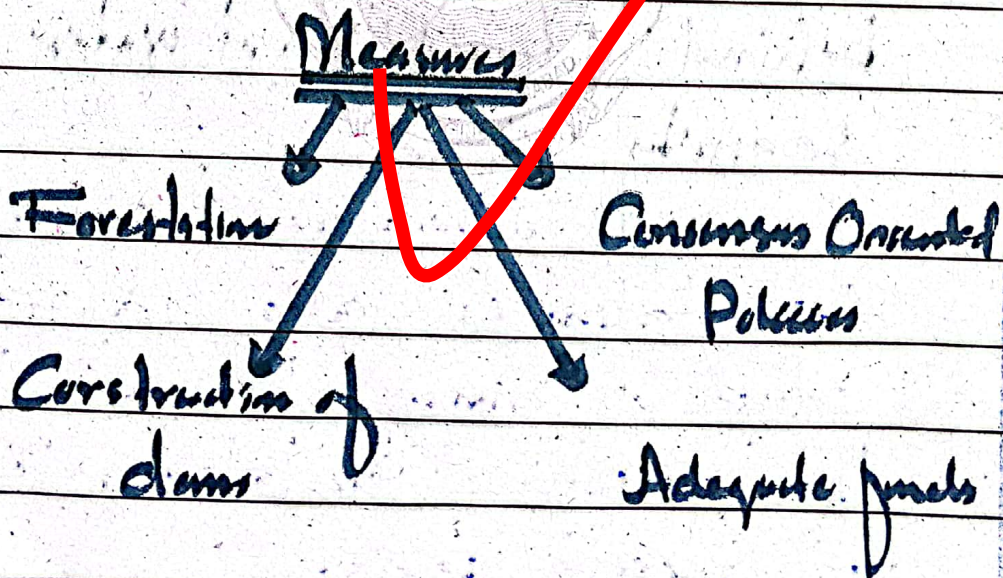
'About 3.5 pc of forests is cut in the last few decades.'

Therefore, Pakistan needs adequate funds to overcome floods and water crisis.

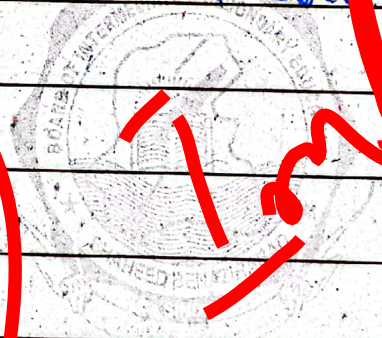

Following are few policies and deals under QUAD:

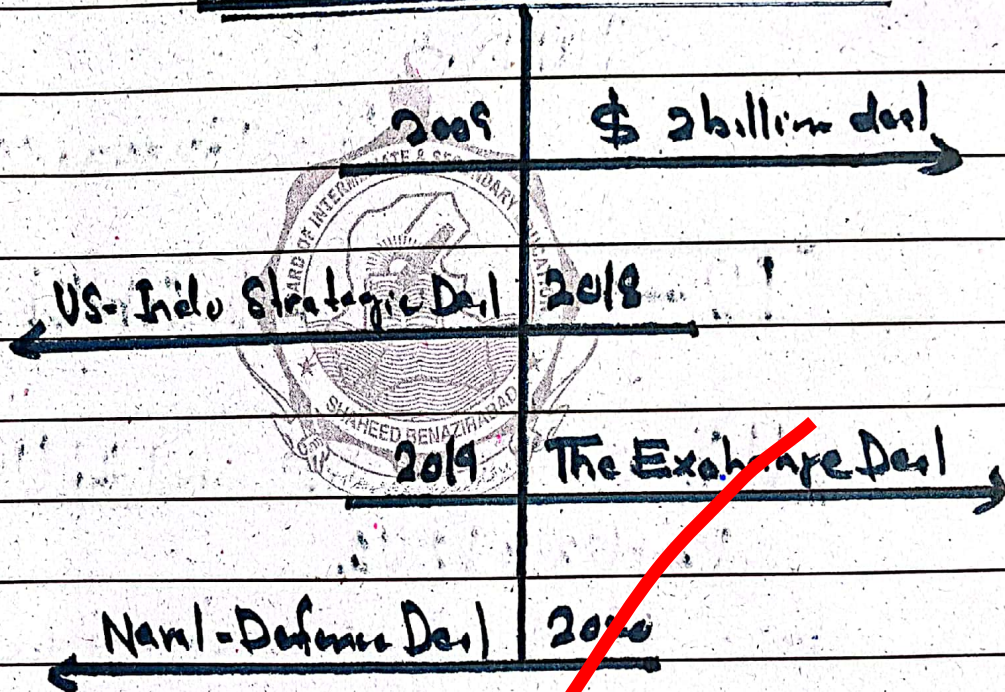

Pakistan.

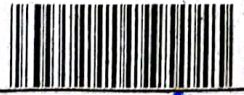
b) Threat to global trade in

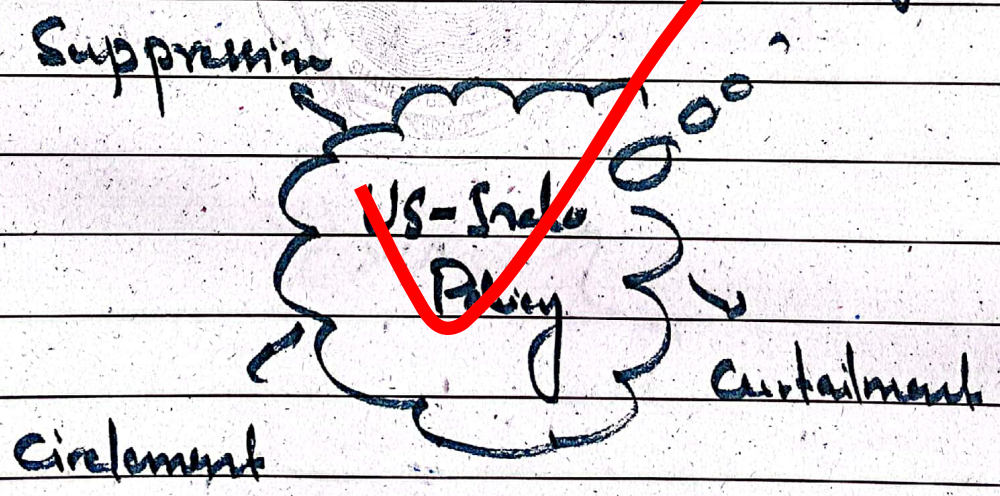
Therefore, Pakistan needs to increase its defence deals.

Therefore, Pakistan should maintain balance reaction with India.

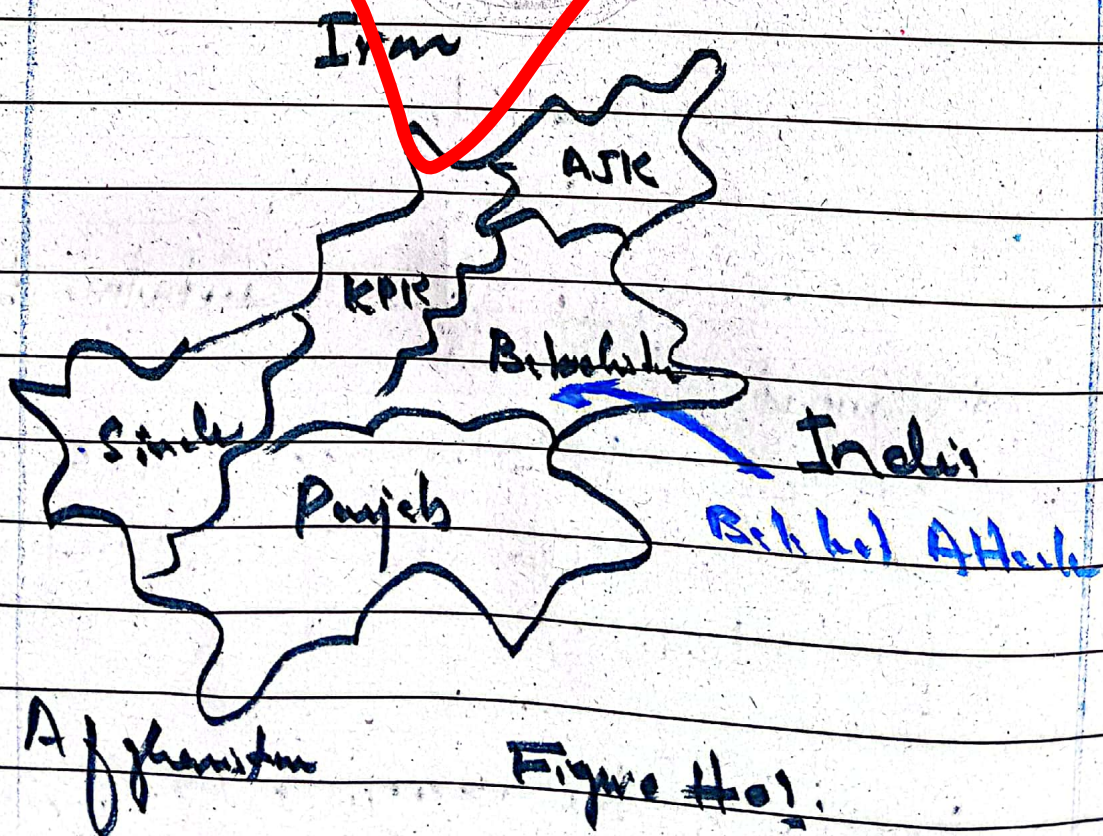

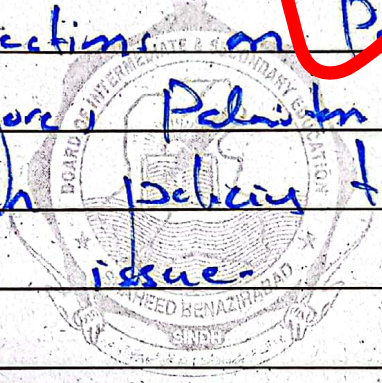

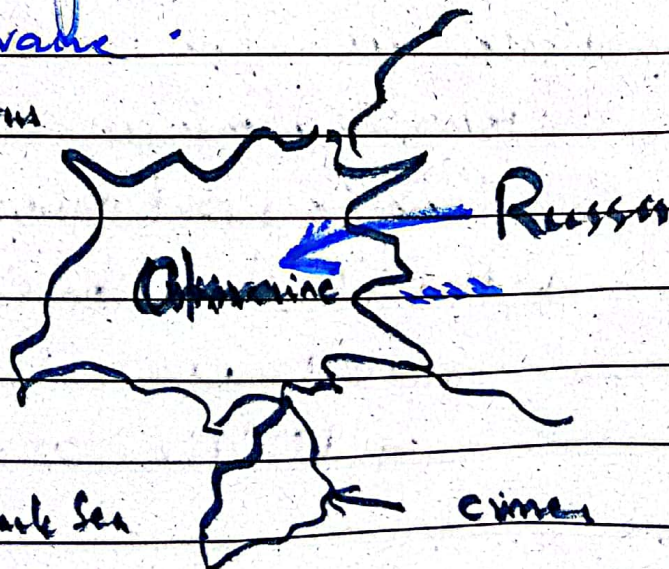

Russia's war on Ukraine lead to the West in confusion. Following are few evidences:

a) Russian veto power in the UNGA: the threat to the US monopoly

The US brought resolutions in the UNGA against aggression of Russia. But, Russian veto power declared it null and void.

In 2022, the UNGA passed resolutions against Russian attack on Ukraine, but Russia repealed it with its veto power.

(- UNGA, 2022)



Hence, Russia has power to decrease the West global order.

b) Suspension of the Strategic Treaties "New Start Treaty"

Moreover, Russia has declared its suspension from 'New Start' treaty. In fact, the treaty was signed between the US and Russia for the peace of the Ukraine.

The growing interference of the US in Russia's foreign policy made

Russia to suspend the 'New Start' Treaty.

(- Vladimir Putin, 2022)

Hence, Russia suspended treaty and left the West alone.

c) Fear back in the NATO
Further fear is

back in NATO. The NATO members have reached a consensus incl. increasing budget for NATO.
