## Comprehension

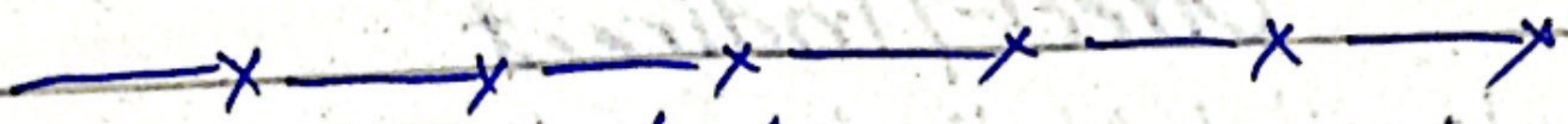
#1: Stauffenberg was a man who tried to kill Hitler by placing a bomb in his car, in 1944. But, the bomb failed to kill Hitler.
