While career fairs are held in the country, these career fairs are very generic in nature and rarely does it happen that valuable guidance is provided to the youth through them. These fairs are, unfortunately, point scoring tactics for the big companies, which don't really look to train and hire the educated youth.

Moreover, as the world is fast changing new job are being created while the old ones are becoming redundant. Sadly this is not happening at a pace in Pakistan at which it should happen. Thus while universities are producing educated graduates, the job market doesn't hold the potential to absorb this educated workforce. New fields and areas of specialization are emerging but the Pakistani landscape is as of yet not ready for new avenues and areas.

Furthermore, the educated youth of the country lacks faith in the existing systems and the recruitment

processes in the country. There is a strong perception among the educated youth that cronyism and nepotism are common practices in Pakistan organization. Hence, merit-based recruitment rarely takes place. The hiring and recruitment processes are not fair and authentic. Thus, the educated youth of the country does not rely on them and yearns for more transparency in the recruitment mechanisms/processes.

Moving on, in terms of policies, rules and regulations, too, Pakistan is not focused on its educated youth. There is a dearth of policies which are solely geared towards the educated youth of the country. Government initiated youth schemes such as the 'Kabiyat Naujawan' scheme fail to address the root cause of the hurdles faced by the educated youth of the country. Thus, well-researched and targeted policies are needed to address the problems of the educated youth of Pakistan.

To top it all, the issue of utilizing the educated youth of Pakistan is not anywhere near the top of the priority list of the policy-makers and elected representatives of the country. Politics and the economy take precedence over social issues such as meeting the demands of the educated youth bulge of the country. It is only when the issue of the educated youth is seriously taken up that it would be effectively addressed in the country.

The result of the neglect of the educated youth of the country is that the youth is becoming frustrated and, in extreme situations, mentally disturbed. The youth is not able to utilize and optimize its true potential and is prone to becoming dejected and depressed. This, at times even

leads to extreme actions on the part of the educated youth, such as suicide or drug addiction, which is not only harmful for the youth itself but also for the society on the whole.

Further, as the Pakistani job market is not offering the opportunities which the youth needs to realize its true potential, the youth of the country is moving to other countries. Last year, that is the year 2022, two million Pakistanis went abroad.
