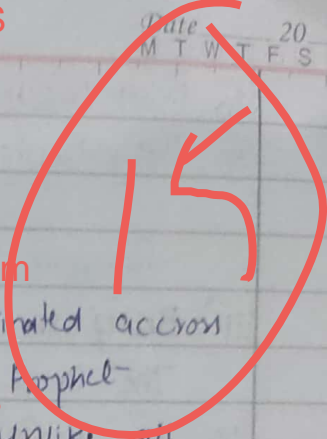

CAUSES OF EXTREMISM.

i) HIGH RATE OF ILLITERACY

Nowadays, Majority of Muslims are illiterate in both religious and conventional knowledge. In such cases they are easily misguided by a group of people who works on the agendas of enemies.

ii) Western Propaganda against Islam.

Western world play major role in the rise of extremism. Western media through planned mission is presenting Islam extremist religion.

iii) Sectarianism

iv) Afghan Jihad against Soviet Union

PRINCIPLE OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION & GOOD GOVERNANCE.

1) Fear of Allah.

Hazrat Ali and Hazrat Umar Farooq wrote it to people involved in governance must have fear of Allah.

2) Authority is the trust of Allah.

According to Islam, authority is fidelity to Allah. Authoritarian is the servant of people to facilitate them.

In Quran Al Inam (6:165):

He is the one who placed you as a successors on earth and elevated some of you in rank over others so he may test you what he has given to you.

Holy Prophet (ﷺ) said that "Chief of nation is chief servant of nation."

3) Government by consultation:

According to Islam, matters must be resolved with consultation. For instance :- Shura must be consulted for passing a budget.

4) Transparency in Government matters.

In Islam, there should be every thing and process crystal clear to public.

5) Rule of law

There is an example of rule of law by Holy Prophet (ﷺ) that ~~there~~ everyone is equal for rule of law.

"If Hazrat Bibi ~~has~~ stole anything, I will order to cut her hands for the sin of stealing."
