1. TAWHEED: THE BEDROCK OF ISLAM..

The essence of teaching of Islam is tawheed. It means there is only one Supreme Lord of the universe and that is "Allah". To whom all the things in this universe belong. Islam is like a fort and the gate to that fort is tawheed. (Holy Prophet Muhammad PBUH). No one can claim himself a Muslim without accepting oneness of Allah. This unique aspect is also mentioned in Holy Quran.

It's the distinctive aspect of Islam that Muslims do not have to sacrifice for it, all are granted by Deen. Whereas people of West had to sacrifice life to get their rights.

3. How Islam Ensures Dignified Status Of Women:

Before Islam people used to bury their daughters. As the light of the Islam prevailed it taught Muslims to respect their women. It made them aware about the status of women and called

girls as a blessing of Allah. With time Islam keep on teaching about the rights and status of women and give them a respectable status in the society. Following are the few way by which women in Islam got dignified status.

a) Islam Shows no discrimination between girls and boys:-

Islam ensures dignified status of women by ending all the pre-existing differences between girls and boys. Birth of girl child is considered as blessing of Allah in Islam.

Holy prophet (PBUH) said that, "Lucky is the women whose first child is daughter." Along with this Islam also denies the discrimination between girls and boys. But has elevated her status by the quote of Holy prophet (PBUH) that, "whenever you bring

anything to your house, give it first to your girl child."

Above two evidences are showing that Islam has ended all discrimination between girls and boys.

b. Islam grants women^{the} right to get education:-

In Islam it is mandatory for every Muslim girl or boy to get education. According to Islam "the first institution for the child is mother's Lap". Therefore, it is necessary for a mother to be educated, to be empowered to make his child aware about the ups and downs of life and to built a child of strong and good character. Islam has emphasized upon the education of daughter as much as one worry about his son. It is ~~not~~ saying of

Holy Prophet (PBUH) :-

"Seeking knowledge is obligatory for every muslim men and Muslim women."

c. Islam ensures the consent of the girl for the marriage proposal.

Islam has elevated the status of women through this special right. Islam ensures the consent of the girl before accepting any marriage proposal. It is commanded to the parents that ask your daughter before saying yes to any marriage proposal. It has also denounced the stereotype that a girl herself can't sent proposal for marriage if she likes someone.

Inspiring upon - the character of Holy Prophet (PBUH) Hazrat Khadija (R.A), herself, sent marriage proposal for Holy prophet (PBUH). Like wise Holy prophet (PBUH) after getting

marriage proposal from Hazrat Ali (R.A) for her daughter Fatima and knowing Allah's will in this relation said InshaAllah to Hazrat Ali (R.A) and asked his daughter about his consent regarding the proposal. In these ways Islam ensures dignified status of women.

d. Islam has given women the right to inherit property..

Pre-Islamic customs related to women were biased. Women were treated as property and they were not entitled to inheritance, whether as a mother, wife, sister or daughter. But according to Islam a mother, wife, and daughter can not be deprived of from the right to inheritance. Islam has set the ratio for the inheritance. Hence, Islam is the only religion which does not deprive women from their right of inheritance rather ensured right to inheritance.

e. Right to involve in Politics:-

Islam ensures political independence of man and women. Islam grants women opportunity to involve in politics. She can participate in political convention, she can vote. Women in Islam has right to self-defense and right to defend her property. But all these are to be carried out under the directions of Islam.

f. Islam has given women right to choose profession:-

In Islam

there is no difference between men and women. Islam grants women right to earn, right to choose profession by keeping in mind the limitations set by Islam.

For a married woman, Islam directs women to choose profession with mutual understanding of both the partners.

g. Islam gives women the right to own property.

Islam

allows women to purchase and be a owner of property. Nobody whether her father, children, brother, husband has right to interfere regarding her property. She is free & from all such boundries and restrictions. Husband has no right in her private property. In this way islam ensures dignified status of women.
