The right-now-sacrifice requirement of climate change for a down-the-line pay off is one of the major reasons behind the neglect. (Major national and international changes, for example compromising on industrial efficiency for a short term, fuel-switching, using renewable energy resources etc, required for the stopping and to some extent reversing of climate change induced damages will need some immediate sacrifices that will have massive beneficial impacts on the entire human race in future) But, compromising and sacrificing something in present which is yet to come in future is a big challenge as this is not how human nature works, humans seek benefits and power that are immediate in nature, careless of its future costs. As Thomas Hobbes says in his Leviathan: "So that in the first place, I put for a general inclination of all mankind a perpetual and restless desire of power after power, that ceaseth only in death" Therefore, we can safely assume that asking loss and sacrifice for something that has majorly existed only in theory until recently was quite hard and unrealistic.

The climate change has not really proven to be a very just phen-

phenomenon as the countries with maximum contribution to the phenomenon itself have seen to be the least affected ones and vice versa. It majorly occurs because of the geographical factors. Year 2022 ~~was~~ provided a live picture to the world of how severely climate change can impact a country's entire population. Despite making 3% of the entire global population Pakistan contributes a negligible 0.8% of the global carbon footprint (UN environment program, 2022) making it the most severely ~~affected~~^a country yet one of the least contributing countries.
