As per China's economic survey, "China lost almost \$200bn of the US import due to heavy taxes by the US." (Economic survey of China, 2019). Hence, taxes is also a threat to economy.

b) Balance of payment crisis (BOP)

Not only loans but (BOP) crisis is also another contemporary issue to the economy of Pakistan. Fiscal Year 2022-23, Pakistan faced more than \$18bn deficit. (Pakistan Bureau of Statistics, 2023). Hence, BOP crisis is another threat to economy of Pakistan.

c) Decline in remittances

Further, decline in remittance is continually prevailing problem. Unfortunately, foreign reserves of Pakistan has declined by 27pc.

As per the latest update, Pakistan's remittances declined at \$22.7bn in May, 2023. (- Faisal Bari - economy in crisis, 2023).

Acquire more loan

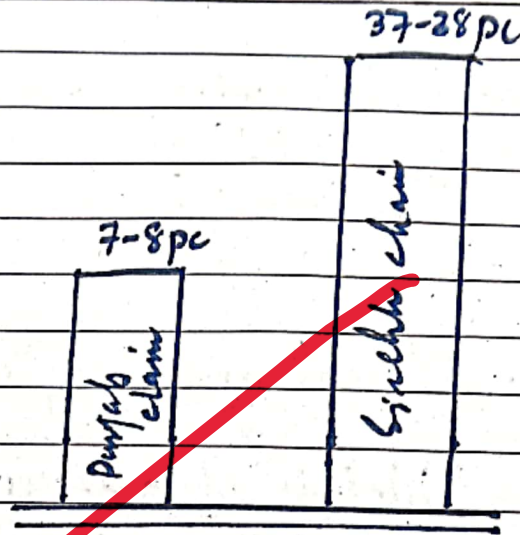
3- Hydro politics - water issues in domestic and regional level
