Online Education totally replace Traditional form of education.

Education has been sin-qua-non for the development of every era. Even the process of revelation from Allah (SWT) started with the verse of Surah Alaq, "Read! Read in the name of My Lord." The verse continued emphasizing on the importance of education and imparting of knowledge in the following words: "He was taught man the use of pen. Taught man what he knew not." Education has therefore undergone changes in order to customise and modify itself according to the requirements of the people. Currently, online education is the modern means of acquiring knowledge. It has a plethora of benefits and has revolutionised the traditional system of education but it is not possible for online education to totally take over the traditional form of education. Traditional form of learning is an effective way of learning that has reached its current face by getting evolved for centuries, although online education is a promising way of imparting knowledge, ^{but} the roots of traditional learning still hold strong.

In traditional form of learning, students are supervised by teachers physically. The benefit of being physical evaluated by teachers are numerous. Although books and online education offers
a plethora of benefits yet still the reigns of
traditional learning are held tight and seem not
to get loose to be replaced ^{totally} by online learning.

There has been an exponential increase in teachers
and also people who are acquiring degree and expertise
in order to join the teaching field. Had teaching (
traditional learning) be getting replaced to online
robots and e-teachers, these people would have

learning. Moreover, these teachers prefer to teach

Character building and psychological well being is only possible through traditional learning. When one is physically present, body language, facial expressions and gestures of hands can be interpreted by teachers and fellows. They can judge in a jiffy if one is going through a problem or not. Teachers and students can help those going through tough times to come out more effectively in
