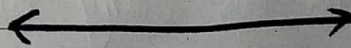

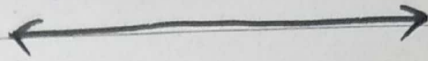

Hassan Ali Gondeal said to Shahab that when his essay book will be ready?

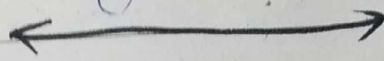
Shahab said that he believe, at the end of November.

ready-made content for cramming.

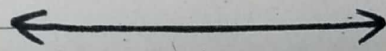
Hassan Ali Gondal said if it is so, then its gonna clear most of the misconceptions about essay writing.
