Both Muslims and Hindus contribute in this struggle through out history in different ways.

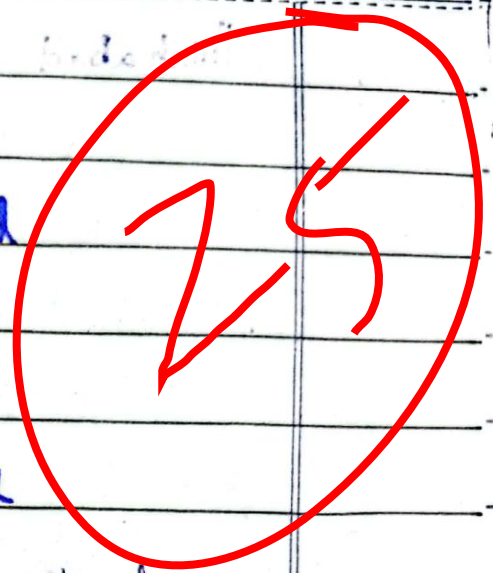
Muslims divide on this occasion, as some support the state and they are first Indian then

### Allahabad Address: ~~Reo~~

On December 29, 1930, Allama Iqbal address to Muslim League meeting in Allahabad. Generally meetings of the party were held in a close hall e.g. in cinemas etc. But this address was held at the house of Rahim Bakhsh, a tobacco merchant.

Interesting this meeting was just an important meeting at that time. According to Fakhru-islam, who joined it, it was a meeting of only 400-500 people. Similarly Assistant Secretary of the league said that, decision was set for 75 delegates but not filled completely.

Despite these amazing facts, Iqbal address ~~the~~ one of prominent and unique proposal for new Muslim state which had never presented by any Muslim leader before. Iqbal gave a clear road map for achieving separate state for the Indian Muslims.

Iqbal was the first president of the party who discuss the clear image and destiny of Muslims of the India.

### 1) Role of Islam in Politics of India:
