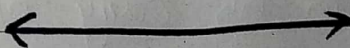

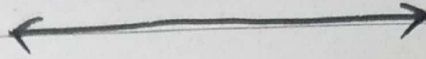

Shahab said that he believe, at the end of November.

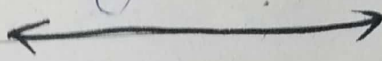

Pakistan's millions of youth are part of generation Z.

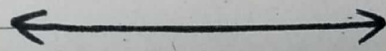
It is that generation which is born after 2000. They are now at 20, 21, which is
