Introduction

Religion and politics are one and same in Islam. They are intertwined. Islam is a complete code of life: it tells how to pray, how to pay Zakat, how to offer charity, same like that Islam tells about principles to be followed in political system. Islamic political system is a perfect system that provides solution to contemporary political system's problems.

Principle

It is based on principle

of oneness of Allah (Tawheed),
Risalat (Prophethood), and
Khilafat (Caliphate)

Features of Islamic political system

Following are some distinctive
features of Islamic political
system

- (1) **Sovereignty of Allah**
First feature of Islamic
political system is sovereignty
of Allah. Every one / ruler
is answerable to Allah.
It means that while
governing, Shariah
is the guidance to
be taken into account
while running government
and does not to be
prohibited. Sovereignty means
Allah is Supreme, He
has control over
everything in the universe.

He is the Absolute ruler.
Members of parliament and
rulers are all answerable
to Allah. A/c to Quran
"The Command is for none
but Allah".

(2) Caliph: Viceroy of Allah
Khalifa is the person
who is sent by Allah
on earth to dispense
his message.

A/c to Quran,
Allah said to Angels
"I am going to place on earth
Caliph".

Abu Bakr was made
Caliph without any electoral
procedure. But when Hazrat
Umar's era came, he
introduced 6 member
Council which later
on appointed Umar R/A

and then AHIRAH)

So Caliph were elected by elections at that time, like now a days Head of state/ president is elected through electoral college

(3) Equality of all Citizen

In Islamic political system, all citizen are equal, There's no priority of race, colour, cast etc.

(4) Religious Freedom

Religious freedom is exercised in Islamic political system. Like christians Jews in Madinah used to live peacefully and exercised their religion freely

(5) Rulers accountability

In Islamic political system rulers are accountable and answerable to

Allah and then to people
People have right to question
their ruler, as he is
exercising power given
by people to him

A/c to Quran

"A person who has done
an atom's weight of good
and the person who did
an atom's weight of evil,
will see it."

(Al Zalzal)

(6) Government by Consultation
Hazrat Muhammad used
to consult his companions
before doing any work
Consultation is the important
feature of Islamic political
system. "Majlis-e-shura"
was formed for consultation
It's importance lies in the

fact that a Susah named
Susa "Al-shusa" is named
after it. A/c to Qur'an
"and Consult them
in the Conduct of affairs"
(Aal e Imran)

7) Meritocracy

In Islamic political system
meritocracy is also
given huge importance while
selecting anyone for any
job. Holy Prophet (S.A.W)
chose younger and expert
people as Commander, despite
presence of older ones,
and sent them for expeditions
For example Uthman bin
Zaid was appointed as
Commander for an extremely
important battle while he
was 18 years old, and
other older ones were
also present.

(8) Independence of Judiciary
In Islamic political system, judiciary is independent of executive. Head of State or government would be called ~~to~~ to the court if necessary. They will also be treated like citizens of state in the court of law.

(9) Rule of law
It is an important feature for the survival of state. All are equal in the eyes of law. Rule of law is necessary to keep law and order in the state.

As Islam is a complete code of life, so does Islamic political system provide complete guidelines for better political system. If in modern political system, ruler consider himself as viceroy of Allah and being accountable to Allah, this sense of fear will make him responsible and staunch to his duties. Impact on Individual life

1) Creates Self respect

2) Sense of Modesty and humility

(a) Right and Status of women in Islam

Introduction:

Islam is a complete code of life that guided mankind in every sphere of life. It recognized rights of women when in Arab women were buried alive and in other part of world they were deprived. It recognize all social, economic & political rights of women.

Status of women

As a mother Islam consider women as respectful and gives status to be respected

As a mother, she is given
right to be respected
given love, honour &
kind treatment by children
As a wife

(2) A wife has many rights
over her husband such
financial & human rights,
kind treatment etc. Hazrat
Muhammad (S-A-W) ' kind
treatment of his wives

As daughter

Before Advent of Islam
women ^(daughters) were buried alive
Holy Prophet gave respect
and his attitude towards
Fatima (R.A) showed his
love and respect towards
daughters

Rights of Women

(1) Right of Inheritance
Women are given rights
of inheritance as daughters,

mother, wife even as a baby and fixed amount is allocated for them in inheritance

(2) Right to divorce

Right of khula is given to women in Islam. She can avail this right on any medical, ethical or religious grounds

(3) Right to education

Women's role is important in society. Islam recognizes women's role and urges both men and women to acquire knowledge

“Acquisition of knowledge is obligatory on all Muslims”

(4) Right to do job (trade/business)

Islam gave women right to do job, trade or

business. There's not restriction
on benefitting from women's
talent in business / trade /
job. She can do job
when necessary.

For example Hazrat Khadija
was famous woman trader
of Quraysh.

Hazrat Kaiba Bint-i-Saad
Al-Aslamie was the first
ever Muslim ^{female} nurse who
provided services in the
battle

(5) Right of Maintenance (Mahar - Nafqa)

In Islamic Sharia, man
is asked to provide woman
or wife with mahar with
good heart and it's compul-
sory to be given.

And give to women
their mahar with Good
heart (An-Nissa)

Islam also gave rights of Nafqa to women. He to be provided with basic necessities like food, medical treatment, clothes etc.

(b) Concept of Justice in Islam

Justice means distribution of wealth, opportunities, and privileges within a society.

Islam has emphasized on numerous principles that organize relationship among members of society.

In Islamic civilization

equality is the element that ensures social justice.

No one can be considered superior because of their wealth, social status,

space etc. one of the most important principle is social justice with all its important values that is ourselves peace, love brotherhood and prosperity. All human beings are equal and owe just and equal treatment.
