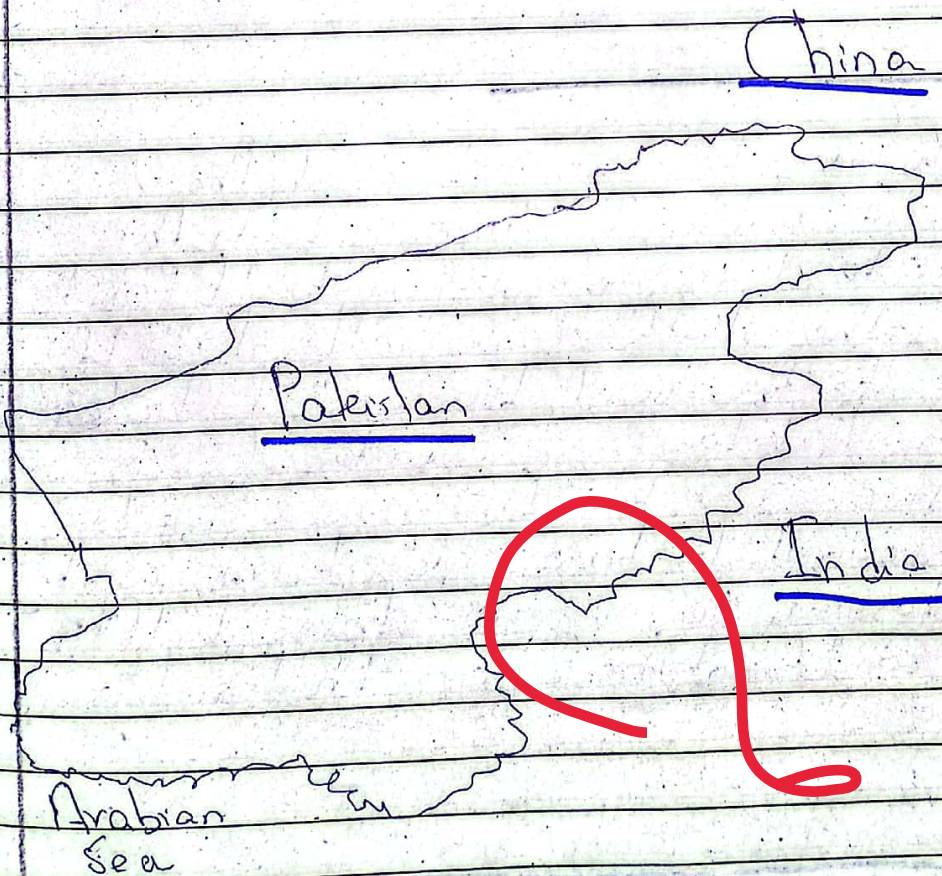
2) Increasing Trade with U.S and China

3) Broker Negotiations and Agreements between States

IMF has laid a condition that Pakistan would show a more openness in diplomatic relations. This also includes trade with its neighbour India, which Pakistan avoid due to many reasons. However, if there both countries revive relation it could benefit Pakistan to a greater extent.
