Problems in the power sector has resulted in unimaginably expensive electricity that has far reaching negative implications on the economy, social and political life of the country. Critically evaluate the statement and suggest workable recommendations.

INTRODUCTION:-

The problem in the power sector of Pakistan and at global level casting a looming threat to rise inflation, political unrest and decreasing/declining the GDP %age.

The main reasons behind these problem is Russia-Ukraine war, circular debt, bad policies of energy sector. Thus certain measures need to be taken to overcome the problem in the power sector.

How electricity has been produced in Pakistan?

The power sector of Pakistan is dependent upon fuel. That Pakistan

imports from foreign countries. Middle east has been the largest exports of fuel. By using fuel the power plants of Pakistan generates electricity. That fuel is expensive that Pakistan imports.

How the Problems in the power-Sector has resulted in expensive Electricity:-

The main problem in the power sector is circular debt. Pakistan imports fuel on debt. That fuel given to the state-oil companies and then transfer to Independent power plants on debt.

Distribution Companies distribute the electricity to consumers. In this vicious circle, the money receiving process starts from consumers.

The fuel is transported to the companies that makes electricity. These companies get oil on less price but gives electricity to consumers on high prices. The money has n't been collected from any company except consumers are paying.

One of the main reasons

of expensive electricity is that Russia-Ukraine war. Due to the war the fuel had been sold on higher prices. Pakistan had taken a barrel on 147 per \$. As a result the consumer had to pay more bills because state oil companies, distributors or IPP's are getting fuel on debt. There is no other way to pay debt except consumers.

The Distributor Companies has been facing the loss of electricity during distribution. The loss of electric distribution is 17%. The theft is another major problem and ^{through} old structure wires electricity wastes. The debt is mounting as a result government is increasing the bill payment per unit.

Therefore, in July the people got infuriated and refused to pay the electricity bills. The salary of government employees or wages of labour are less than the electricity bills. Many protests had been staged in many cities of the Pakistan.

Far-Reaching Negative implications of expensive electricity on the economy, political and social life of the Country:-

The problems in power-sector resulted in expensive electricity that has disturbed the economic, social and political life of the Country and leave negative implications on the Country.

Negative Economical implication on the Country:-

The GDP is expected to decline by 1.7% due to Russia-Ukraine war. Government is unable to recover the loss for done through distribution loss, theft, ~~loss~~ Economically Country is at its worst. When Government is unable to recover the payment directly the state oil companies unable to give ~~no~~ fuel to Independent power plant. However, IPP and power generating companies of government don't have money to generate electricity. Thus, economically

People don't have enough money to pay the bill. There is no way to recover money. So, the problem in Pakistan power sector resulted in expensive electricity has negative implication on country life.

As the electricity bill mounted, the fuel price increases, currency devalued resulted in ^{high} inflation.
