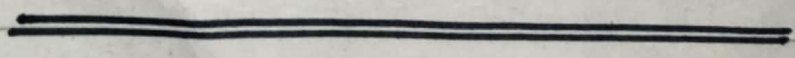
③ "Tower of Babel" refers to the usage of different languages which are misinterpreted by others and it causes destruction, as architects do not understand each other's point of view. The real chief
