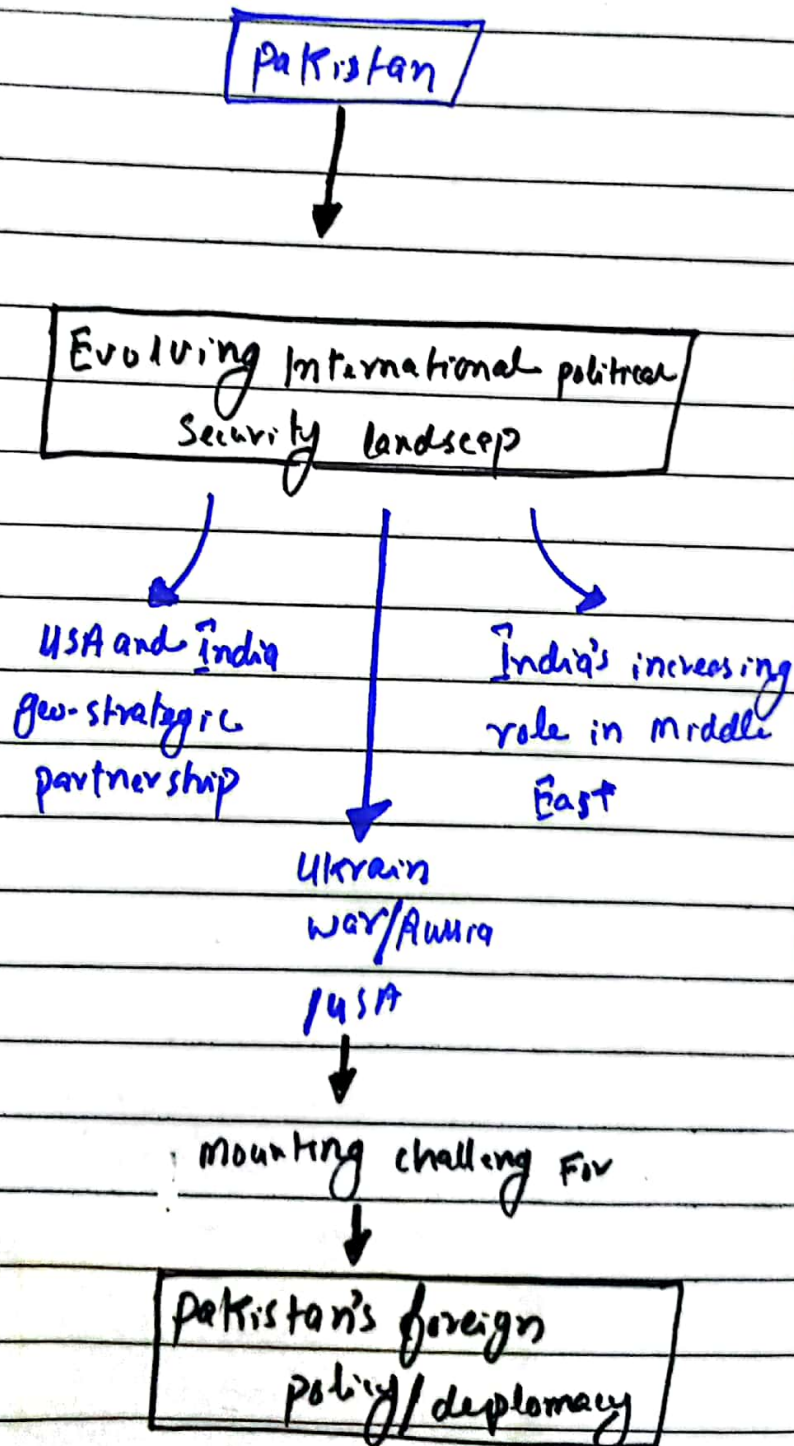
Introduction:

shifted its foreign policy from USA to China. Indeed, Pakistan has adopted neutral approach with USA. Pakistan is trying to establish amicable relations with USA.



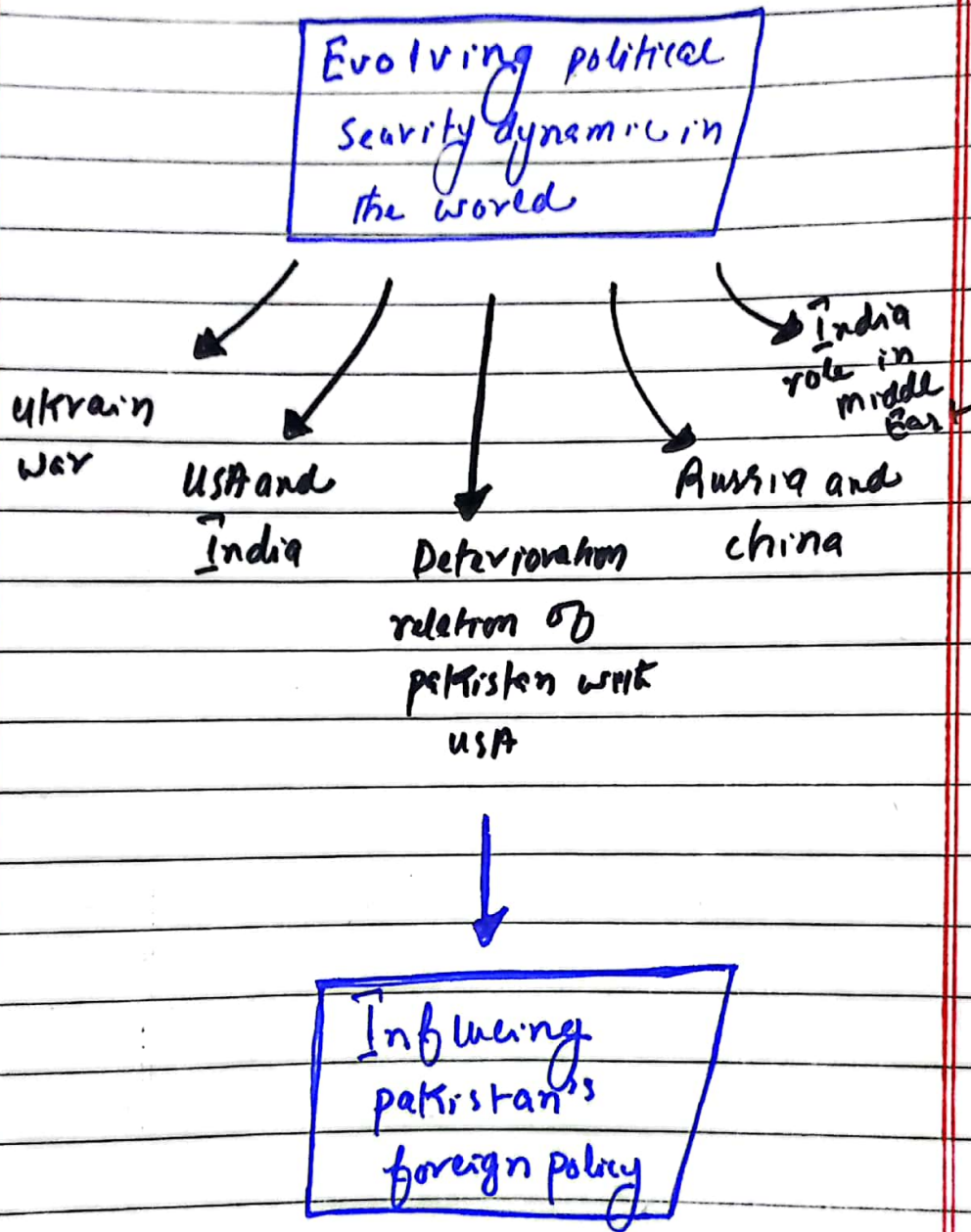
① What is international political Security

from west to East china and Russia.

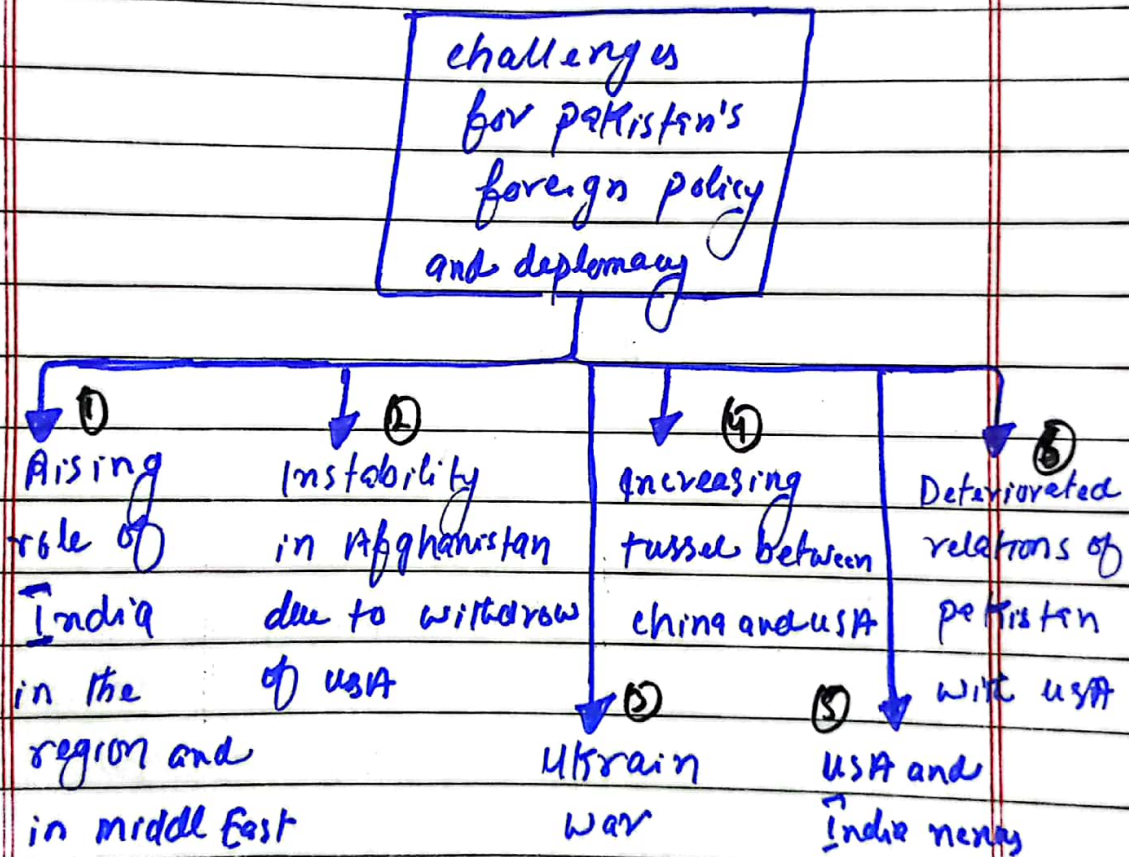

④ Ukraine war is an quagmire for Pakistan's foreign policy and diplomacy

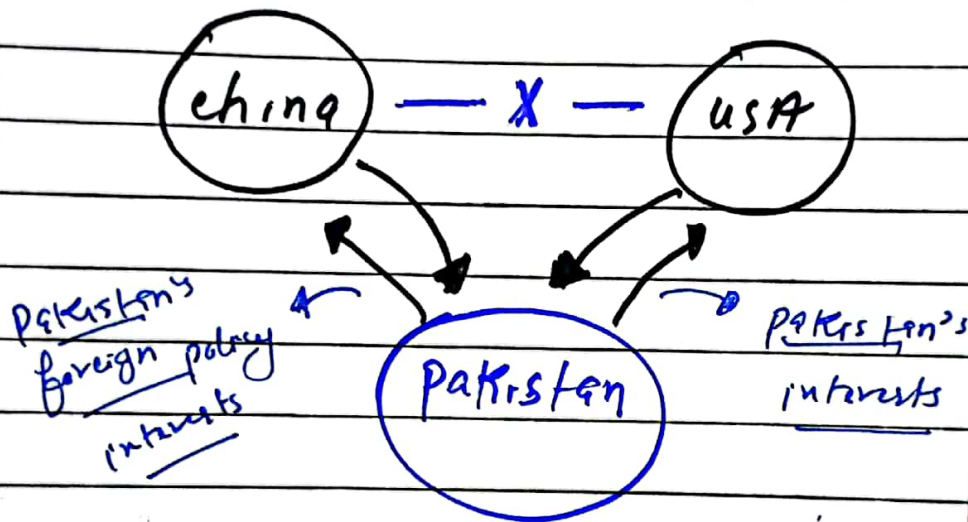

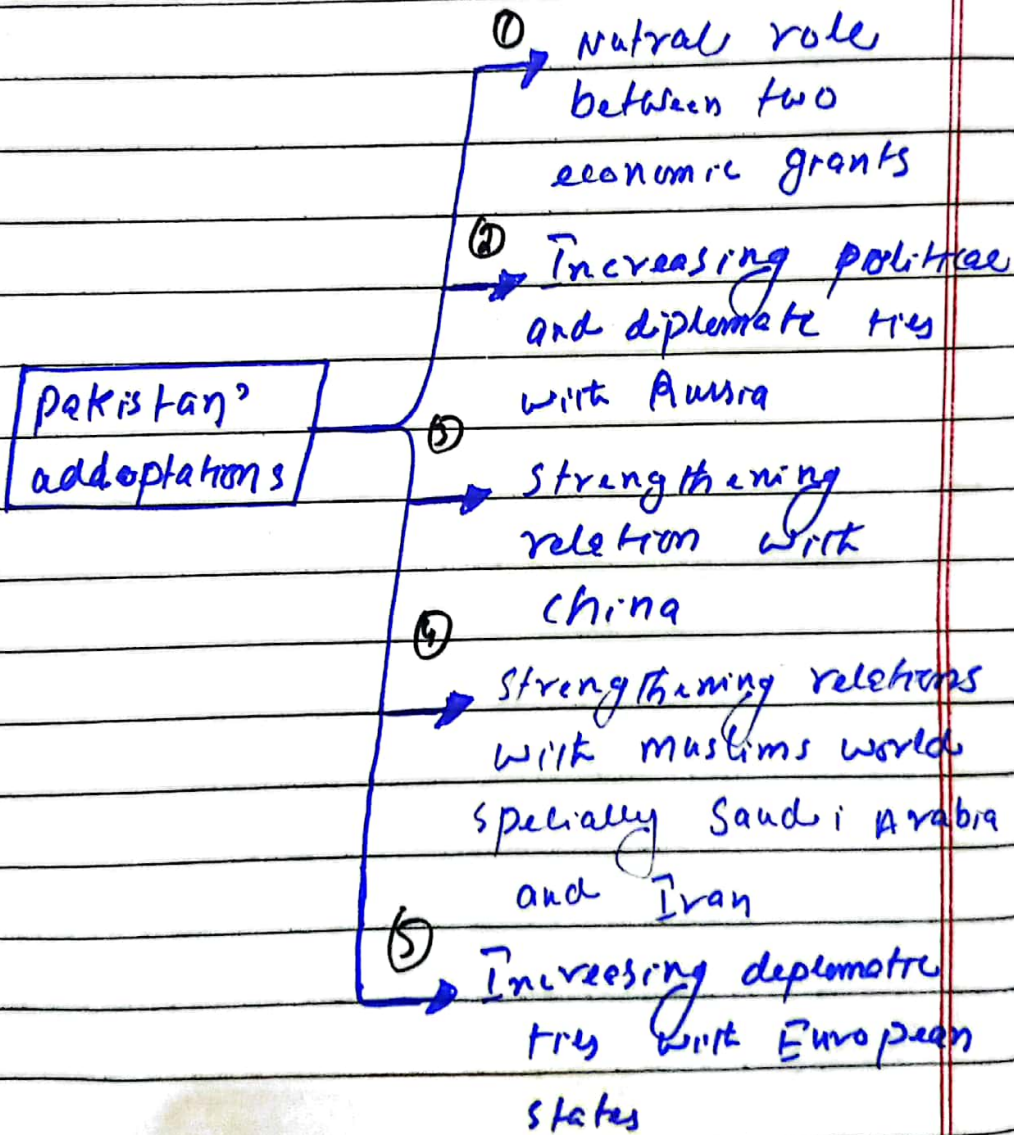

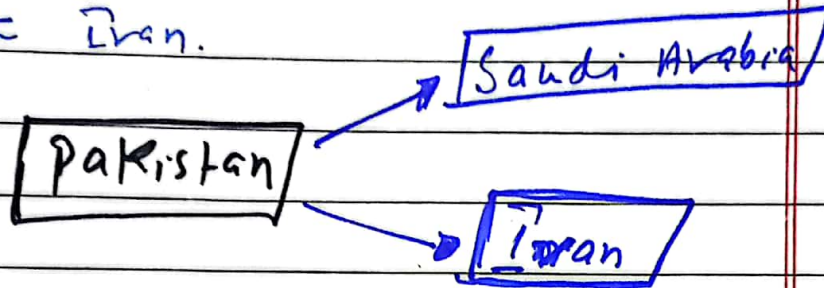
It is foremost goal of Pakistan's foreign policy to establish friendly relations with

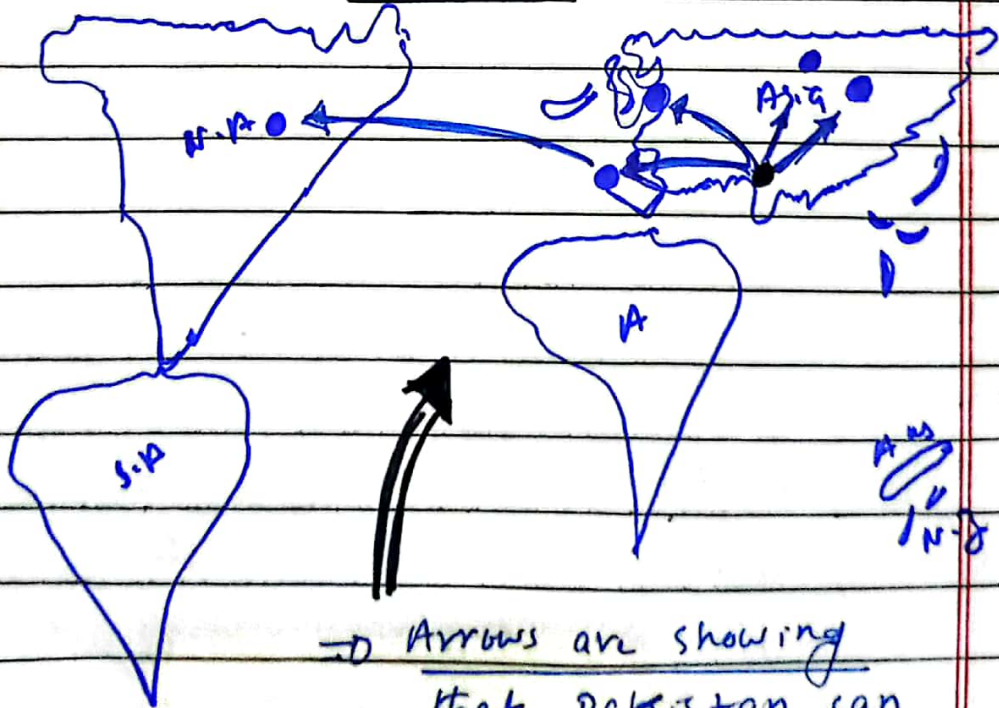
It can help Pakistan's foreign policy to strengthen its interests in European countries. It can counter India's influence in Europ.

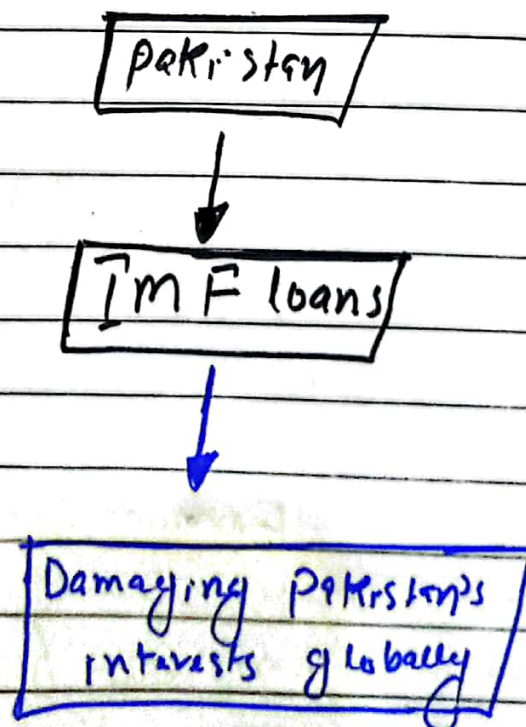
A) Introduction:

Former finance minister mufta Ismail said that continuous financial assistance from IMF is damaging Pakistan's economy.

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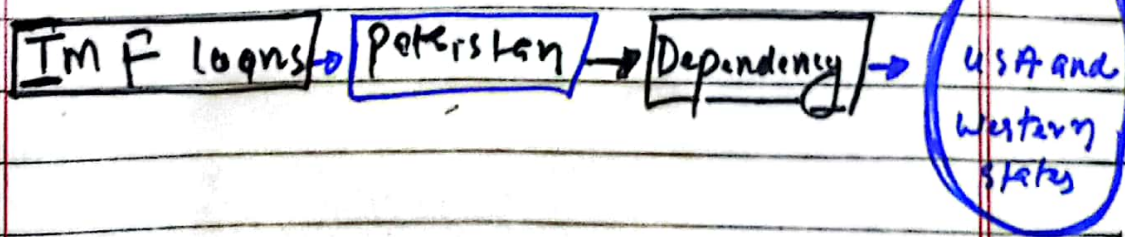

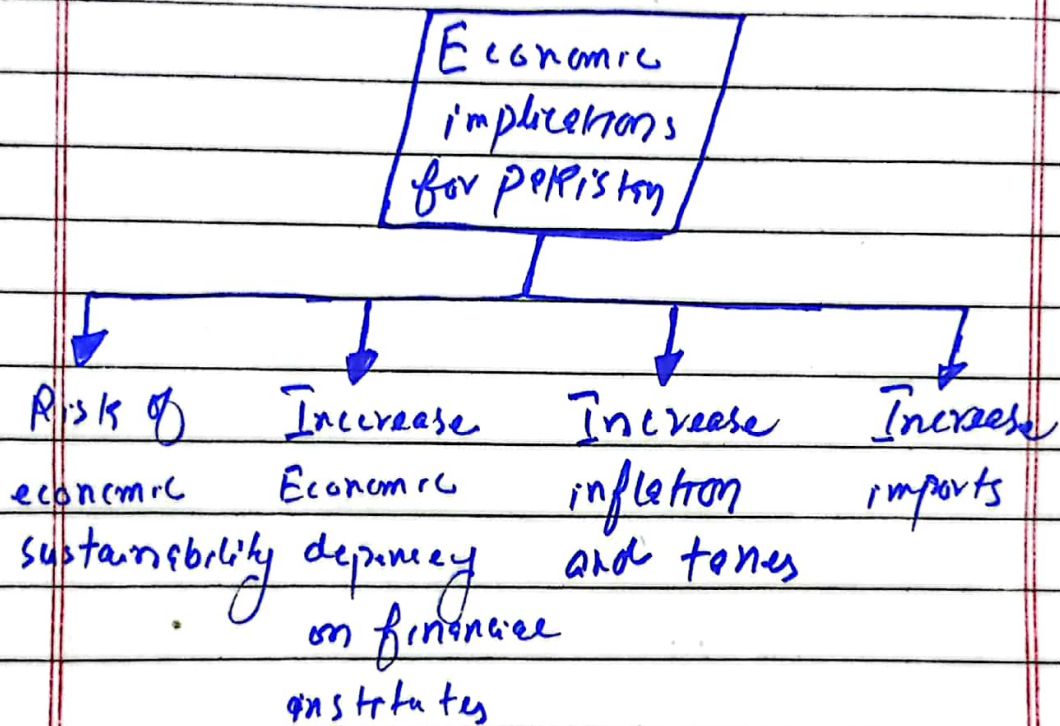
① How Pakistan's participation in IMF is affecting its position in international political economy?

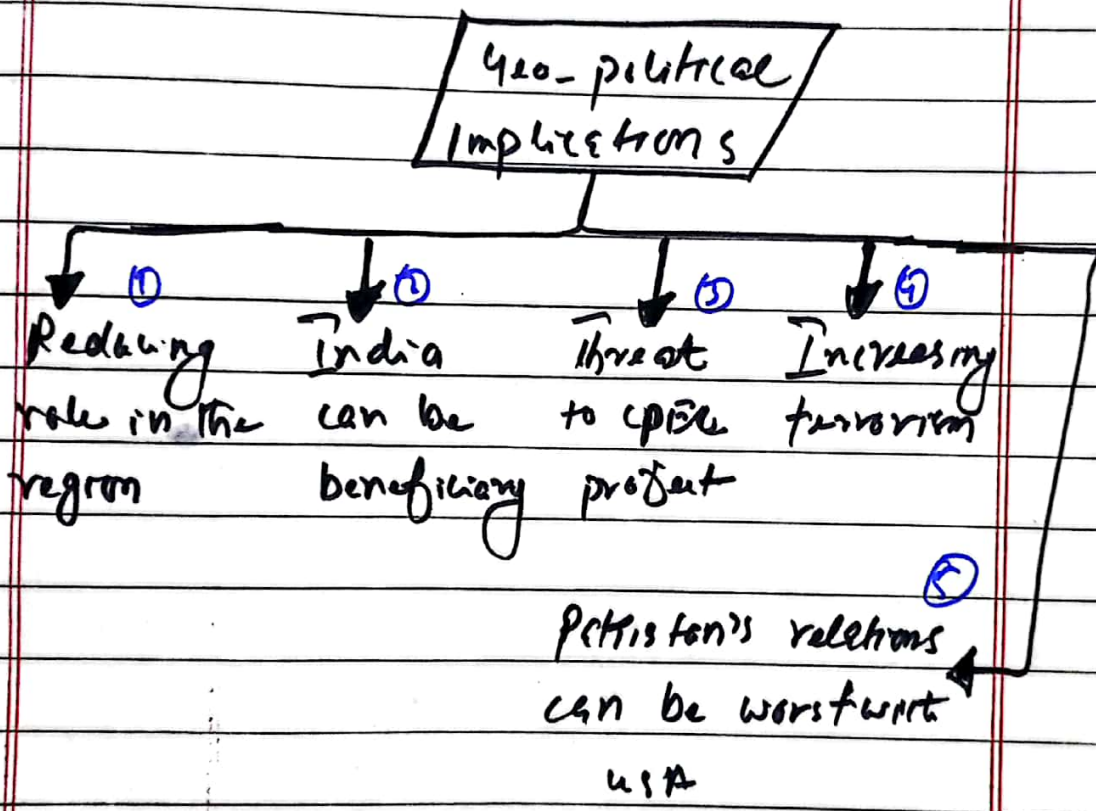

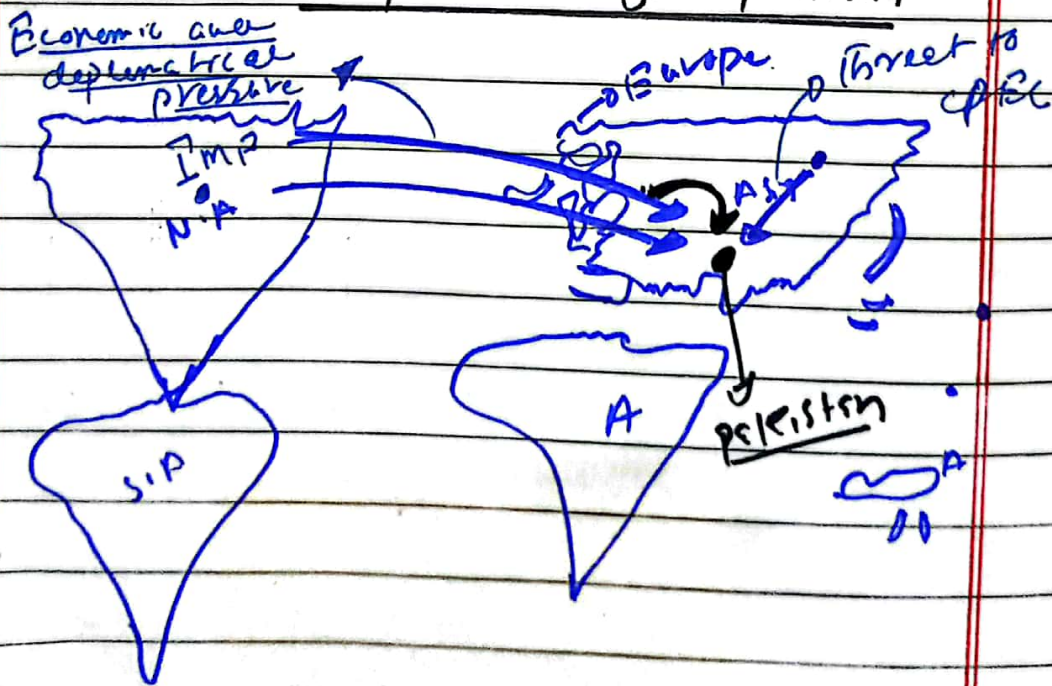
Due to economic hurdle, Pakistan cannot give attention to terrorism. Therefore

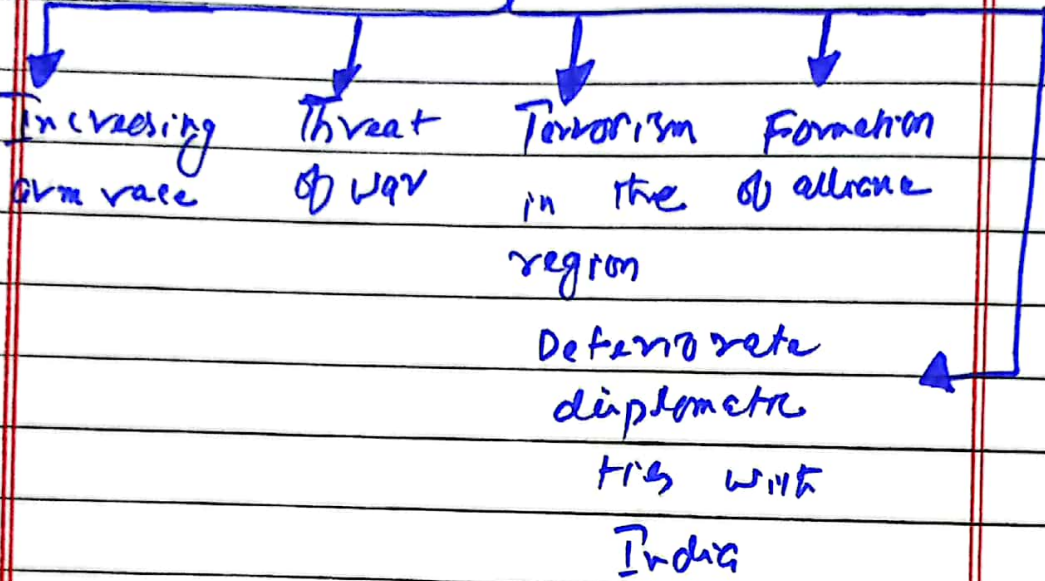

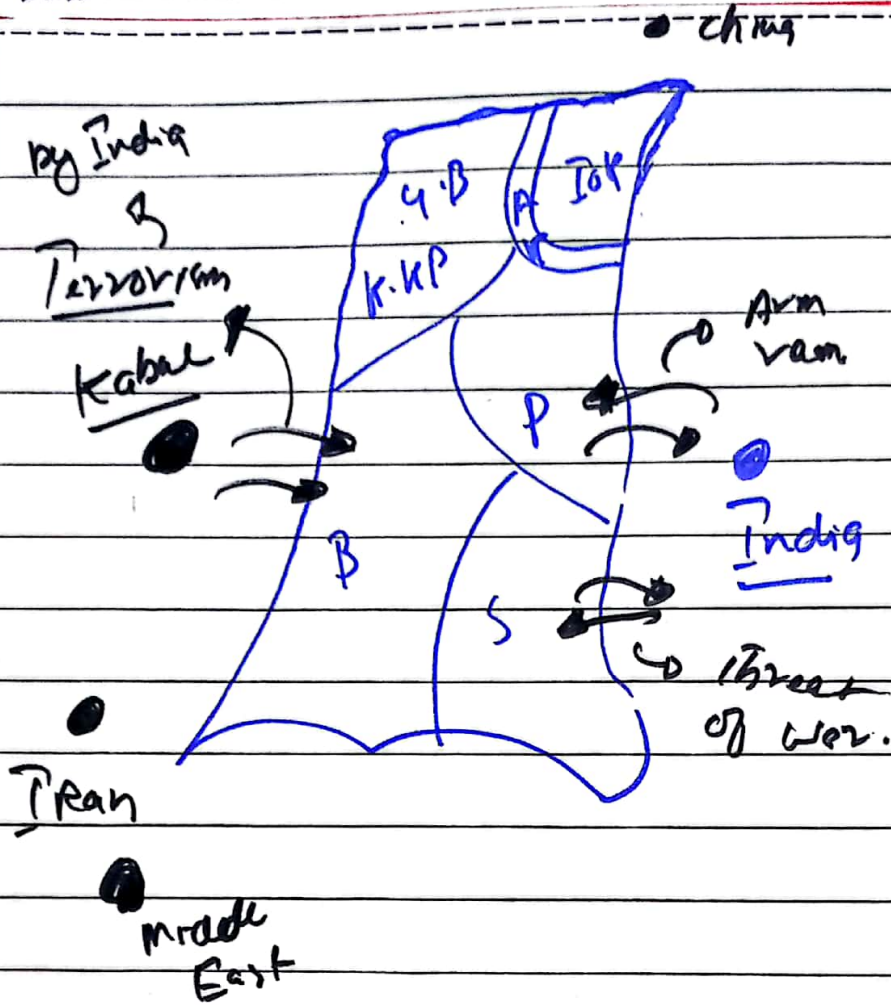

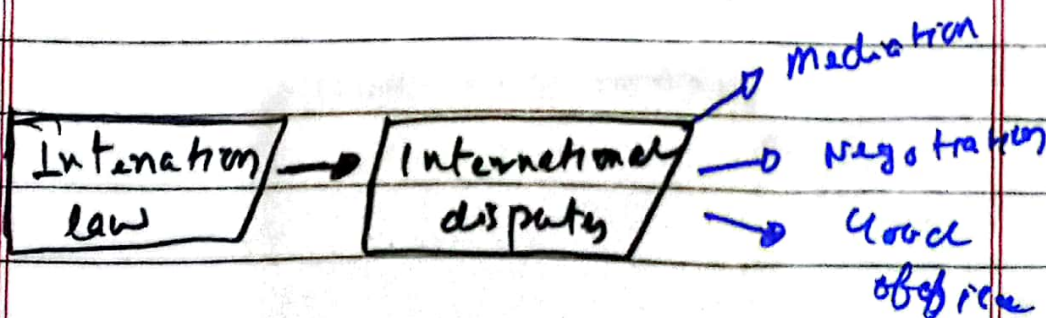
Conclusion

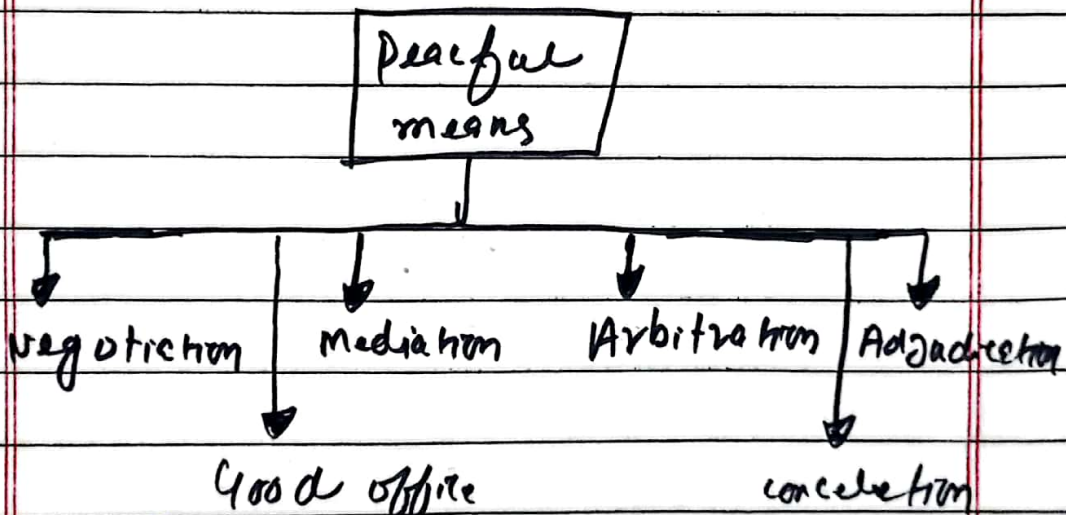
Q Introduction:

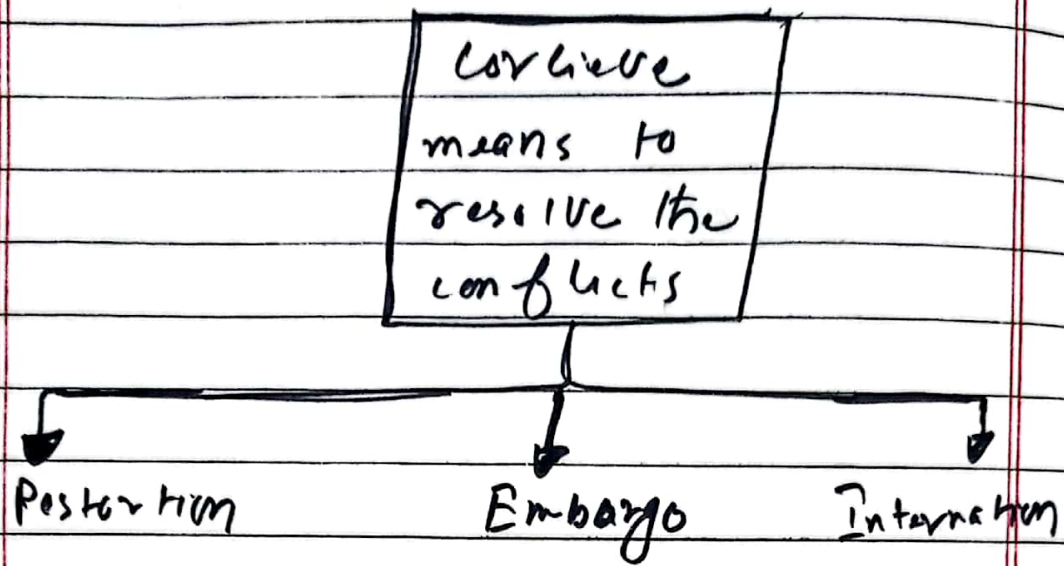
