3- Educational aspect of Aligarh Movement

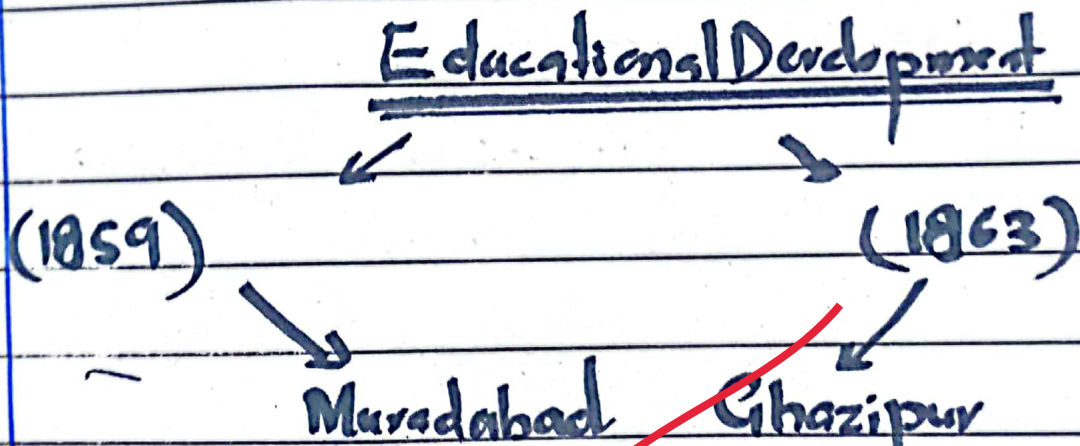
Following were educational significances:

 knowledge.'

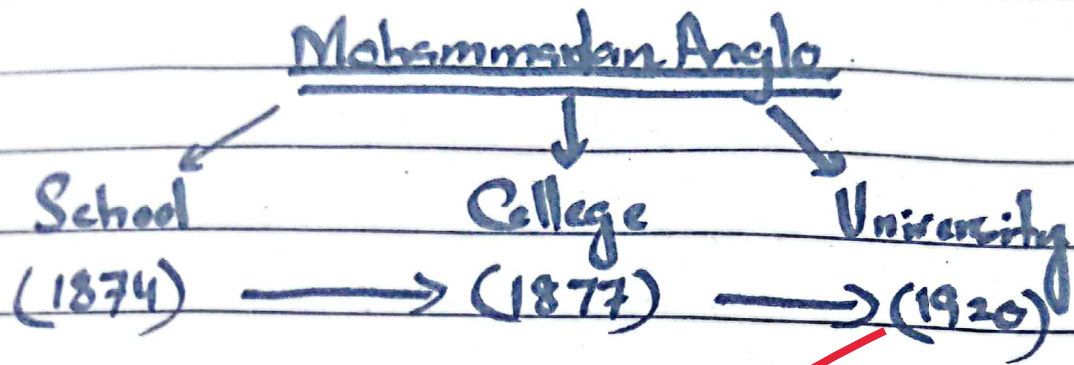

part in politics."

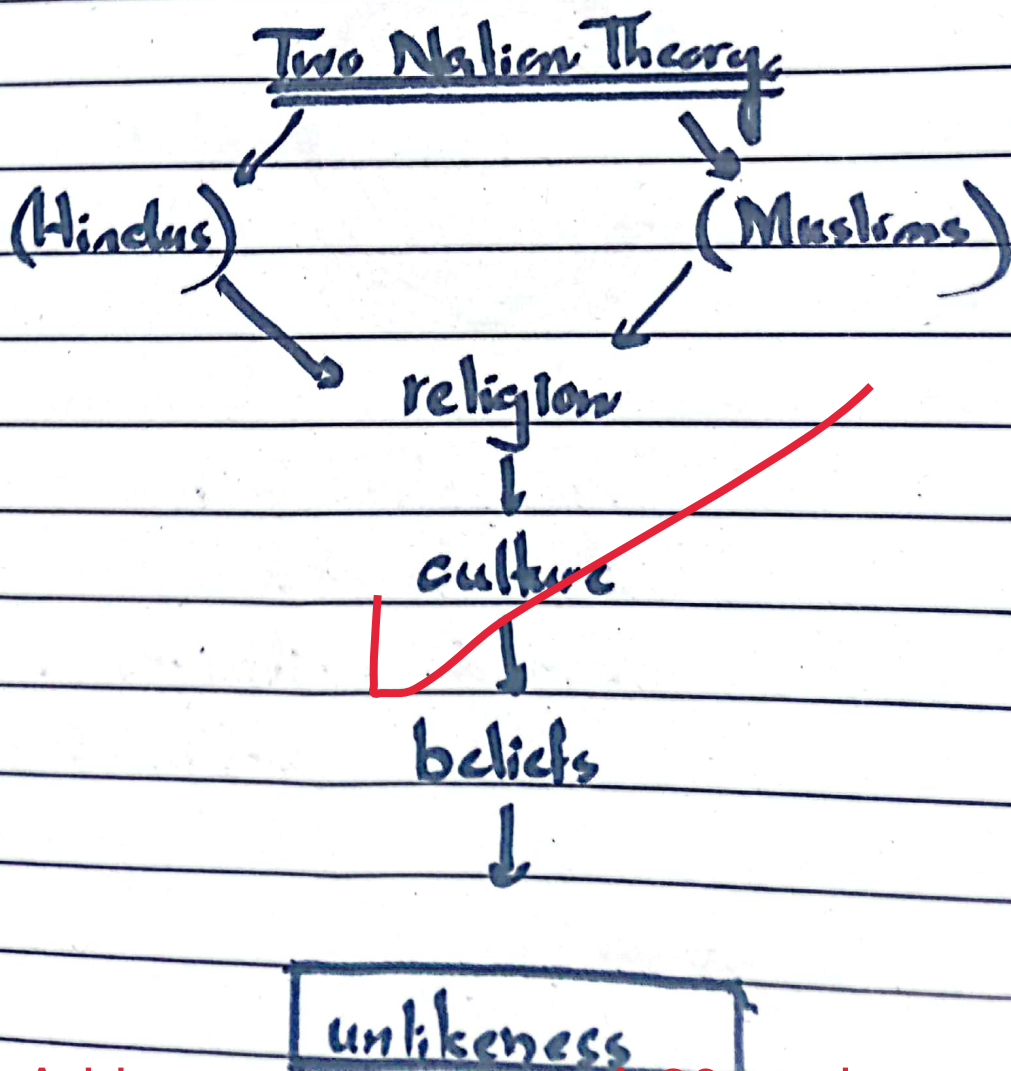

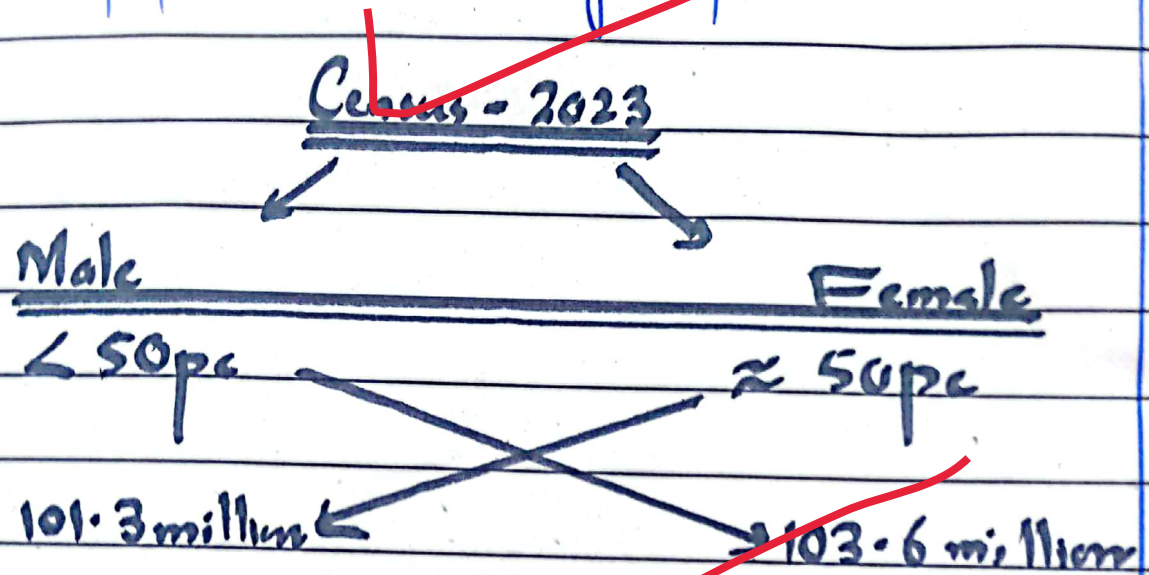

3- Population bomb: Economic condition of the country

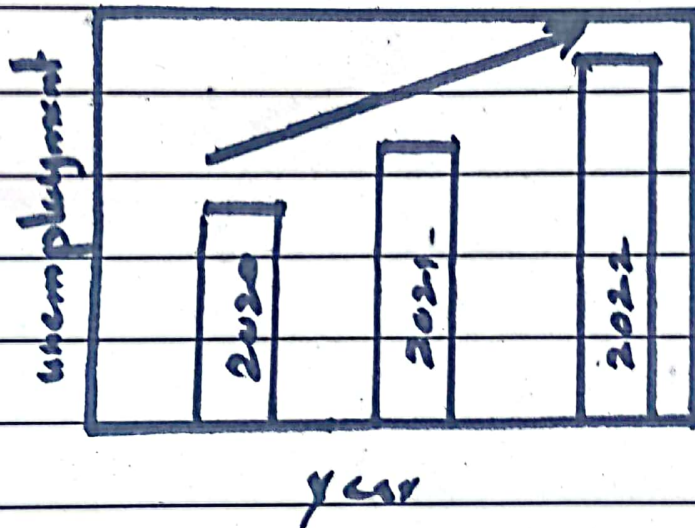
Population explosion has following impacts:

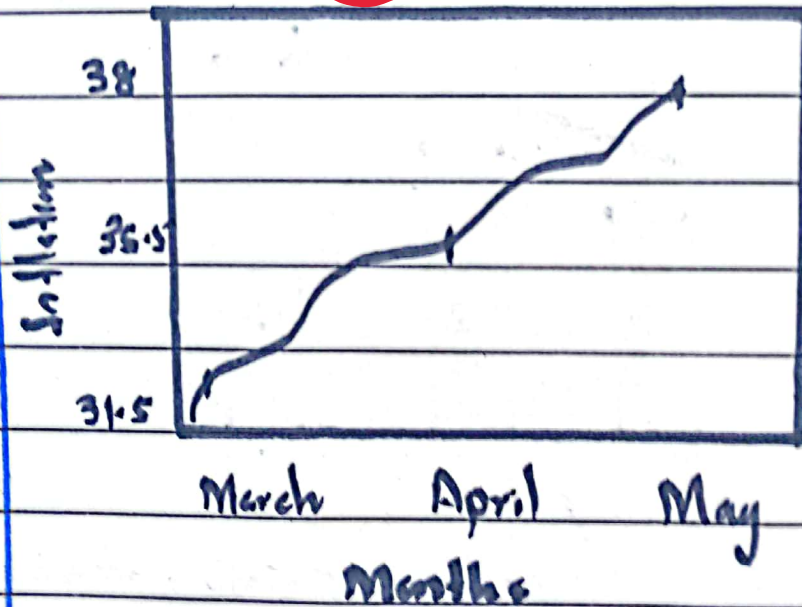

c) Growing Budget deficit of Pakistan

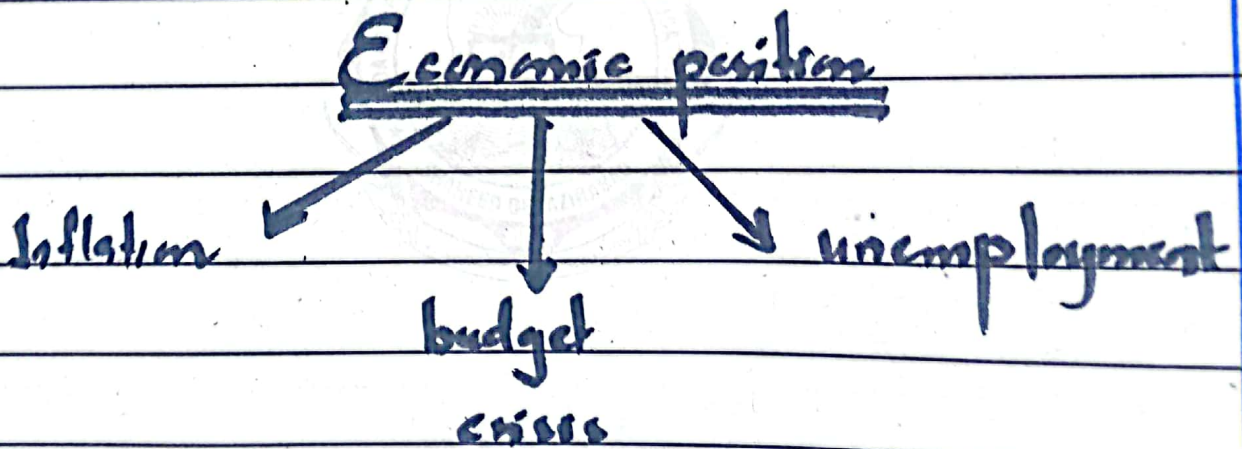
Pakistan also has

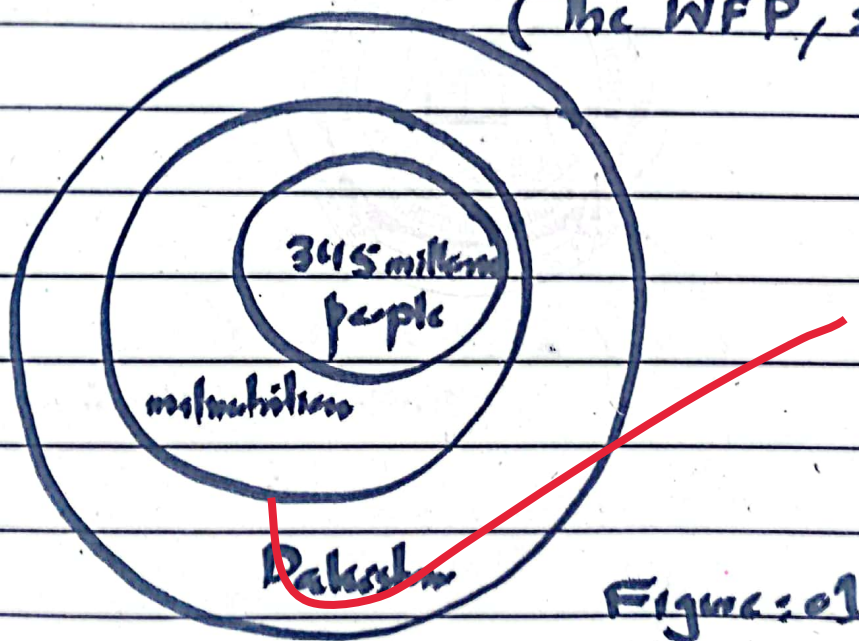

c) Increase in crimes rate in Pakistan

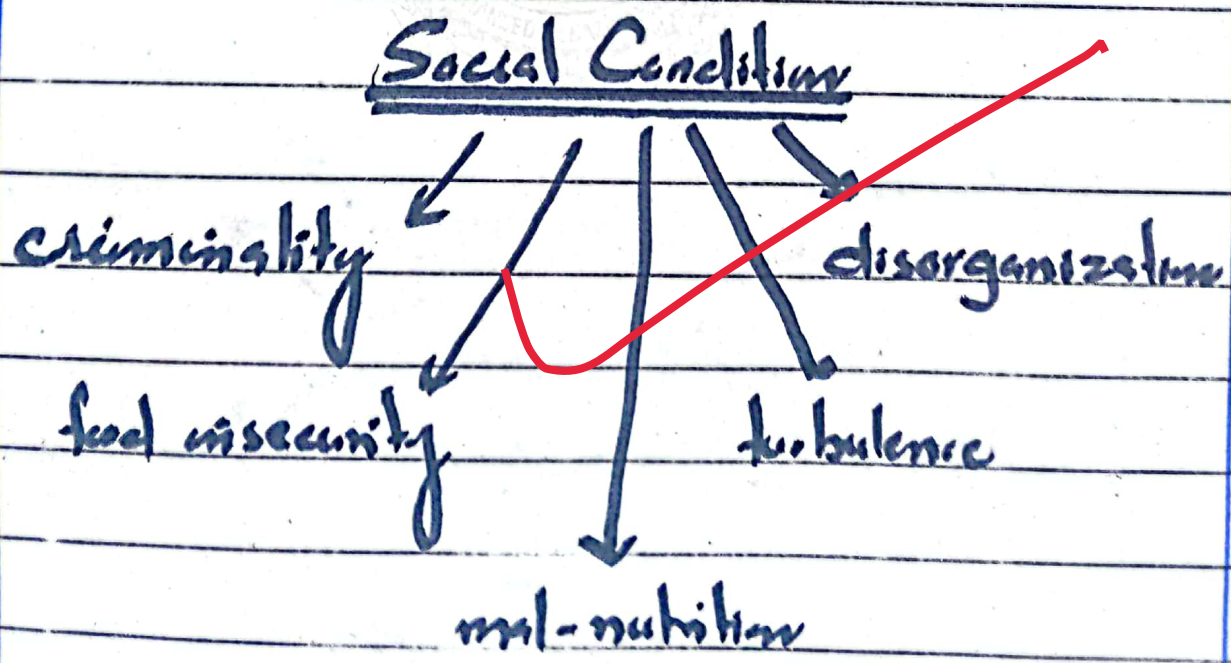

3- Factors behind economic crisis of Pakistan

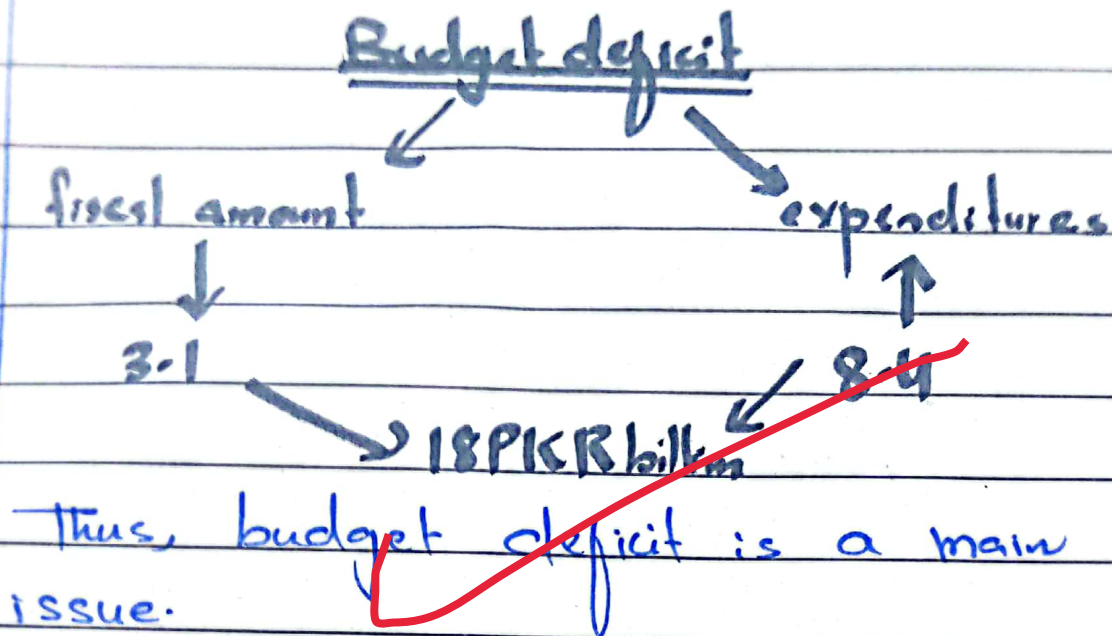
Following are factors:

Hence, PKR is devalued sufficiently.

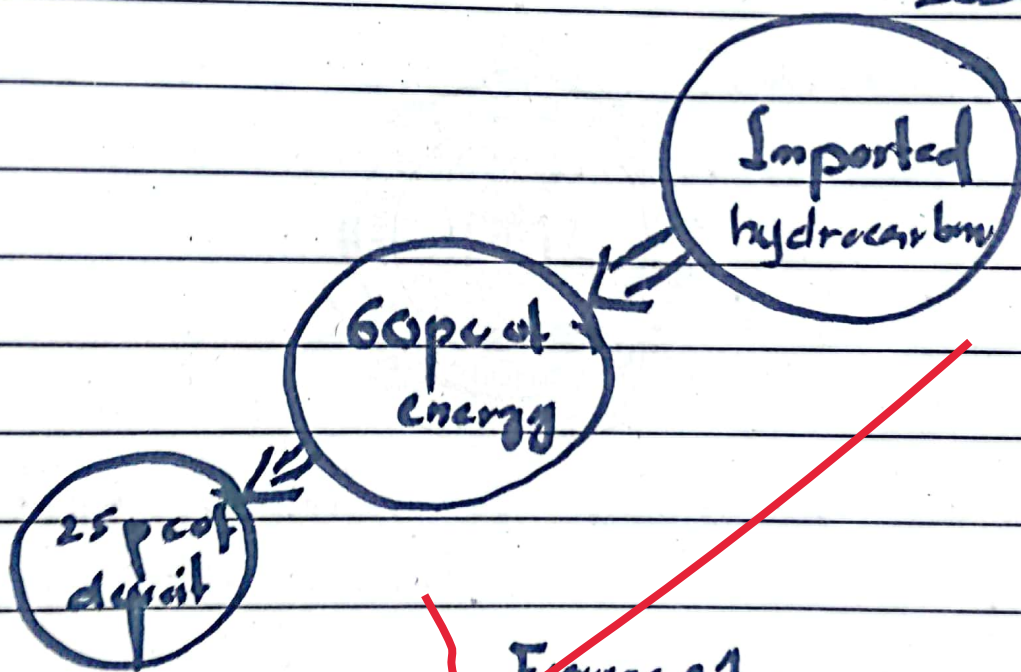
d) Imported hydrocarbon for energy

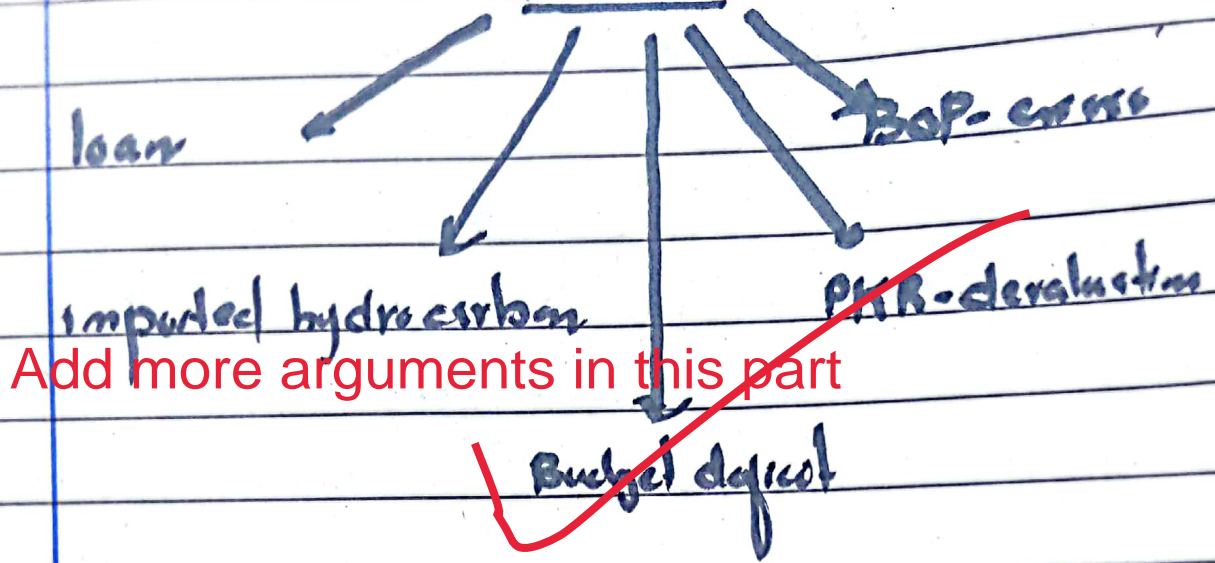

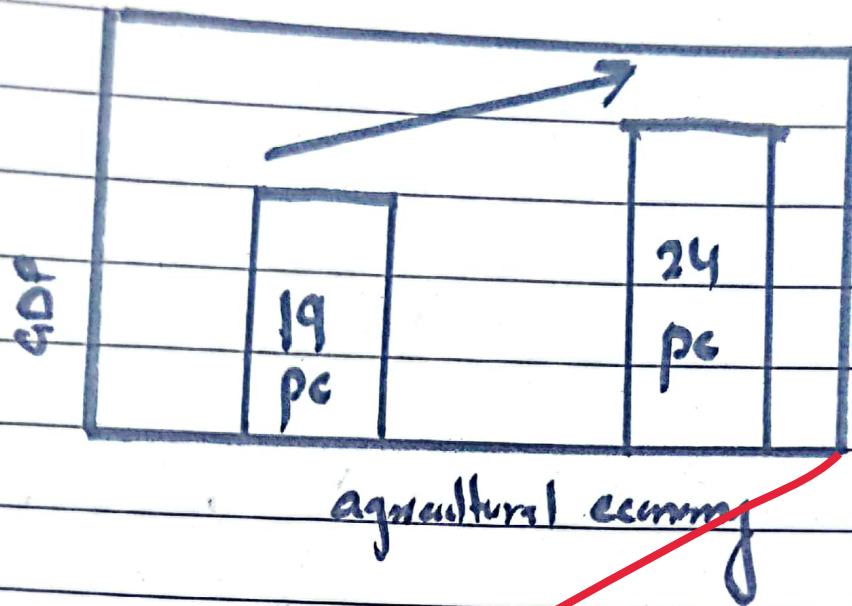

b) Reformation in industries

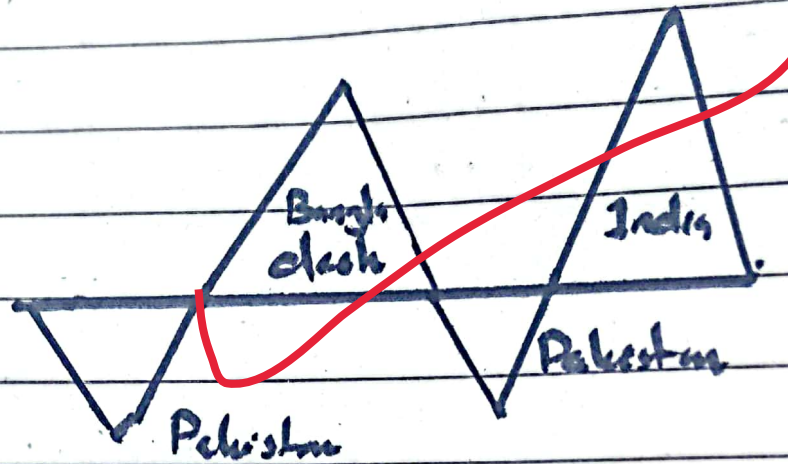
Along with agriculture, Pakistan also reform industries. Unfortunately, industries are going in massive decline.

2- China's stance on Afghanistan:

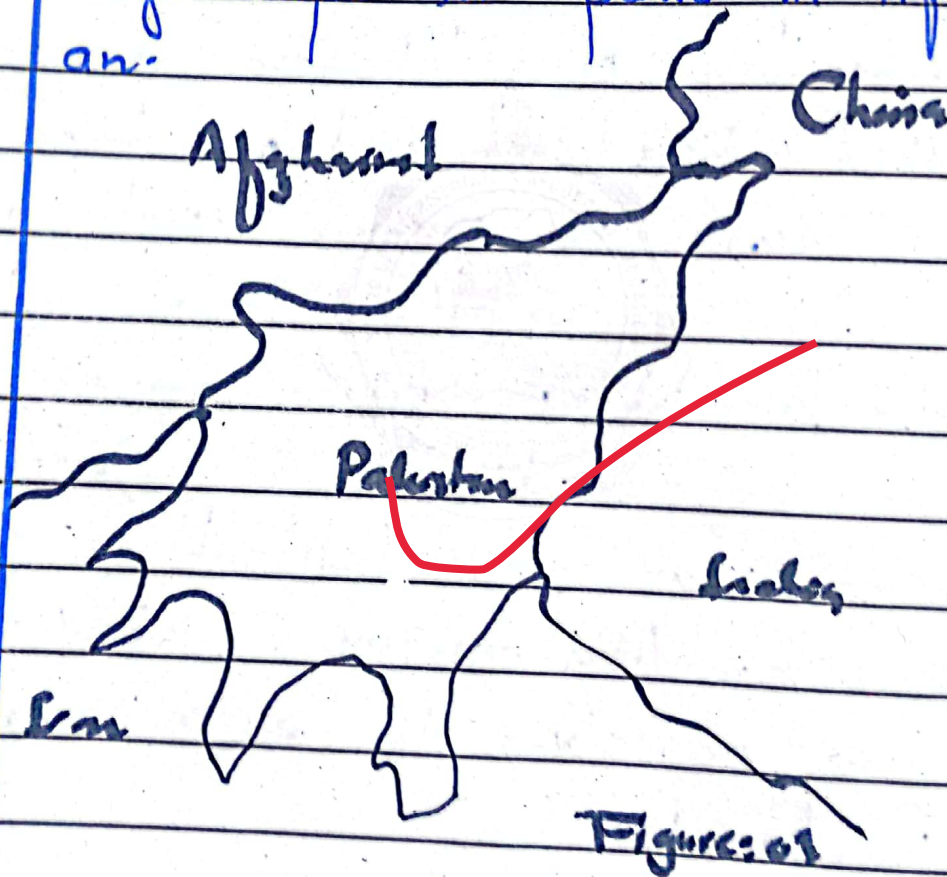

Thus, China has a huge interest regarding CPEC.

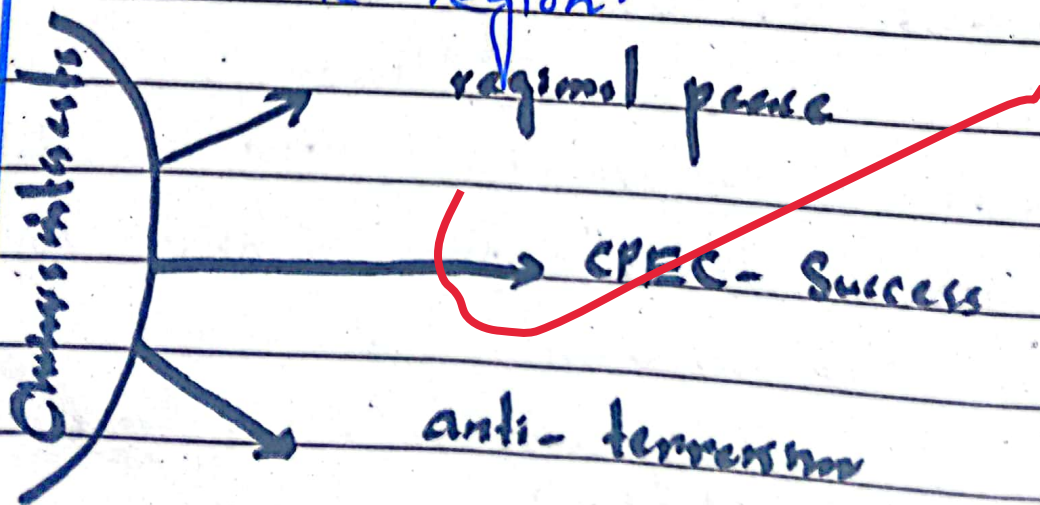
c) Say end to 'terrorism' in the region

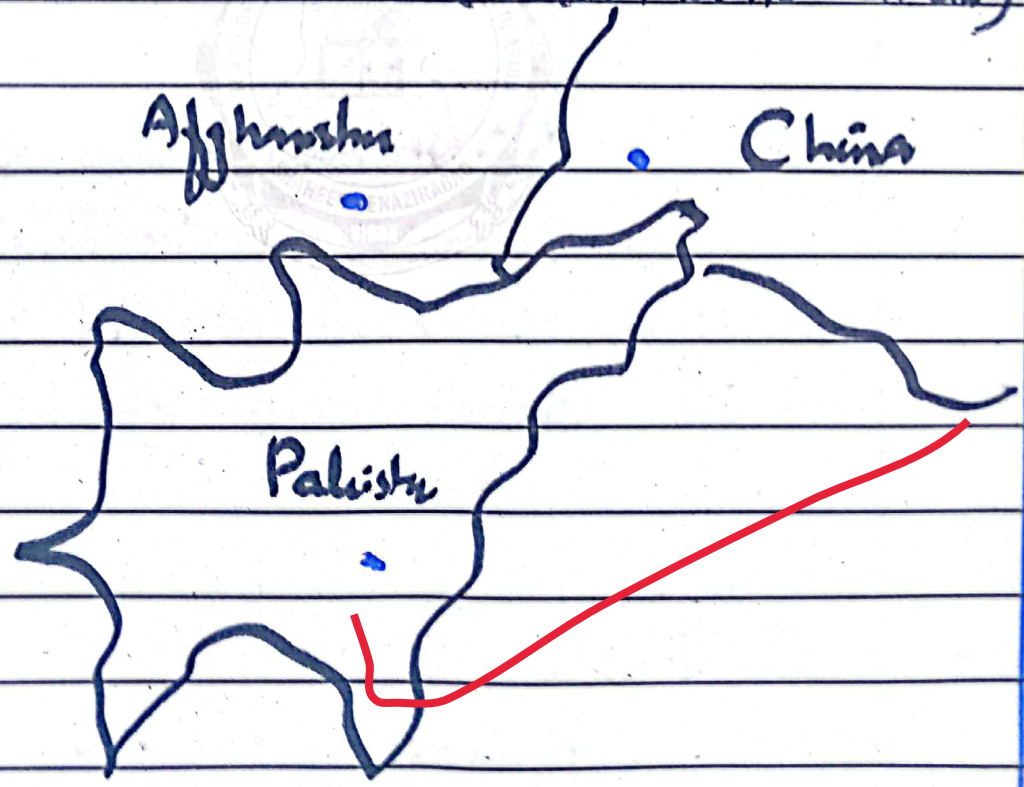
