Another approach that is popular in hybrid warfares is to initiate disinformation campaigns and propoganda in a bid to manipulate public opinion. A government or military that loses the support of its citizens is likely to collapse soon. The disinformation campaign disseminate false information in order to turn the public against its governing bodies. Reinforcing the thought, a similar strategy was adopted to ~~raise~~ induce hatred in the people of east pakistan against the ruling elite of west part of the country. It was only later ascertained that element of indian intelligence were actively disseminating manipulated information to stir up hostility. This ~~testo~~ grounded the seeds for further chaos and led to the creation of Bangladesh, hence manifesting the damage that misinformation can inflict.



Regional dynamics can play a vital role in prosperity of a nation or its downfall. There are a plethora of complex issues associated with regional dynamics, territorial disputes is one of these.
