Chapter VI which is Pacific Settlement of disputes should be followed and the conflict should be resolved.

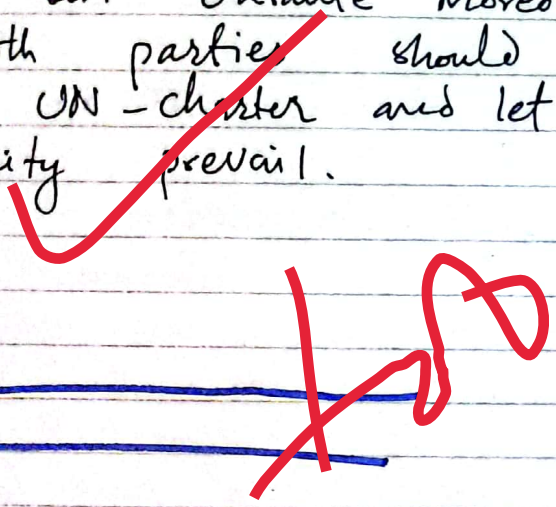
3.6) Follow the policy of Cooperation not Confrontation

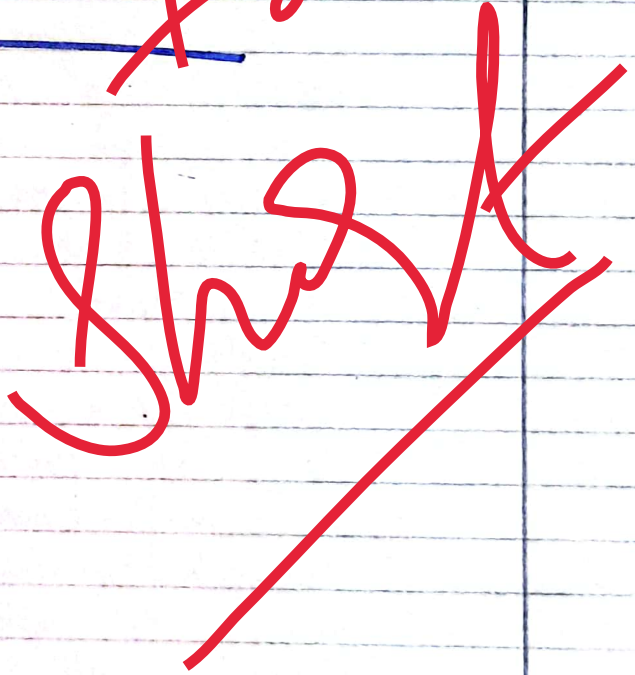
4) Conclusion
