The Role of Islamic state in Islamic Economy:

Islam considers economic relations and behaviour as ways of integrating society into a higher level of reality. The Islamic state considers economic attainment as a means not an end. The state in Islam is responsible for organizing a social life, creating a material and spiritual prosperity and spread of faith.

Islamic state is responsible for regulating, supporting and protecting economic growth and activity.

The state is the holder of the mandate of Allah and His messenger as well as the mandate of community to carry out collective tasks. It is creating welfare and for all people.
