in Islam:

Islam had laid down some fundamental
right for humanity as a whole
which are to be observed and enjoyed
under all circumstances whether a person
is resident within the territory of the

Islamic state or outside it. Human
rights are the fundamental rights. No one
has the right to abrogate these rights
or withdraw from them.

Women rights are also the basic
human rights, which shows the
status of women in Islam.

Status Of women in other religions or
Before Islam:

Before the advent of Islam, women
were deprived of the basic fundamental
rights like, the right to life and

and to live. women were burned alive, and men would consider a daughter as a source of dishonour.

Some religions had the status of women.

Hindu: women are considered as material goods, they have master-slave relation. They are put to death when their husbands die. Some time provided as prostitutes to priests (Hindu)

Chinese: female child was considered as humiliation. It was source of dishonour. While male child was celebrated.

Greece: Greeks would consider the women as embodiment of evil, and would be considered as evil.
