After Pakistan's independence in 1965, she ran for president of Pakistan. Due to her contributions to development of Pakistan and her efforts to promote social justice and equality she is remembered today. Her works did not show she was a frail woman.

Second comes Benazir Bhutto as an strong woman from Pakistan. ~~she~~ she was a prominent political leader. She had her Bachelor's degree in Political Science from Harvard and Master's in (PPE) from University of Oxford. She was daughter of Zulfikar Ali Bhutto, and after his execution in 1979, she led Pakistan Peoples Party (PPP). She made history as the first woman to lead a Muslim majority country when she became PM of Pakistan in 1988 serving until 1990 and then again from 1993 to 1996. She broke all the stereotypes. She was also strong supporter of women rights and promoted gender

equality through her policies. Her leadership encouraged women's participation in politics. She faced many political challenges and was exiled but did not lose hope and returned Pakistan in 2007 but she was assassinated in a shooting attack at her during an election rally.

Benazir Bhutto was a reshaper of Pakistan politics as a female leader in a predominantly male dominated arena. Her achievements and hard work show she was not weak.

On third we have Tehmina Mirza. She is a notable Pakistani politician. She holds ~~a degree~~ a degree in Bachelor of Arts (BA) and a Master's in Political Science. She ~~has~~ began her political career from Pakistan People's Party in 1980s. She held various important positions throughout career.
