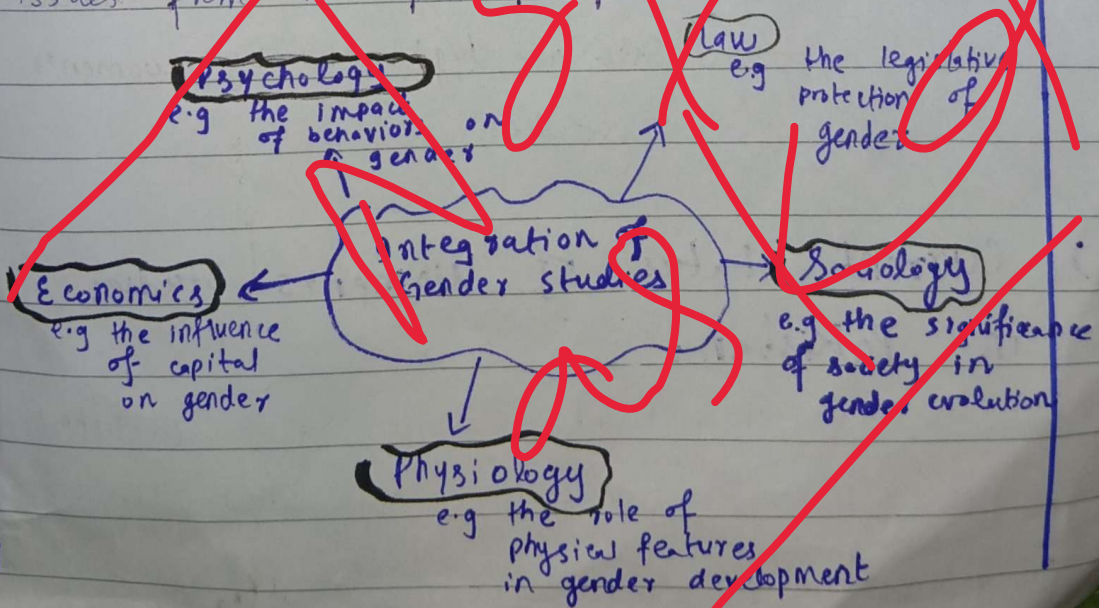

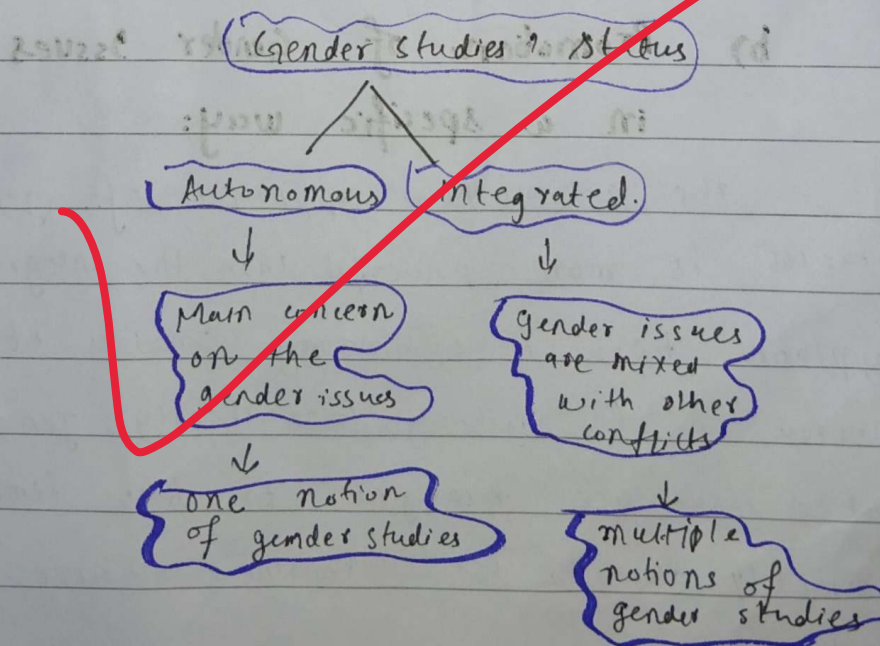
A: Introduction:

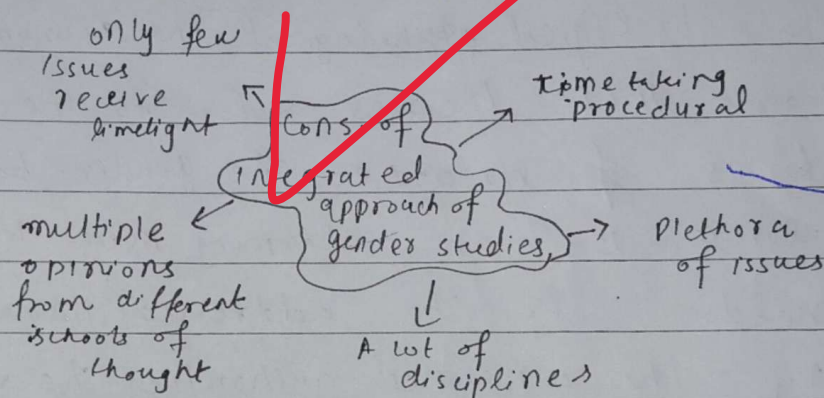

c: Types of Gender Based Violence:

There are three eminent types of violence,

D: Theories of Gender-Based violence:

The major theories regarding gender-based violence are discussed as follows;

a) Biological theory of Gender Based Violence:

The biological theory of gender-based violence states that the biological differences in the hormones and brain anatomy in men and female results in gender based violence.

b) Social Learning Theory:

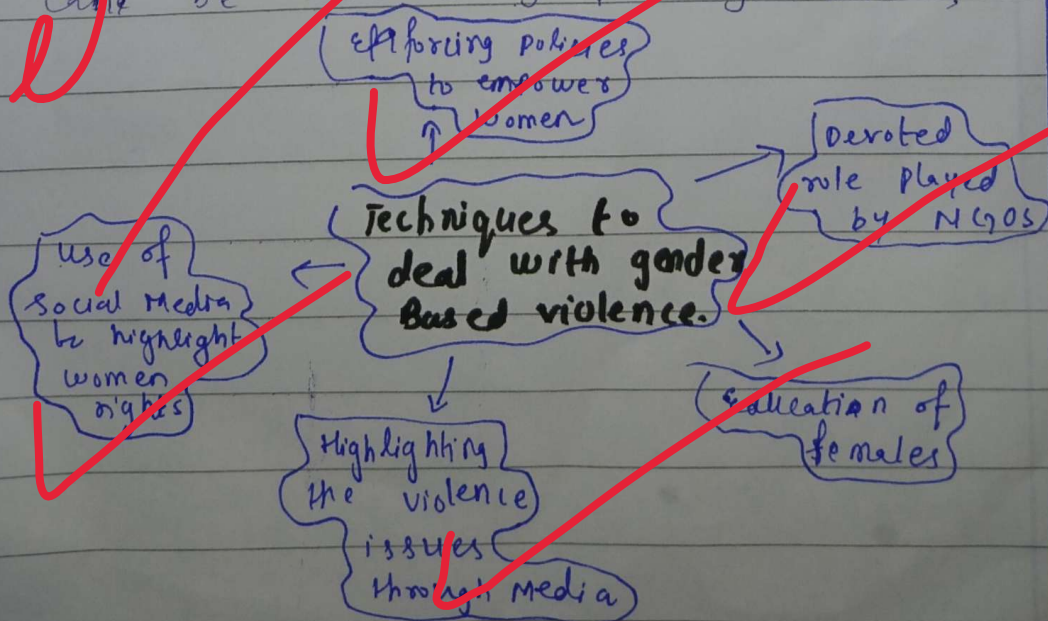
