The congress ministers of 1937 played a significant role in shaping the political landscape of the Indian subcontinent, Ultimately contributing to the demand for a seperate state for Muslims, which culminated in the creation of Pakistan in 1947. These ministries were formed under the . Government of India Act 1935, it was the first time that the Indian National Congress held power in several provinces across British India.

Background of Congress Ministries 1937:

In the 1937 provincial elections, the Indian National congress won six out of eleven provinces and formed government in these regions. The All India Muslim league, representing Muslim interests, performed poorly in these elections.

Policies And Actions of the Congress Ministries:

1- Promotion of Hindi and Hindu Cultural Symbols: One of the key grievances was the

This was seen as an attempt to impose Hindu culture dominance. 2- Muslim Representation and Employment: Congress ministers were accused of neglecting Muslim representation in government jobs and administration. Muslims felt marginalized in the government, leading to a perception that congress was a party inat primonily represented Hindy interests. 3- Warda Scheme of Education: The introduction of warda Scheme, which emphasized the teaching of Hindi and the use of the spinning wheel (charkha) in education, which was seen as another attempt to promote Hindu values in schools. Muselims viewed this an effort to assimilate them into Hindu culture. 4. Congress's Refusal to share Power: The congress's refusal to include the Muslim league in provincial government



led to increase communal tensions.
