## 2- Concept of Doctrine of Tauheed in Islam:

### 2.2 Terminological Meanings:

In terminological sense, there is no deity except for the Almighty Allah. He is alone worthy of worship and all kinds of praise. He has no beginning and no end. He has created everything from scratch without the help of any other being and He provides sustenance for all living creatures.

The Holy Prophet (PBUH) described the concept of Tauheed in such a beautiful way which means that:

"It is the believe in Allah, His angles

1- Oneness

#### 4.3 The Companions of Prophet Perspective on importance of Doctrine of Tawheed



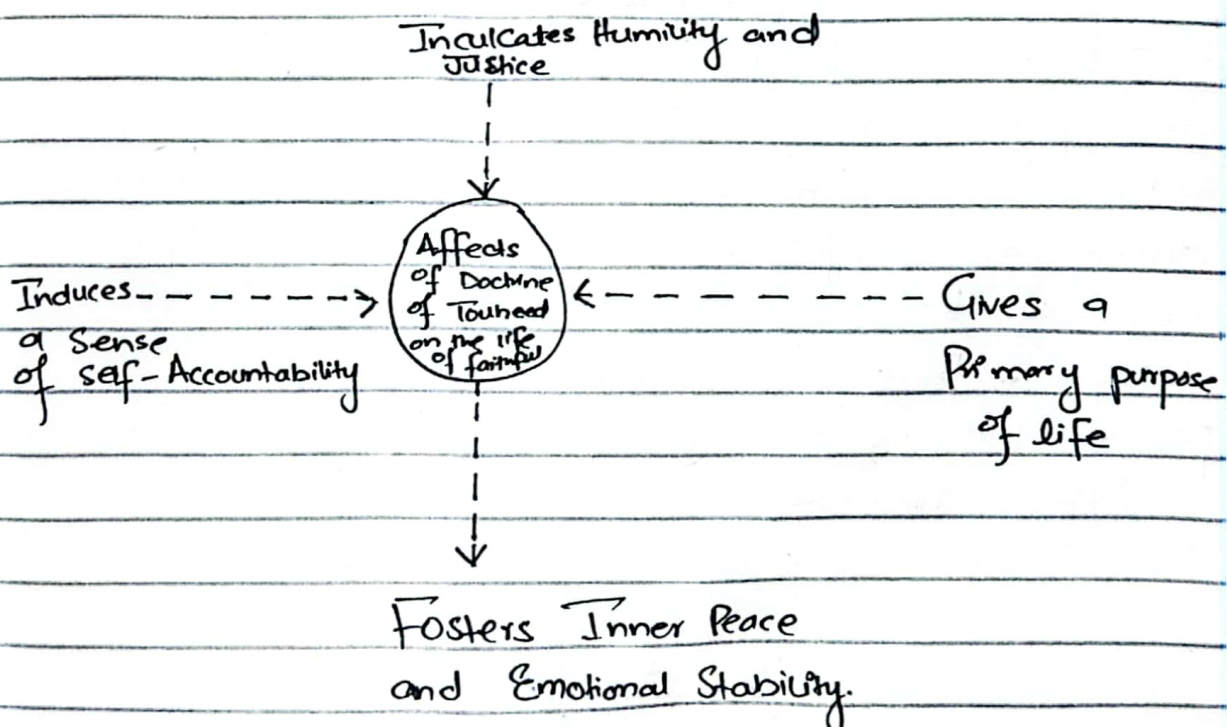
