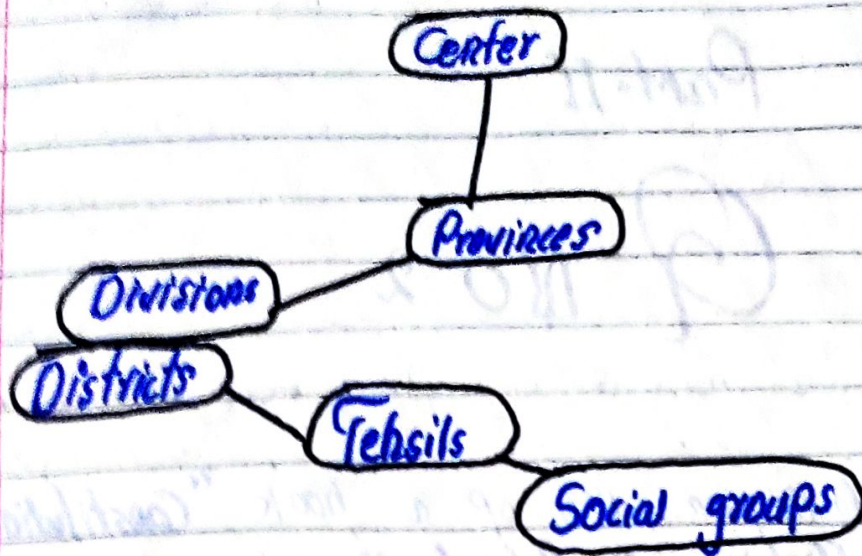
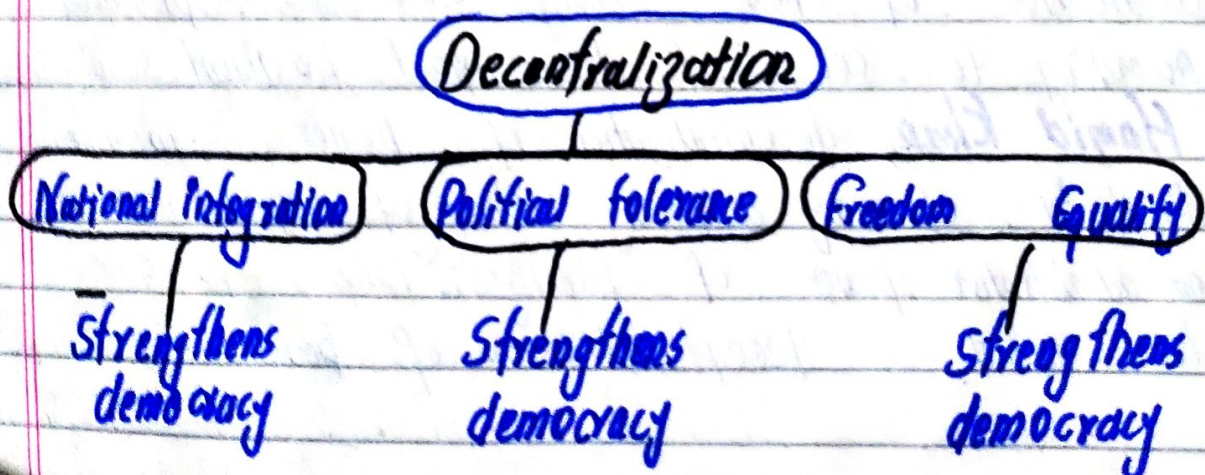


Figure 0.1 transfer of the Power among different stakeholders
