



Introduction

Israel has violated international law by causing civilian casualties, and it ~~has~~ ~~even~~ continues these atrocities in the name of self protection. The draconian acts of Israel are condemned by international organizations including ICJ but due to continued backing of US, Israel is still involved in genocide. These complicated situations are compromising relations with Arab world. War crimes of Israel has produced deep resentments among public. Hence, cooperation needs cooperation of international organizations and political will from major powers to bring peace-driven solution.

① Continued humanitarian crisis

Israel's actions on the Gaza strip have produced several humanitarian crisis such as famine, water crisis, health insecurity, education impairment. The blockade of aid by Israeli forces have resulted in hunger crisis. Israel has attacked schools, hospitals, refugee camps, converting Palestine into rubble.

② Violation of international law

The international law violation include actions against human rights such as civilian killing, destruction of civilian infrastructure, use of force against public and keeping people deprived of their basic fundamental rights. Israel has committed all the actions that clearly violate the international law.

③ Israel's efforts of genocide

Israel has crossed all red lines of atrocities. It has ~~targeted~~ targeted women and children at an alarming level. Israel wants complete destruction of Palestine and establishment of only one state. According to UN Report, 70% of those killed in Palestine were women and children. It means nearly 7 out of 10 victims were children and women.

④ Statements by International organization

Israel has faced severe backlash and criticism. Multiple international bodies have condemned Israel's actions. Recently, Amnesty International presented stark conclusion regarding situation in Gaza:

"This is Genocide, it must stop now!"

Counter-arguments by Israel

Israel argues that actions conducted by its government are self-defence and it attacks on Hamas' infrastructure. They claim that military attacks on Palestine target Hamas only, not civilians.

Decisions of International Court Of Justice (ICJ)

However, legal decisions of ICJ face challenges of implementation as it lacks the specific institutions for enforcement mechanisms.


Response Of US Government

Criticism on stance of US government



Impacts on relations With Arab World

The Israel's continued coercive measures in Palestine creates a complicated situation in Arab world, straining its ties of cooperation.



① Growing geo-political tensions

The Arab countries with pro-Palestinian sentiments face severe pressures from public protests. Israel's actions in Gaza strain its relations with Arab world. Countries like Egypt, Jordan, which have signed peace treaties face backlash to condemn Israeli atrocities. The kingdom of Saudi Arabia, was exploring normalisation ties with Israel but it has paused such talks due to public and political pressure.

② Abraham Accords

Abraham Accords was signed between Israel and Arab countries to normalise their relations. Arab countries like UAE, Bahrain are now facing criticism for ^{deep} silence on Israel's genocide on Palestine.

Strengthening anti-Israel alliances

Several anti-Israel groups such as Hezbollah from Lebanon, Houthis from Yemen, Hamas are gaining emotional support, as they portray themselves as defenders of Palestinian rights. Iran has used this as an opportunity to counter U.S influence in middle east.

Impacts on Arab-US Relations

The US support for Israel alienates key Arab and muslim allies. The consistent supply of armaments, economic aids and political support by U.S, undermines US credibility in Arab world. Outrages by muslim nations, & mass public protests have weakened Arab-US ties.

① Ongoing hostilities and grievances

The continued atrocities of Israel on lands of Palestine has produced deep resentments. They would continue due to resolved conflicts on blockade of Gaza, settlement and expansion of Israel and disputes over Jerusalem.

② Mass casualties

Israel has killed almost 48000 civilian including mostly women and childrens. These actions of destruction of schools, hospitals and other infrastructure have displaced millions of Palestinians. They are coupled with Hamas retaliatory actions to continue its influence. These attacks from both sides have produced a cycle of endless violation.


③ Hamas' Political Pressures

Israel-Palestine Conflict

A major supporter of Hamas and Hezbollah is Iran, that can encourage the escalation of war. Iran plays strategic role to counter influence of Israel and

the US in the region. Iran's support can broaden the conflict, particularly through Hezbollah in Lebanon, and other militias in Iraq and Syria.

⑤ Involvement of Arab-states

Arab Nations have normalized relations with Israel through Abraham Accords. UAE, Morocco and Bahrain face significant public pressure to support Palestinian cause. Saudi Arabia also strived for normalization of relations but it faced severe criticism. Hence, their silent stance produces a vacuum for Israel continuing its draconian measures.

⑥ Role of Global Players

The US pledged strong support through military and economic aid. It has protected Israel on various International forums by use of Veto.

Russian and Chinese opposition to the US and Israeli policies may encourage them to back Iran or other actors indirectly, exacerbating the war.

④ Triggers for regional escalation

The direct attacks on holy places like Jerusalem may trigger war escalation and regional instability.

Solutions to reduce expansion of war

① Immediate ceasefire

The continuation and expansion of war may be controlled by immediate ceasefire deal through use of mediators such as China, Qatar. It requires adequate will from global powers to reach an agreement and produce solutions for grassroot causes of conflict.

② Two-state solution

The Israel and Hamas should start negotiations with involvement of international peace organization. They must hold talks to produce solutions like two-state solution for both Israel and Palestine.

③ Economic and social support for Palestinians

The socio-economic support for Palestinians to address poverty, unemployment, diseases, famine and water-scarcity may reduce their grievances. Millions of people in Gaza are in need of food and clean water. Through economic aid, the global states must reduce their resentments.

④ Addressing root causes of conflict

The Hamas-Israel war may be stopped through addressing root causes such as border conflicts, illegal Israeli expansion and protection of holy place, Jerusalem.

Conclusion

The continuation of Hamas-Israel conflict is due to entrenched grievances, political pressure of Hamas and cyclical violence. The chances of regional expansion are due to global players such as Hamas, Hezbollah, Iran and Arab states. However, they can be stopped through international diplomacy such as involving UN, US and regional powers.
