

after Oct 7 2023 had led new insecurity wave

↳ Israel aggressive stance and patronizing behavior of Israel → has brought the middle east to the brink of a new period of instability

Three main scenarios in the region:

DATE: / /

1) Worsening security Crisis:

Israel ~~has~~ Aggressive stance, and ~~Viets~~ ^{Continues Attacks.} in Gaza and Hezbollah.

Israel \Leftrightarrow Iran :

Intermittent missile exchanges,
targeted assassinations and cross border skirmishes.

Iran's Proxies :

- Hezbollah in Lebanon
- Houthis in Yemen
- Shia Militias in Iraq

Syria \rightarrow Battle ground for Israel-Iran military conflicts
Israeli airstrikes on Iranian position in Syria.

In Yemen \rightarrow Houthis attacks \rightarrow in the Gulf of Aden

(Red Sea) Supply chain Global oil supply routes.

The Complex nature of vicious cycles attacks \rightarrow Peace Process difficult for the regional and international Peace Process.

(Gaza, Syria, Lebanon) \rightarrow Violations of Humanitarian laws.

Disruption of global supply chain worried the great power - USA, U.S., Russia, E.U.

\rightarrow Strong Support of US to Israel \rightarrow Encourage US-Israel.

2) Formation of alliance:

Iran + Russia + China \rightleftharpoons Israel + U.S. + E.U

diplomatic, military balance, Balancing the regional power.

Where there is always war in Middle

East :

Ottoman Empire \rightarrow occupied whole middle East / western Asia

- Decline of ottoman empire, and occupation

Colonialism in Eastern Asia

Israel threatened the Yemen-Russian Proxy:


