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

Similarly, the society binds people in different norms but humour comes into action by breaking these norms. So, it connects people

socially, ethnically and linguistically.

Humour is also an important tool of communication deployed in Learning. It is used both in formal education i.e. classroom settings and informal education in the form of satirical humour. In classroom setting, a teacher who is funny is the most popular and loved one by the students. The class is more interactive as different forms of barriers are no more working. This allows the students to express themselves more openly without losing the decorum of the class. Moreover, humorous short stories and plays act as a form of learning, students are more interested in. Secondly, Humour can also be used to teach students informally.
