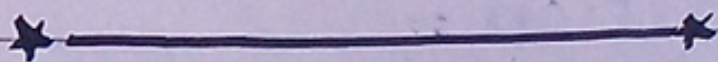

Foreman transition from boxing to business because he needed a stable source of income after losing his boxing fortune due to bad decisions.

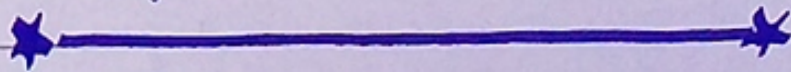
② What was the competitive advantage of the George Foreman Grill?
