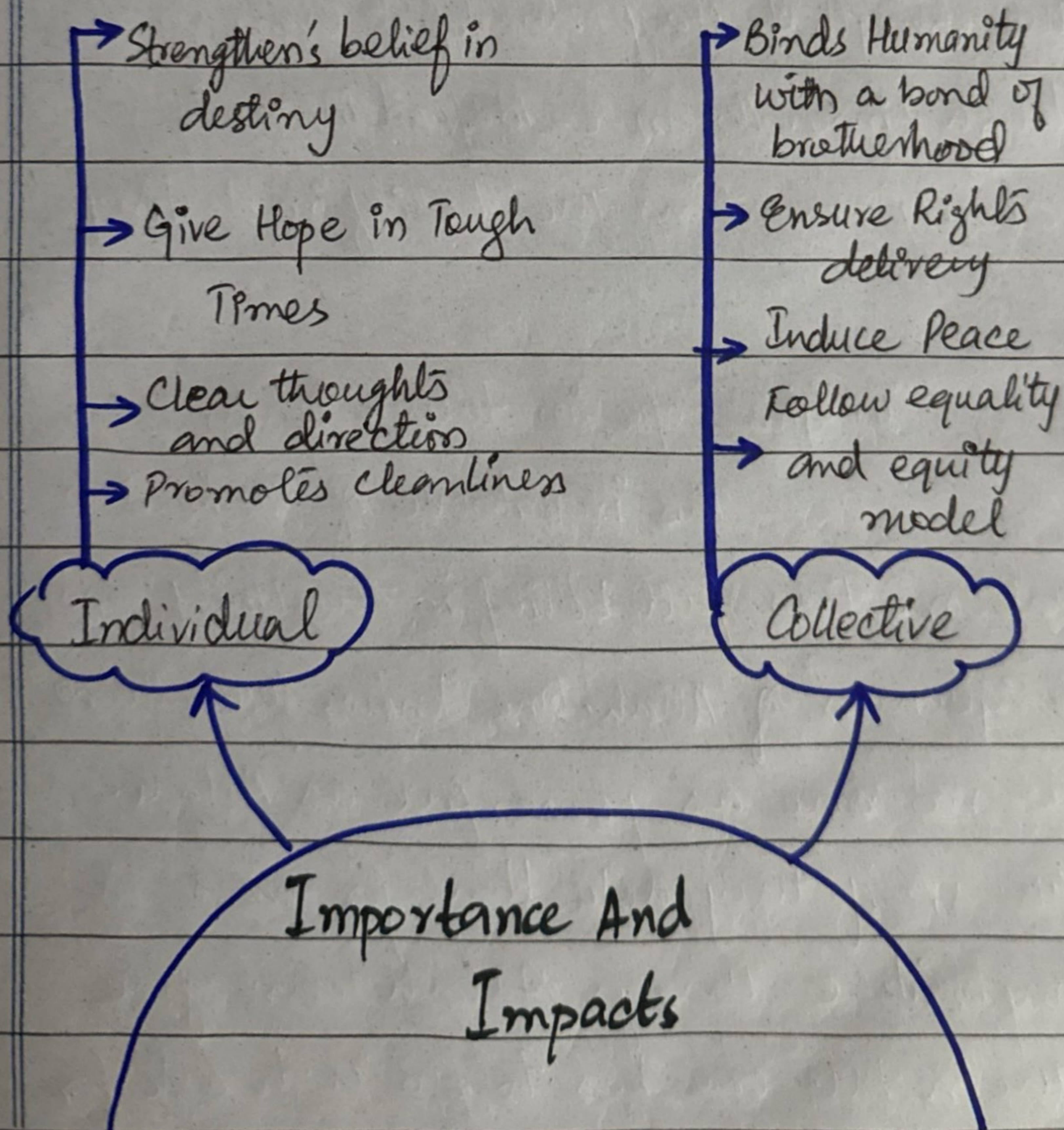

A. Importance of Zakat and its Ability to Alleviate Poverty

importance as it can help in eradication of poverty.

B. An Overview of Zakat

At another place the Quran says:

"Those who spend their wealth by day and night both publically and secretly will have their reward with their Lord"

The Holy prophet said that Zakat purifies wealth. Thus, it is of prime importance. It is to be paid on wealth in form of land,

jewels, agricultural yield, money and animals such as camels, goats and sheep.

c- Importance of Zakat

1) Purifies wealth.

Zakat purifies wealth. It adds Barakah to it. It enhances its efficiency. If a farmer pays zakat on his yield, Allah will add Barakah by increasing his production.

2) Amplifies in value

It is said in Quran that if you trade with Allah it is like you sow one seed of grain which produces multiple grains. Each shaft carrying multiple grains. Thus, this is how the wealth increases in value once Zakat is paid on it.

D- Ability to Alleviate Poverty

1) Zakat helps the poor quench needs

of zakat include:

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needy. The word used in Quran is:
"Maskeere". By giving zakat the
rich help the poor. Thus, easing
their problems.

2) Circulates Money from rich to poor

Unlike capitalistic model
where money is concentrated in
few hands, through zakat money
is circulated. Hence, increasing
the buying capacity of poor.

3) Reduces Inflation

Through circulation of
money the money increases the
buying ability of poor. As a result
the market performance increases
and, thus reduces inflation rate.

4) Encourages poor to start their own business

Through zakat if the poor are given enough money to set their own business or buy a taxi or rickshaw. Thus, they can pull their families out of ~~inf~~ poverty.

5) Creates Jobs: Reducing Poverty

These small set ups made through zakat funds can generate more jobs for other poor people. For instance a man starts a tea shop will need other workers. Hence, jobs are created which can reduce poverty.

6) Through Zakat ^{can} pay debts and can reduce poverty

Poor people instead of saving and upgrading their social status

can use the funds they got through Zakat for paying their debts. Once their debts are paid then they can use the saved money to pull themselves out of poverty.

E. Case Study: The Caliphate of Hazrat Umar

All the caliphs were very particular about Zakat. Hazrat Abu Bakr even wanted to wage war against those who denied the payment of Zakat. Until a time came when even the empire of Islam expanded to far flung areas, yet there was no poor on the land. People used to look for people who could take Zakat and there was none to be paid. Thus, Zakat can alleviate poverty and it can be seen from Hazrat Umar Caliphate era.

Zakat is a major component of Islam. It is compulsory on every person who has a wealth ratio defined in Quran. Zakat is vital as it purifies one's wealth and removes evil from it. It not only benefits the giver but also the taker. It is because of zakat that poverty can be alleviated from the society.
