Meaning: "Do you have doubt on the God who created Sky and Earth?"


Mohammad ﷺ said,

Guidance for Life


Tauheed provides a comprehensive world view encouraging submission to Allah's will.

Introduction :-



As a husband :-


Mohammad (ﷺ) was a great and exemplary husband. Hazrat Ayesha told about prophet that he said

"No one have supremacy on any one, all are equal in eyes of Allah"


One day Mohammad ^{peace} scolded a person because his camel was thirsty. This shows that Mohammad was concern for animal rights too.
