"There is no deity except Allah"


Tauheed has great importance in Islam, as all belief, worships and rituals are because of Tauheed. It has huge impact on life of human being, both on individual and collective life.

Meaning: "Do you have doubt on the God who created Sky and Earth?"

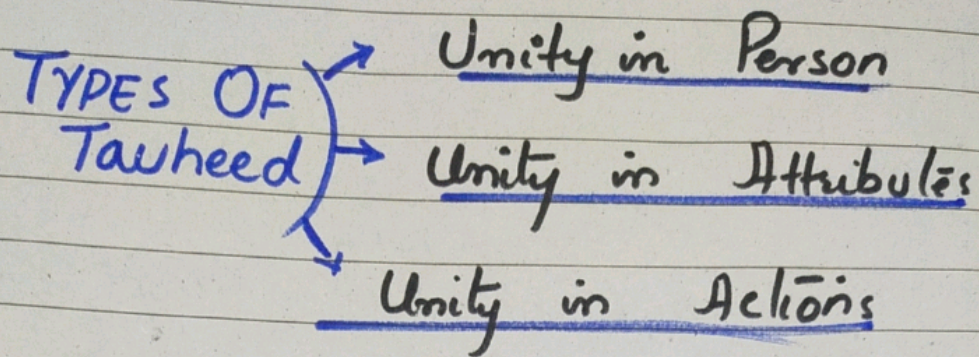
Mohammad  said,

“Tauheed is the first chapter of Islamic Syllabus.”


Core pillar of Islam:

Guidance for Life

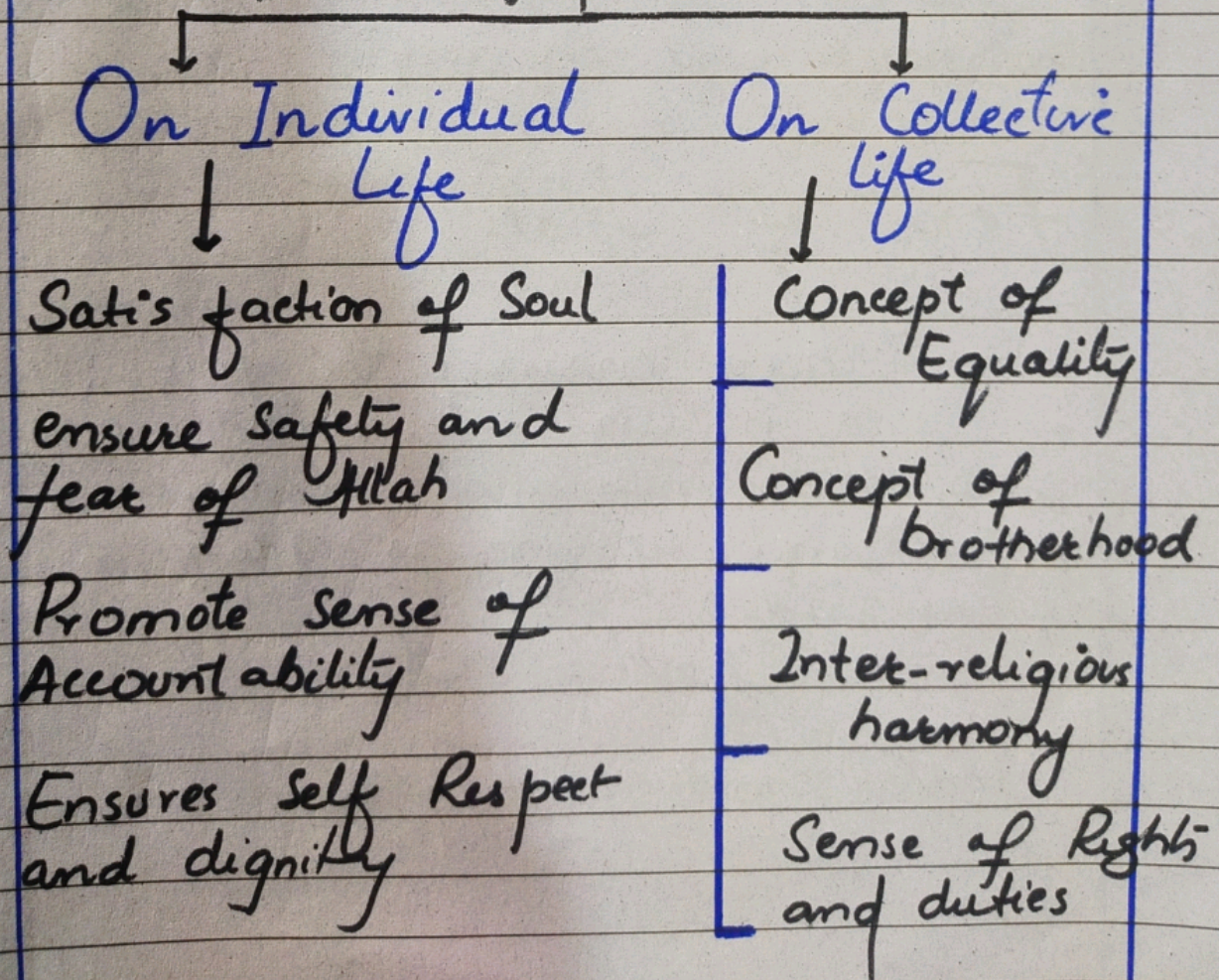
Tauheed provides a comprehensive world view encouraging submission to Allah's will.

Conclusion


Tauheed is fundamental pillar of Islam. It has immense importance in Islam. It impacts on every sector of individual's life. It discusses collective life as well.

As a husband:-

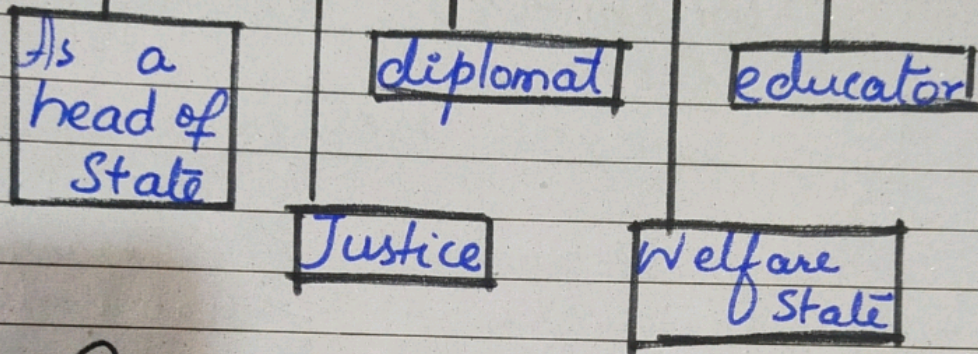
Mohammad (ﷺ) was a great and exemplary husband. Hazrat Ayesha told about prophet that he said


"No one have supremacy on any one, all are equal in eyes of Allah"
