General Ayul Khan's 1958 coup led to a concentration of power in militry, with the judiciary being grophed to Justify military decisions. Ayub Khan's government sought the approval of Judiciary for constitutional ammudments and desicions that aligned with the militarys interests. Notably, the Supreme Court of Pakistan under Ayub khan validated - he new 1962 constitution, which granted him sweeping powers as president. Similarly during General Kia-Ul-Hagy's military dictatorship, political influence over the judiciary grew, examplified by his dismissal of judges who were deemed insufficiently loyal to the regime. For example, Justice Yaqub Ali was porcefully removed from the office after he agreed
