Cognitive Perspective This theory was proposed by Lawrence Kohlberg about moral development. He qualyzed the criminal behavisor via faulty reasoning or moral disengagement. Individuals with low land of moral disongagement becomes victim and Sometime tend to commit crime. xamples in lakistan 1) Corruption among individuals with justification" Evenyone does it, or " It's necessary to sorrive in this system." Case: Widespread misuse of power in land acquisition scams, hand grabbers etc. Personality Theories: This theory was developed by Hans Eysenck that helps learn personality traits and crime. It shows that certain personality traits coch as high impulsivity and low conscientiousness, predispose individuals to criminal behaviour. He aggind that extroverts are more prove

to commit crime. Examples in Pakiston: 1) (dre ef domestic vidence, honour killing, cyler harraisment etc. Spain and Stress Related Theories: Augen and it says that shain or stress are caused by the mability to achieve accepted goals such as wealth and status. This leads to Frestation which may result in criminal behaviour.
