provide 90% of fuel to world.

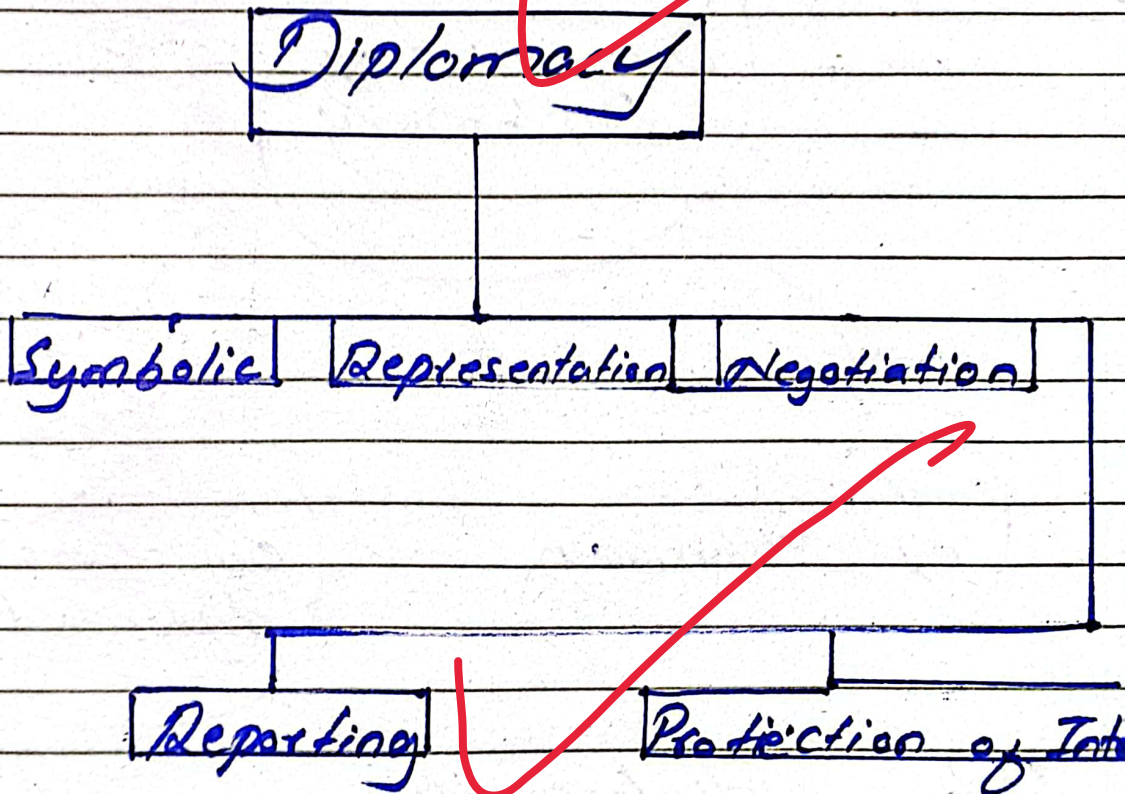

Concept of diplomacy and its dynamics:

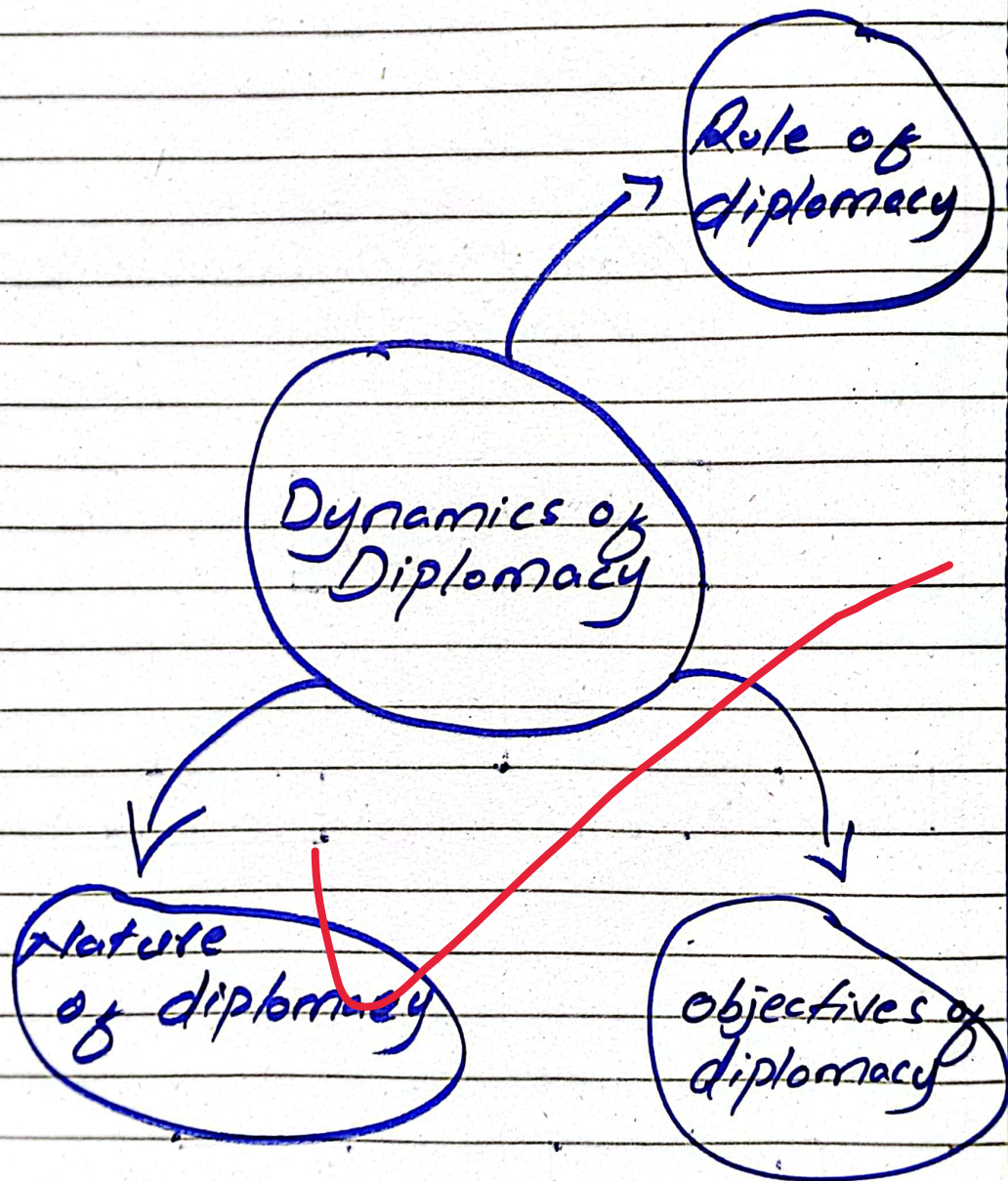
"Peace, like war can succeed only where there is a will to enforce it and there where is power available to enforce it"

Definition of diplomacy:

"Diplomacy is the management of international relations by means of negotiations; the method by these relations are adjusted and managed by ambassadors and envoys business or the art of diplomats?"



Role of diplomacy:

1. Symbolic Functions:

Diplomats of states are the symbolic representatives of their nation and Government in all official and non-official functions.

2- Representation:

Diplomats basically represents his state in the foreign state as normal agent of communication between his home office and that of state which he is accredited.

3- Negotiations

To conduct the negotiations with other states is a basic function of diplomacy. Through negotiation seeks to secure agreements and compromises over various conflicts and issues. Diplomats play crucial role in the International negotiations.

4- Reporting:

Reporting involves observation of the Political, economic, military and social conditions of the host country and accurate transmission of findings of the diplomat to his home country.

5- Protection of Interests

Diplomacy always work for the protection of interests of their state and people living in abroad.

Nature of Diplomacy:

1- Diplomacy is not immoral:

Diplomacy is neither act of deceit nor mere lies or propaganda.

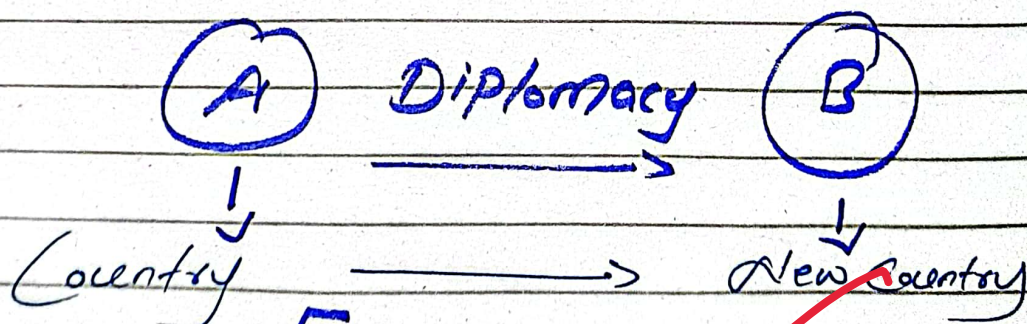
2- Tool to Secure interests

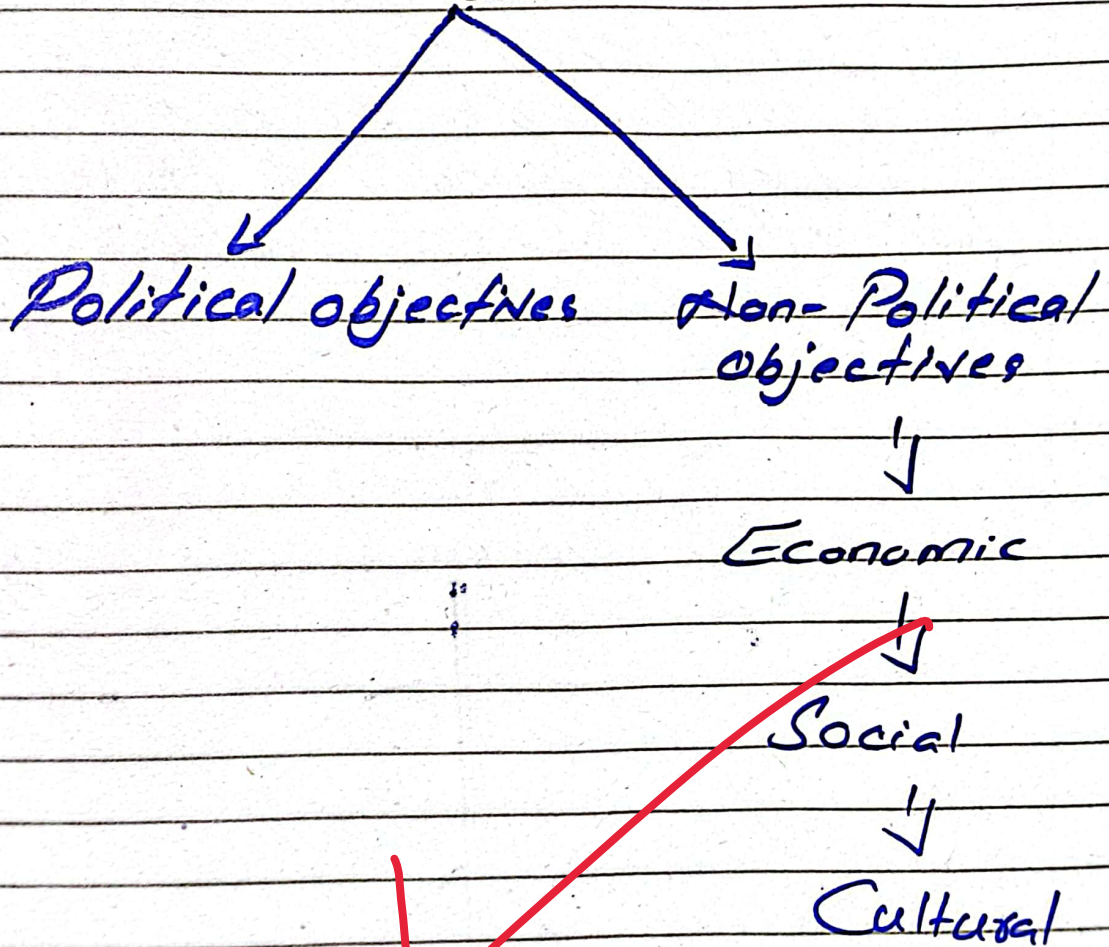

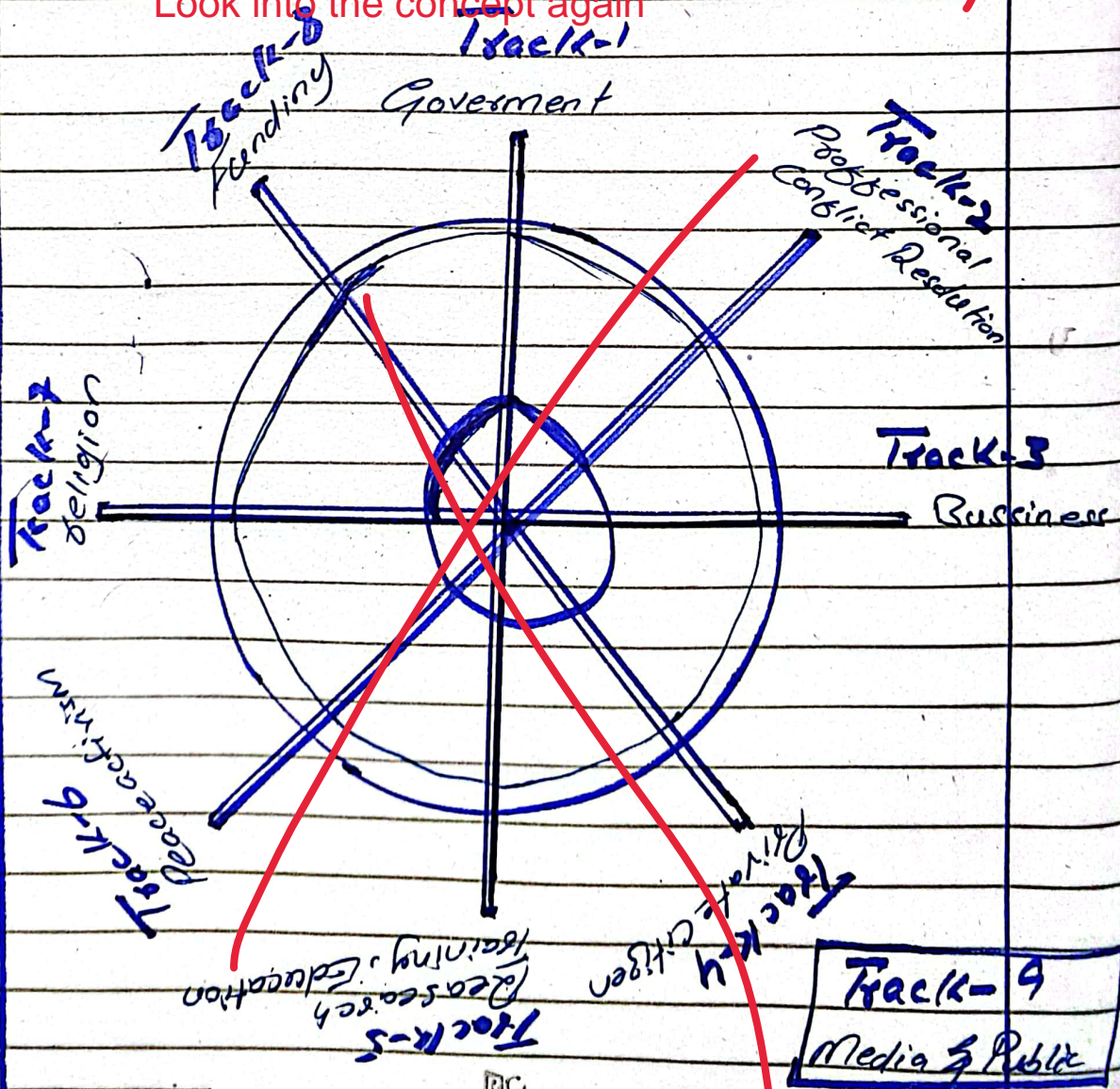

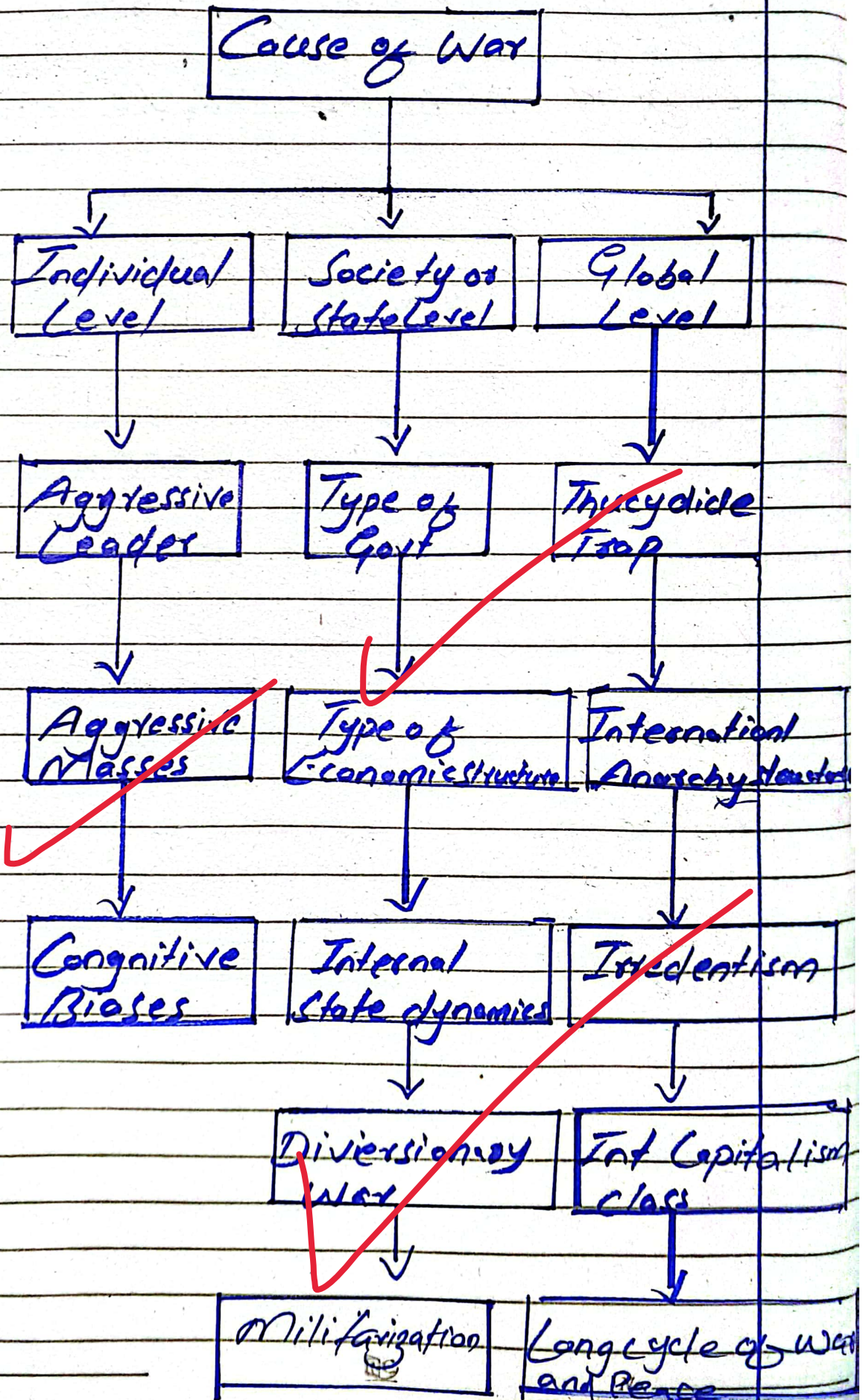

Understanding Concept of War:

War is a condition arising within state (civil war) or between the states (Interstate war) when actors use violent means to destroy their opponents or coerce them into submission. Traditionally, war is an act of use of military force of one state against another.

Causes of War and Middle East Crisis:

1- Individual Level causes of War:

a- Aggressive Leader:

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's aggressive Zionist thought led to the middle east crisis. Continuous war from the Gaza strip to Syrian territory Golan Heights are the result of aggressive approach of individual state leaders.

b- Aggressive Masses:

Aggressive masses is another cause of individual level of war. After the Syrian Civil War in 2011, several rebellion groups arose in Syria i.e. Hayat Tahrir al-Sham, HTS, Ahrar al-Sham, Free Syrian Army. All these groups collectively demanded democratic reforms, freedom and end of President Bashar al-Assad regime. Which created regional instability in the middle east and created a vacuum for Global Powers.

C. Cognitive Biases:

Middle Eastern States to the Israel defeat is the Cognitive Bias. Talking from 1948 till today Israel always dominated over the Gulf States. Saudi Arabia's co-operation with Israel may led to devastation of Middle east.

2- Societal or state Level Causes of War:

a- Type of Government:

Immanuel Kant have given ^{Peace model} theory called "Liberal Internationalism theory for Democratic Peace". Under democratic States will lead to War. Most of Middle East States (Saudi Arabia, Qatar, UAE, Oman) have Monarchy, Syria, Jordan Palestine have Partial democratic system which causes civil wars, foreign interference and eventually the whole region comes under the crisis.

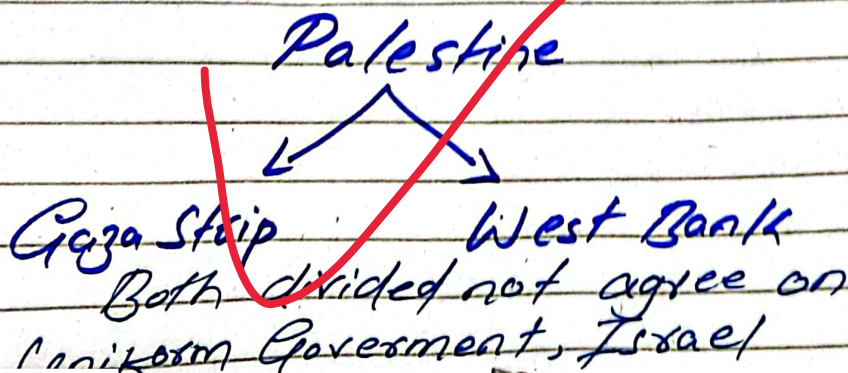
b- Type of Economic Structure:

Middle East Economic Structure may be divided into two types: Liberal, Commercialism and Free Trade, Saudi Arabia, UAE, Oman, Qatar falls in this category while Poverty, Underdevelopment, Syria, Palestine, Jordan, Egypt falls in the second category. The first category will not war as per the second category which depends on foreign aid mostly. This division also led to the Middle East crises.

c- Internal state dynamics:

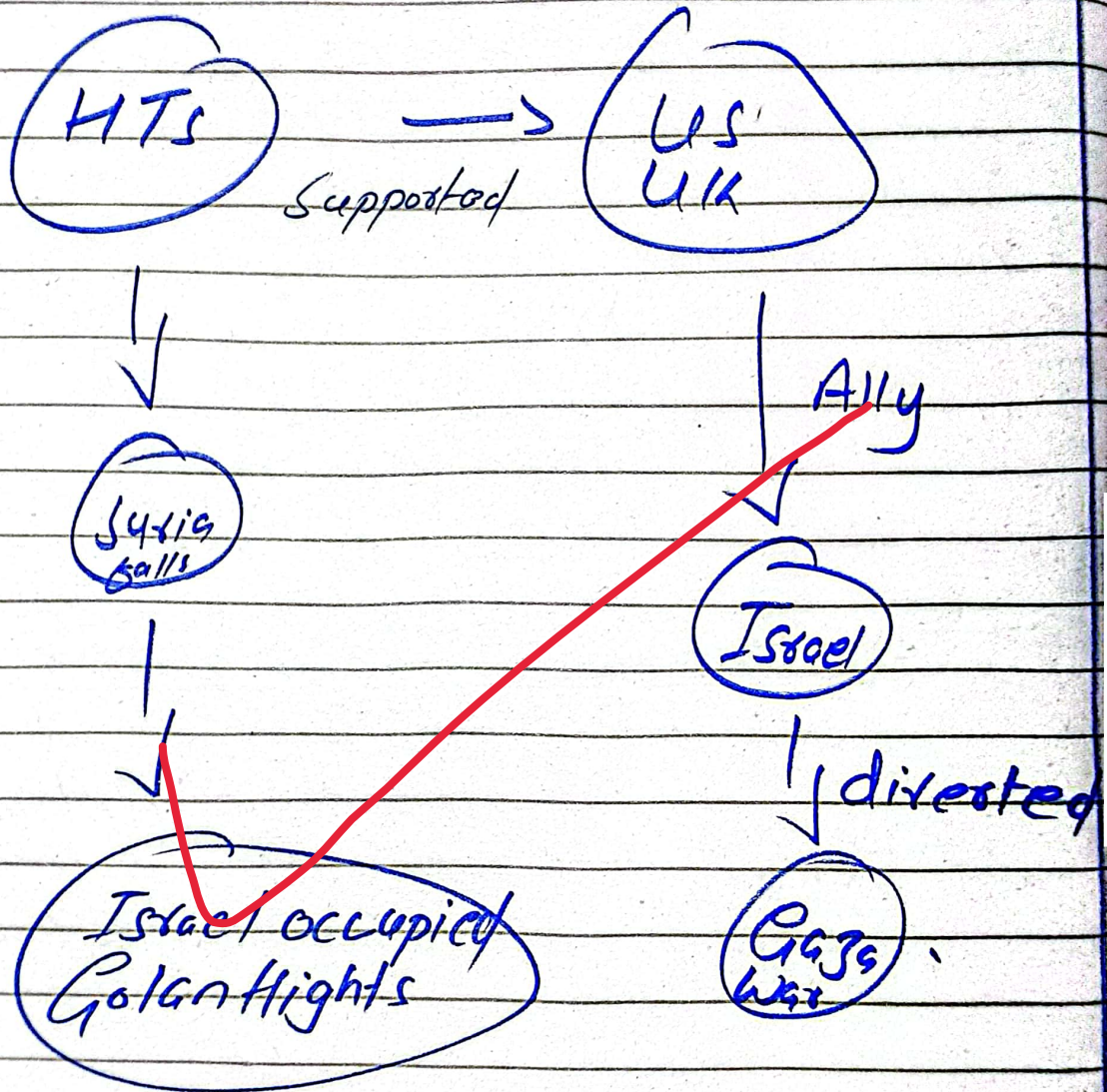

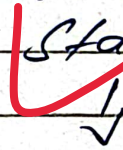
