IMPACTS OF TAUHEED ON INDIVIDUALS:

Tauheed has overarching impacts on individuals' lives and benefits them in unique ways.

i) ~~SEES~~ SENSE OF PURPOSE:-

Belief of Tauheed inculcates sense of purpose in this vast world.

"We did not create Jinn and humans except for the purpose that they should worship me" (Al-Quran).

The purpose of humans is to only worship Allah and submit their will to Allah Almighty.

ii) INCULCATES SELF-RESPECT:-

As mentioned in Quran:-

"We have honoured children of Adam --- and we greatly favoured them over others we created"

This sense of self-respect that Allah is the one, the best of the best creator who has created humans, inculcates a sense of pride in being created by Allah.

iii) INDUCES HUMILITY AND MODESTY:

Allah is the creator of every magnificent thing in this world and also the creator of every tiny thing in the world, then

divided into three categories.

1) ONENESS IN PERSON:-

Qurans -

for all the muslims. The word 'Ibadat'
comes from word "عِبَادَة" (servitude). It
means that the only purpose of worship
is to submit in front of Allah. As Allah
says:- "We create what we please and do not create"

PRAYER (SALAH) IN ISLAM:-

The term Salah literally means dua or

prayer. In Islamic terminology, ~~st~~ **salat** refers to one of the five obligatory worships and it is unique in a way that it is performed daily. Salat is one of the fundamental pillars of Islam. (10)

FIVE DAILY PRAYERS DIVIDED IN A DAY :-

- i) **FATR** → AT Dawn.
- ii) **ZUHR** → AT Noon.
- iii) **ASAR** → AT Afternoon.
- iv) **MAGHRIB** → AT Evening.
- v) **ISHA** → AT Night.

CATEGORISATION OF PRAYERS :-

FARD PRAYER : These are mandatory prayers by Allah Almighty.

SUNNAH PRAYER :- These prayers are those recited by Prophet (SAW)

NAFL PRAYERS :- Those prayers that are additional and not obligatory or mandatory. However, they hold high rewards.

OBLIGATION OF SALAT :-

Salat was made mandatory in 10th year of Prophethood on the occasion of "Isra Wal Mi'raj" (Night Journey) when the Prophet ascended to the heavens and this was the only worship that was obligated in Makkah period.

SOCIAL EFFECTS OF SALAH:-

Social impacts are when salah performed in congregation.

1) Strengthens Social Fabric:-

Congregation prayers foster a sense of brotherhood and unity among Muslims.

2) Promotes Humility:-

Standing shoulder to shoulder in salah eliminates arrogance and promotes equality.

3) Builds Harmony Among Believers:-

Regularly praying together strengthens bonds between individuals and communities.

4) Instills Tolerance:-

Praying together promotes to overlook differences and instills tolerance.

5) Enhance Unity:-

Muslims from ~~bad~~ different backgrounds stand together in front of Allah, instills unity in muslims Ummah.

MORAL EFFECTS OF SALAH:-

1) A Shield Against Evil:-

Allah says:-

"Surely, salah restrains one from shameful and evil deeds"

Salah creates a shield for muslims from all evils in the world.

2) Instills Punctuality and Discipline:-

Allah says:-

"Prayer is enjoined upon believers at stated times"

Allah has fixed times of prayer, it instills punctuality and discipline.

3) Source of cleanliness:-

Five times prayers need ablution which automatically leads to purification and cleanliness.

SPIRITUAL EFFECTS OF SALAH:-

1) A CONNECTION B/W Allah and His servant:-

"Your Lord says: Call on Me and I will answer your prayer" (Al-Quran)

3) A Means of seeking Allah's Help:-

"Seek help through patience and salah" (Al-Quran)
