

under PBUH consisted of infantry, cavalry and archers and was divided into five units.

In addition to this, he used to select appropriate position for his army in the battlefield. He used to issue strict orders to his army to not deviate from his commands and to refrain from conducting premature attacks. Furthermore, he established principles of warfare to minimise the harm caused by war and to protect the innocents. Most importantly he used to prioritise reconciliation whenever it was possible. All of this is discussed in detail in coming discussion.

2 Tactics of war of Hazrat Muhammad (SAW):

Following are the detail account of the military tactics of Hazrat Muhammad PBUH.

(A) Smart strategies to incite fear in the hearts of enemies.

As it is mentioned in the Quran in Surah Anfaal

"against them make ready your strength to the utmost of your power, including steeds of war, to incite terror into (the hearts) of enemies" → Surah Anfaal 8:60.

Hazrat Muhammad PBUH used to adopt smart strategies to incite fear in the heart of his enemies to make them surrender.
