

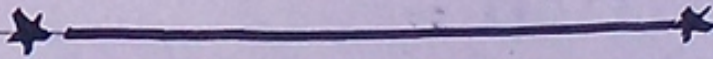

② What was the competitive advantage of the George Foreman Grill?

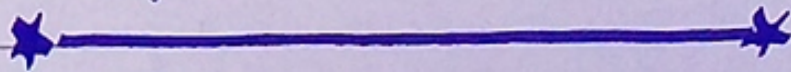
