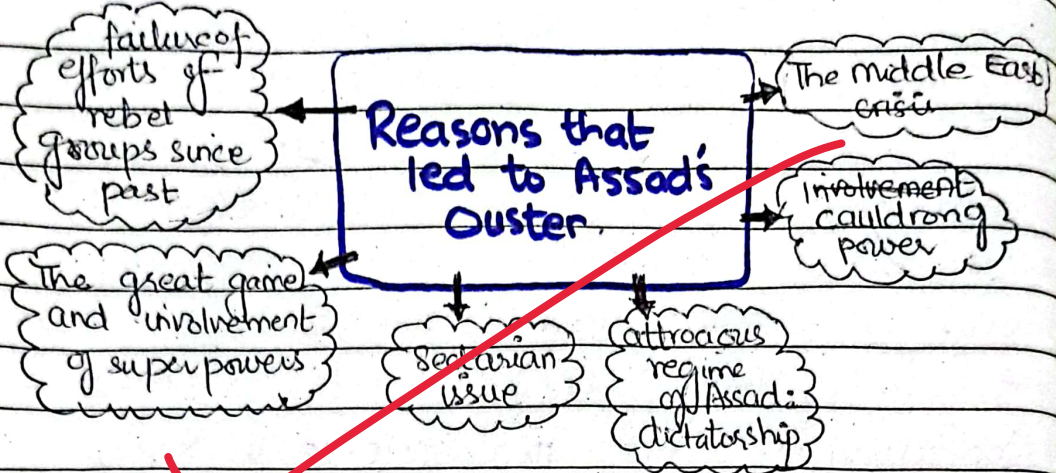

Resultantly, many were martyred, and both sides experienced losses. Moreover, many of the Syrians were displaced and killed in the skirmishes. According to UN, the violence in Syria displaced 370,000 people.

Besides, there was an unprecedented confrontation between the two. In mere two weeks the rebels group took over four major and strategically important cities of Syria. The rebels group first took over Aleppo, then the Hama, the Homs, and eventually Damascus, the capital of Syria.

The efforts of the rebel groups involve reasons which led them take over of Damascus in a way that had never been done before. Follow Below are the reasons that led to the ouster of Assad.
