Object: AI research aims to develop a device that can manipulate and move object.

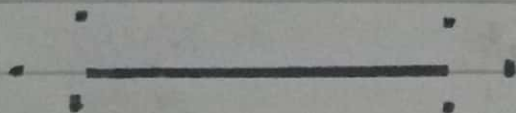
Abject: About 1.3 Billion people around the globe are targets of abject poverty.
