the rulers. Women know the problems of society and they have deep affection for people. Unfortunately, society has not given the equal chance to women. "Woman is not born woman, rather becomes woman." (The Second Sex by Simone de Beauvoir)

Men think they are born for politics. Firstly, it is a male perspective, but cunningly many women also support this narrative. Supporters of this so-called narrative are emphasizing it with socially constructing hierarchy. "History of men's emancipation of women is more interesting than the story of emancipation itself." (The Second Sex by Simone de Beauvoir)

Generally, in society power is associated with males, and people think kings and men presidents are natural. It seems quite normal to live in hierarchical world because it is repetitive narrative. Consequently, repetitive

narratives are the deciding factors behind every socially accepted norm. "Women don't want to take power from the hands of men; they want to diminish the notion of power and control." (The Second Sex by Simone de Beauvoir)

According to male's dominated perspective the politics, world affairs as well as women ~~are~~ should control by men. Because they think it is lesser that their ~~ancestors~~ ancestors gave them. Historically men ruled the world order and gave that order to their sons not their daughters. For Example: Napoleon I gave the crown to Napoleon II and ~~then~~ Napoleon III. "Women ^{writers} will be suspected with lesbian tendencies and higher intellectuals, rather than a mere worker with vagina and lesser brain tendencies." (The Second Sex by Simone de Beauvoir)

Moreover, another male

dominated perspective is women are born for reproduction not for politics. Because they think due to certain biological features and capacities women are not fit in the role of politician. That's why they believe that women should just take ^{care} of their children and their menstrual cycle. "Women are not born, rather becomes mother." (The Second Sex by Simone de Beauvoir)

Another prevailed male dominated narrative is men are highly intellectual than women. Because they think all the (most of) inventions and discoveries are by the men not women. Some of the famous ~~scients~~ scientists are Albert Einstein, Joseph Comrad and Isaac Newton. ^{Hence} they say ~~the~~ majority of scientists are men, it is evident of men's intellectual superiority. "Regular household tasks as similar to Sisyphus, there is ~~and~~ endless repetition of tasks, dirty

to clean and clean to dirty again
and again.?" (The Second Sex by Simon
de Beauvoir)

Lastly they give strong
argue that all the religions
give supriority to men. ^{because} all the
prophets are men, all the
Imam's, priests and pandits
are men. They strongly defend
their argument that women
are also marginalized by
religion, hence, it is normal
to rule world ~~for~~ by men.

"Religion is created by men
to control women.?" (The Second
Sex by Simon Beauvoir)

There is another narrative
that is opposite to male's narrative
about world politics. In contrast
to men there is female's narrative
that women are the best rulers.
Supporters of this narrative also
give various strong arguments
to defend their side. "Two
seperate beings, face to face,"

seeking justification of their identities from one another." (The Second Sex by Simon de Beauvoir)

Women denies the socially prevailing notion of power that is frequently associated with males. Because they think men are born with any power, it is socially constructed norm that is attached to men. Afterwards all the kings in history gave crown to son and supported that idea of power. If these king like Napoleon I and Mughal rulers gave crowns to daughters the idea would not prevailed.

Women are the only human being and only heroins and complete human being in literature."

(The Second Sex by Simon de Beauvoir)

Secondly, women defend their by saying that women are multitaskers with greater ability to handle pain and stress. They denies that only men can control

world affairs. As well as women are not animals that need to be controlled by others. Moreover women handle all the complex domestic tasks, learning of children and their child bearing capacity makes them more perfect for politics. They can handle stress of politics far better than men.

“If the women issue is absurd it is due to male's arrogance, they made it discussion.” (The Second Sex by Simon de de Beauvoir)

Thirdly, women defend their stance by remembering males reproduction is just a part of life, and it is not whole life. They strongly advocates their right to rule the world, breaking all the stereotypes regarding reproduction. Because it is their personal choice when to get pregnant, it can not be treated as hurdle. We have present examples of Benazir Bhutto and

Henry Clinton. "They don't suffice female, they first remark female body." (The Second Sex by Simone de Beauvoir)

Fourthly, women break the glass of men's superiority, ~~that~~ ^{men} who say men are highly intellectual than women by fact that women are closed in cage. Moreover the women are not allowed to explore the world, to travel, to study by their own will and ease. Afterwards they have restrictive opportunities to get knowledge and creativity. "Treatment of women by society as an object is paradoxical." (The Second Sex by Simone de Beauvoir)

Lastly, women defend the male narrative of religious superiority by providing evidence that women are also treated equally in all religions. Moreover men perceived religion as their personal crown. For example Hazrat Maryam

Fatima 9 Hazrat Ayesha and Seeta in Christianity 9 Islam and Hinduism respectively. "No one is more arrogant towards women than man who is anxious about his virility." (The Second Sex by Simon de Beauvoir)

As a matter of fact both men and women can play equal part in politics. Both genders have equal functions and approaches towards politics. There is only need to address the issue in the perfect form. "Due to men's oppression towards women, there is continuous state of war." (The Second Sex by Simon de Beauvoir)

The social norms are constructed and deconstructed by human according to need of time. Moreover social norms are related world politics and power ~~can~~ should be reconstructive. Women should be in power cycle as well as men equally.

“So that not every female is woman, every female should take part in the endangered reality of femininity.” (The Second Sex by Simon de Beauvoir)

Moreover, Reproduction is vital for human evolution but it can not be imposed on women. Because it is women who can take decision when to conceive and how to conceive. Career and their own desires are equally important in addition to reproduction. “He is the Subject; she is the other.” (The Second Sex by Simon de Beauvoir)
