It was founded as a reaction of the ason attack against the Al-Aqsa mosque in 1969, and ains to promote wity among muslims and to tackle issues fared by the Muslim commutity accross the globe. Mowever the history of this organization is tainted with failures, which pertain to a plethong of reasons such as external influence internal politics gropolitical tersions, and economic agendas. => QC in The Backdrop of Israet-Hamas War I, The OC summit on the 12th of October, days after Ľ the start of the war, ended in the Storg condemnation of Israel's actions, and

labeled them as a war ruime. However such summits end up with joint statements rather than collective action because internal members are deeply influenced by the US. For example, a key member, Saudi Arabia has expressed the desire to not recognize (srad in the past in exchange of a military part with the US and a rivilian nuclear program. Given this angle, the Saudia are not keen on taking a very strong position against Is rad, like some states have. Furthermore, the UAE, which has also recognized (srad, enjoys warmer velations and tonomic ties with Israel, which also prevents it from taking a strong starce against (srael). This results is a lack of unity and coherence.

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De Iran-Saudi rapprochement was medicated by China and was achieved on the 10t of March 2023. This resulted in a j major now between the two hostile States. This rapprochement resulted in the end of hostilities in remen, and Iran openly vowing to not use proxies against the Saudis. Despite all this, tensions between the two states still exist and are at visk of increasing rather than decreasing. Griven the Saudis' inclination to wards the west Iran considers this as a threat to the region and to its interests. Although a continuence step towards peace, this rapprochement has still yet to contribute towards wity and collective action.

This project is seen both as a competitor and a complimentar of the Chinese Beltard Road Initiative (BRI), however it will serve as a competitor to the BRI -> Potential of Regional Connectivity

Potential of IMEC

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The IMEC is currently in its MoU stage and has not yet reached a signed agreement between the G20 states. The MEC is a proposed network consisting of railways and sea parts and will have 2 corridors; East counder, connecting India to the Middle East, and Northern Cornidor, connecting Europe to the Arock an Gulf The INEC has potetial to serve as a key regional connectivity project, and small would ost around \$3 to \$8 billion. Dehi has said that it will not be involved in financing the rail roads or ports. The main mindle faced by the IMER is lack of framework and f continuization

-> CPEC: A Forthidable Force

Part of the BRI is CPEC, which is the China Pahistan economic consider. Compared to the MEC which would be valued around SP billion in its initial phases the CPEC is consistly wouth over Stobbillion and is continuing to deuglop. When it comes to the potential of this consider, apail from connecting China with waron waters, it also has the opportunity to spread to Iran and Afghanistan. Since INEC will only be a railbased connectivity network in the Middle East apart from a few pouts, it will not be alle to compete with the CPEC project if it manages is pread to Afghanistan.

## -> Significance of B3W Amidst Competition

In the backdiep of the INEC-BRI competion, the B3W or Build Back Better World' is worth mentioning. Announced by the G7 outions in 2021, This regional connectivity project of aims to build strong Strategic partnersmps, mobilize private capital, and enhance multilateral public fibereirg. In the future, if the IMEC partnered with the BSW, it would be able to serve as a significant counterweight to China's BRI. However, both the B3W and IMEC are in their early developmental stores which the BRI is currently worth around \$ Strillion. With Such a headstart catching up with the BRI would certainly brove to be a tedious task for both-the IMEC and B3W.

-> Implications on Pakistan

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Due to its strategic geostrot geographical location and membership of the BRI, there will be similificat implications of the aforementioned dandogments. Considering the sharp disagreements between the West and Russia. the region is still witnessing subtained duringtions in Pronomic energy and food supply chains. This policy entailed that there would be one China, remified with Hong Korg and Maray, but these two regions would have their own admistrative and Peronomic systems. Recently this policy has been spoken of with respect to Taiwan as well, when Taiwan openly rejected this poticy as recently as in Pecember 2023. Despite this, the US policy towards Taiwan is considered a threat towards China's policy and is exacerbating global tersions. => Implications of US Taiwon Policy -> US Strategic Ambiguity Inroughout history the US has maintained a policy of "Strategic ambiguity 'towards Taiwan. This policy gave birth to several ambiguous policies regarding Taiwan with the aim to

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prevent China from invading Taiwan. However, in 2021, President Joe Biden abandoned this policy and claimed that the US would defend Taiwan if it was attacked. This has stepped up efforts against China's One China' policy and is a significant Challenge towards Taiwan's remification with China. Furthermore, in top, Joe Biden again stated thet the US would militarily intervene if China invaded Taiwan. Hence, such Thetoric is a challenge to China's policy.

# -> Chip Wars

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Apast from the military threads, the Biden administration has also stared to coerce thing with the help of restricting its access to advanced microchips. China and Taiwan are both export and import noukers of such chips, but the US has sanctioned China in order to boost the Taiwanese chip mark et. This has allowed Taiwan to make efforts in its desire to by pass Chinese recording sanctions. Hence, China's policy also faces a threat from the chip development perspective.

-> Mitany Aid to Taiwan

Taiwan's elections in Jaman 2024 elected Lai Chirg as the new residut, who is also considered to be a pro-time way leader. In light of the increasing military aid to Taiwan over the last 2 years, under the new President, there will potentially be more cooperation in the military sector. US military aid aims to enhance the Capabilities of of the Taiwanese military to increase its deterrence against Chira. This is another significant weeks challenge faced by China's policy.
