"While the hereafter is much better and much more durable"

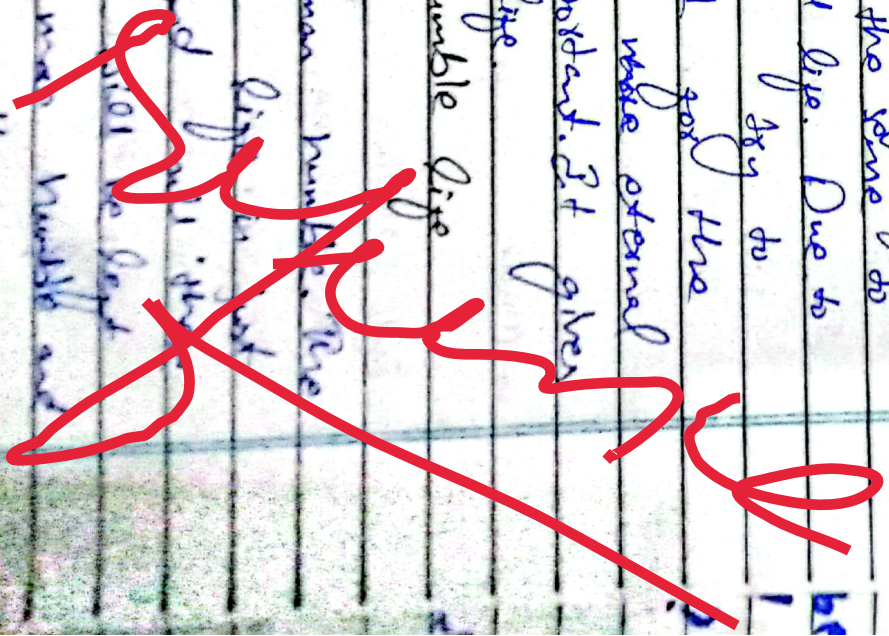

### Introduction:

Word "Ibadah" means "servitude"

Reason of creation of all creatures is to worship Allah.

"I have not created jinn and human except the purpose that they should worship me."

(AL Baqarah)

In Islam, there are 3 kinds of Ibadah:

Physical Ibadah: These are the kinds of Ibadah which include physical effort. For example Salat and Saum.

Financial Ibadah: These are the Ibadah which include financial contribution. For example Zakat.

Physical and Financial: These are the Ibadah which include physical effort as well as financial effort. Example is Hajj.

### Zakat

"Zakat" mean to "purify". It was obligated in 2 hijri. Amount of Zakat is to pay 2.5% from all wealth.

"And performs the prayer

and give alms (Zakat)"  
(Al-Baqarah)

- Faqir: One who has insufficient means of survival.
- Muslim: One who has nothing.
- Amleen: Collectors of Zakat.
- Mulqat ul-Qalob: One who has reverted to Islam.

- Ibn-us-sabeel: Travelers.
