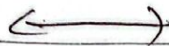

Heer asked that what ~~did~~ had he learned from his journey.

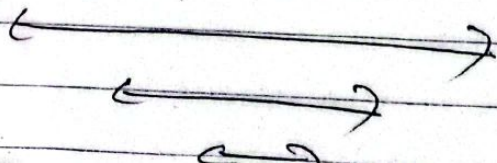
