Recently, the changing dynamics of the world can be a source of progress and development for the organization. The world is

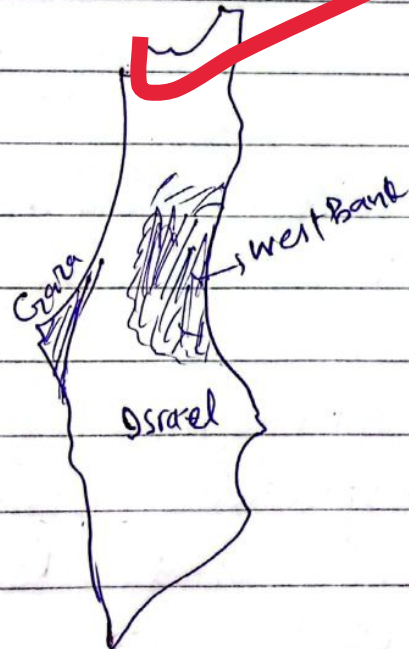

(ii) India's role in the region will be played as a competitor who is trying to compete with China to help China's arch-rival US.

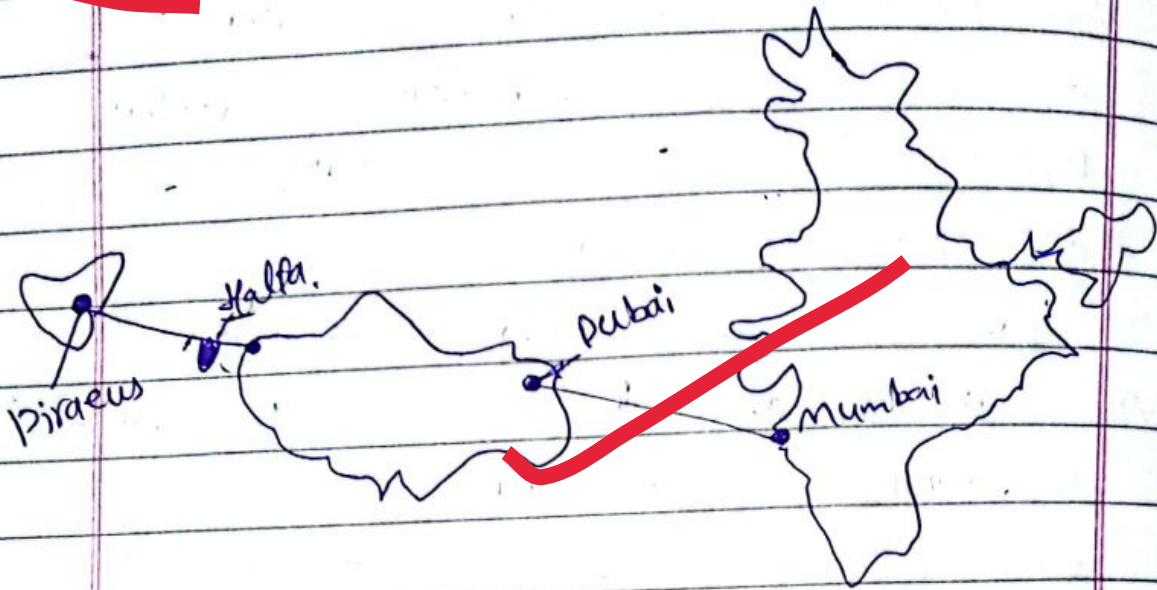

The US Secretary, Miss Nancie Pelosi's visit to Taiwan antagonized China and China had clearly warned US to not interfere in its matters. China recommended Taiwan to not developing ties with other states to undermine China.

Taiwan is the bone of contention between US and China because of economical, geographical and political grounds. Taiwan is one of islands

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that China claims that it comes into her territory and sovereignty. The trade of China and US ~~also~~ is passed from the strait of Taiwan. Taiwan is the major manufacturer of semiconductors which is the major insulator in all things. China and USA depend on these silicon chips due to their economical growth.

US is trying to influence and impacting China because US is recently developing its interests in Taiwan. Pakistan has asked Taliban government to talk TTP and persuade them to negotiate for peace talks. We have two rounds of talks ~~but~~ with TTP but they were so professional that they became conditionalized. Their conditions were not suitable for Pakistan.

In 2021, Doha agreement, Taliban government pledged to let not use the Afghanistan

soil against any neighbor
 country to disturb peace
 of the region 'but they
 are using Afghanistan
 soil without any fear.
 TTP and ISKP has claimed
 and taken the responsibility
 of many attacks of
 terrorism in Pakistan like
 Stock exchange attack in
 Karachi, APS attack Peshawar,
 Sri Lankan team attack and
 many such other.

3. Effects of resurgence in Pakistan:-

Pakistan is facing many
 effects due to resurgence
 in long terms, and some
 of those effects are as
 under:

- (i) The economic slowdown
 of Pakistan is one of
 the major effects of
 resurgence. The security concerns
 of the people do not

remain supportive. The people do not carry on their businesses due to weak security. Just like in Balochistan, many coal miners are not working due to the insecurity, according to the official authority in Balochistan.

(ii) Social chaos and anarchy are the main contributors to disturb the society. People become very sensitive due to the threats. The fear of unexpected attack prevail in the minds of the people which further affects their mental health.

(iii) Pakistan army has been the target of TTP many times. This thing and casualties of army and civilians are the real loss which Pakistan

4. Pakistan's decision about Afghan refugees:-

5. Reasons of Pakistan's decision about refugees:-

- a. Pakistan has decided to repatriate Afghan refugee due to security concerns. According to the officials, out of the 24 attacks, 14 attacks of terrorism from 2021-2022 were done by Afghan nationals.
- b. Pakistan is facing economic slowdown and Afghan refugees are burden on the economy of Pakistan.
- c. The child labour is one of the social evils in Pakistan. Afghan refugees' children are the major contributor in child labour because they had to work due to the fulfilment of their basic needs.
- d. According to NADRA's authorities, some foreign partners have been involved in giving Afghan nationals identity cards. So, all

all such concerns made Pakistan to let herself free from the responsibility of Afghan refugees.

6. Effects of Pakistan's decisions on Pak - Afghan relations.

The effects of Pakistan's step towards the Afghan refugees is a very crucial and decisive step. It can undermine and disturb the relations with Afghanistan. Some of the effects are discussed below.
