point, global conferences on climate change has stepped towards sustainable environment is on the top of the list. The whole world has moved to call urgent climate related conferences for sustainable environment. Recently, in 2023, the whole world met an active conference on climate change moving towards sustainable future. "Approximately 200 countries attended global climate conference - COP-28 to recall the need of a sustainable future." (The Economist - the COP-28 Conferences, 2023) This indicates that global conferences on climate change have stepped towards sustainable environment proving that the environment has not gone beyond the tipping point now.

Along with global climate conference, technological usage in forecasting environmental threats is another evidence of the environment has not gone beyond the tipping point now. The world has promoted technological usage to identify environmental threats for protection of sustainable environment. As a result, environmental prediction has protected natural environment with the help of modern tech.

hology. According to the US-based Institute of Library Medium, "Approximately 69% of reliance on technology in weather forecasting is successful in climate action." (The BBC - Trump's Nationalism, 2020). Thus, the above evidence shows that frequent change in politics has threatened the environment, which shows that the environment has gone beyond the tipping point now.

In addition, the world is facing massive natural disasters due to climate vulnerability, which also highlight the environment has gone beyond the tipping point now. The whole world has faced unprecedented disasters posing risk to human survival. Floods, earthquakes, and cyclones have caught the world in a vicious cycle of disasters. "On 6th February 2023, Turkey went under the massive earthquake, which devastated about 45,000 lives and 64,000 of the infrastructure loss." (The CNN, Massive Earthquake in Turkey, 2023). This shows that the world is facing massive natural disasters due to climate vulnerability indicating the world environment has gone beyond the tipping point now.

Furthermore, the global superpowers are major green house gases (GHGs)

emitters, which highlight the environment has gone beyond the tipping point now. The superpower countries are contributing to GHG emissions for economic revival - Growing dependency on GHG for industrialization and economic revolution causing hazards of the environment. As per Thomas Friedman, "In a globalized world, countries are moving towards economic conflicts 'disturbing the phenomenon of the natural environment.'" (Thomas Friedman, *The World is Flat*, 2005). This indicates that the global superpowers are major green house gases (GHG) emitters showing the environment has gone beyond the tipping point now.

Not only this, but financial commitment has also not been fulfilled successfully advocating the environment has gone beyond the tipping point now. The global financial commitment on climate finance has loopholes generated by the superpowers causing environmental hazards. Agreement on generation of climate funds was not supported by the West, particularly the USA. "About \$22 billions were missing in COP-26 - Glasgow Conference among them 18 billion dollars by the USA." (The IPCC 2022). Thus, financial commitment has not been

successfully fulfilled, which shows that the environment has gone beyond the tipping point now.

Besides this, deforestation is still a big global issue advocating the environment has gone beyond the tipping point now. The world has also caught in a cycle of deforestation dilemma, threatening the natural environment. In fact, growing unsustainable urbanization has made a road map for the environmental hazards. "The world is moving rapidly towards unsustainable urbanization leading to unsustainable development, which threatens the natural environment" (The World Bank, 2023). 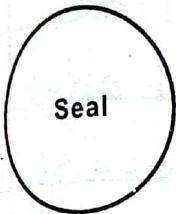
