### A. Day of Judgement.

their deeds in the mortal world.

"He, who does an atom's  
weight of good, shall be rewarded  
and he, who does an atom's

- Al-Quran

### B. Concept of 'Hell' and 'Paradise' in Islam:

According to the  
good and bad deeds of Human  
beings, they will be sent to  
Hell (Jahannam) or Paradise (Jannat)  
In Quran Allah says;

"Say to those who disbelieve  
that you will be overcome  
and gathered together in the  
hell, wretched is the resting place"  
- (Al-Quran)

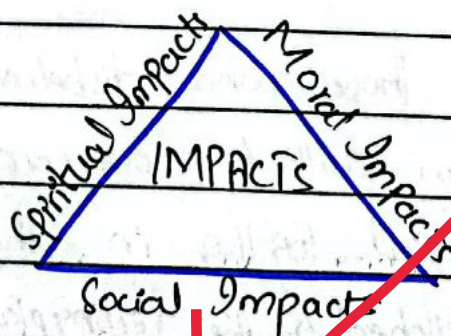
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Additionally, in Quran, Allah has also described the beauty of paradise where people with good deeds will be sent.

Islam puts a lot of emphasize on the importance of Zakat. It is only given to those who are needy. In Quran, Allah has already told about eight Muzarif to whom one can give Zakat. It helps promoting social justice. Those Muzarif are:

“Alms are only for the poor and the needy, and the officials over them, and those whose hearts are inclined, and the captives, and those in debts and in the way of Allah and the wayfarer; an ordinance

from Allah. Allah is all-knowing  
and wise."

~ Al-Quran

### D. Economic Freedom to Females

Islamic system also promotes social justice by giving equal economic freedom to women as that of men. Hazrat Khadija (RA) is the biggest example of this freedom. M. Qutb in his Opus "Islam; the Misunderstood Religion"; also says:

"Islam occupies a unique position in that it ~~requires~~ recognized an independent economic status of women and gave them the right to earn and utilize without having any intermediary trustee and mediator"

- Holy Prophet (PBUH)

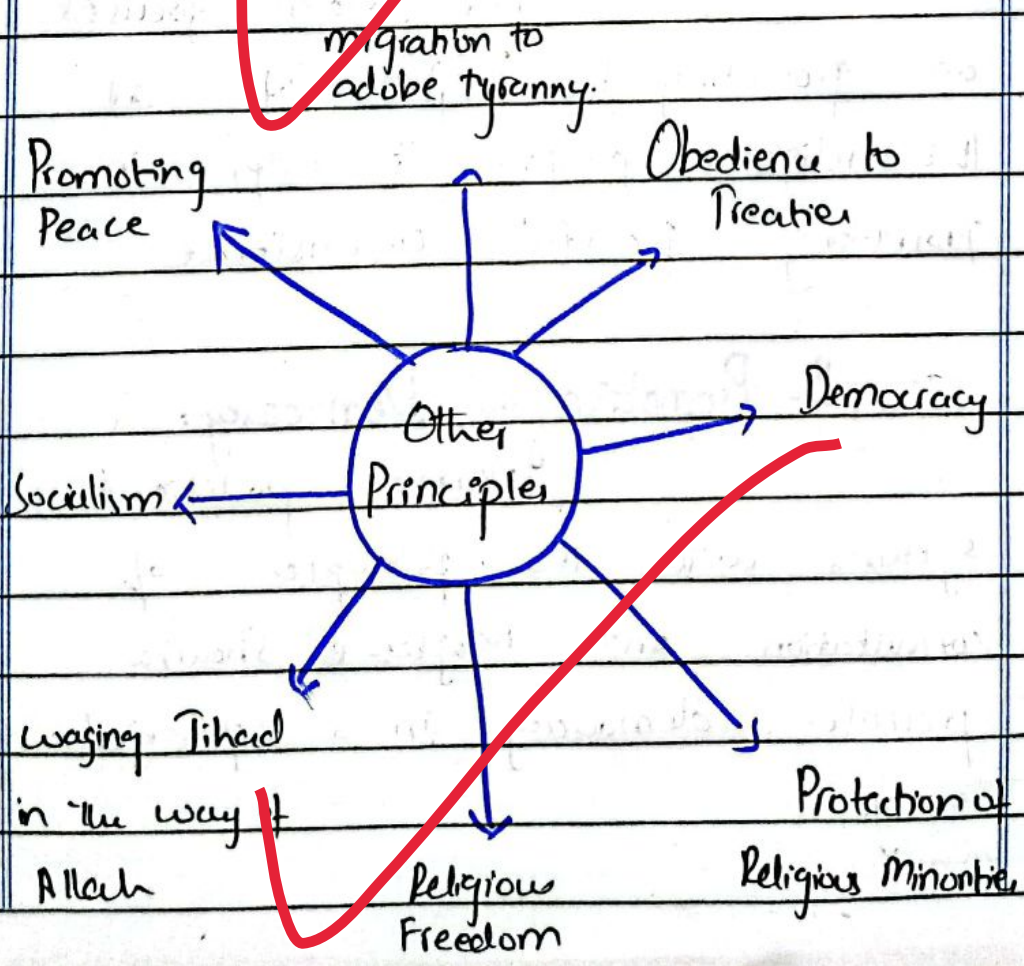


### D. Government by Consultation:

As Islam gives a lot of importance to treaties, their breach will lead to war. Hence, staying loyal and abiding by the treaties help promoting prosperity of state and the society.

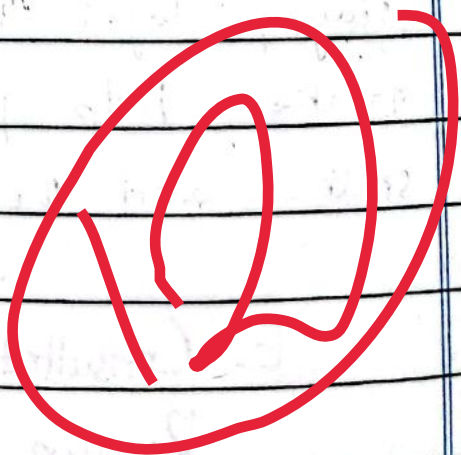
### E- Consultation and Accountability Remove evils from the Society:

- Al-Quran

The importance of Ha. Zakat can also be found in Ahadith. Prophet (PBUH) says:

"The people who hinder Zakat will be afflicted by God with Drought"  
~ Al-Quran
